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Copy Cats

- 1 Sit facing your baby with her on your lap, or else put her in her bouncy chair, where you can be face to face.
- 2 Pull faces at your baby, and make funny noises, and then pause, and see if she smiles, and tries to copy you. At first she won't be able to copy very much, but as time goes on, you'll see she becomes cleverer and cleverer at doing what you're doing.

You can swap roles, too, and when she pulls a face, or does something with her hands, or makes a noise, copy it back to her - ***she'll think it's hilarious!***

Just keep it simple and stop when she's not interested.



Try these ideas

- ★ Touch your nose and make a squeaky noise
- ★ Put out your tongue
- ★ Blow a 'raspberry'
- ★ Clap your hands
- ★ Make a noise and wobble your lips with your fingers
