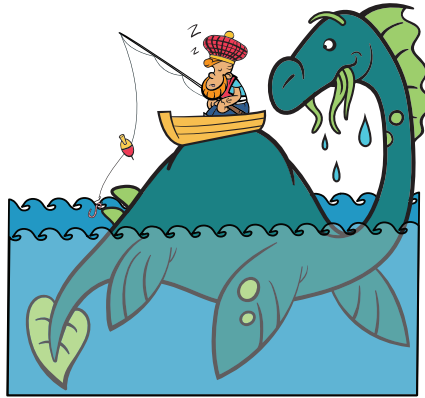


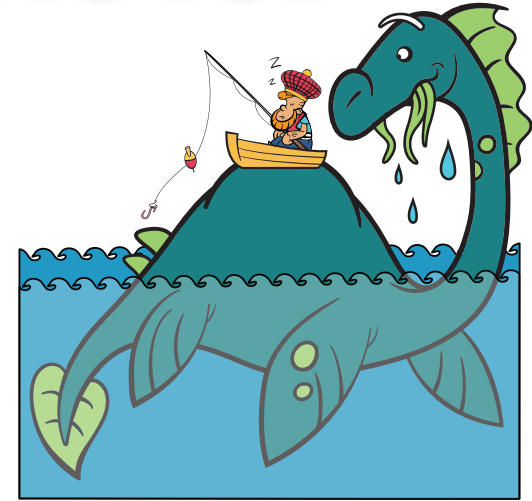

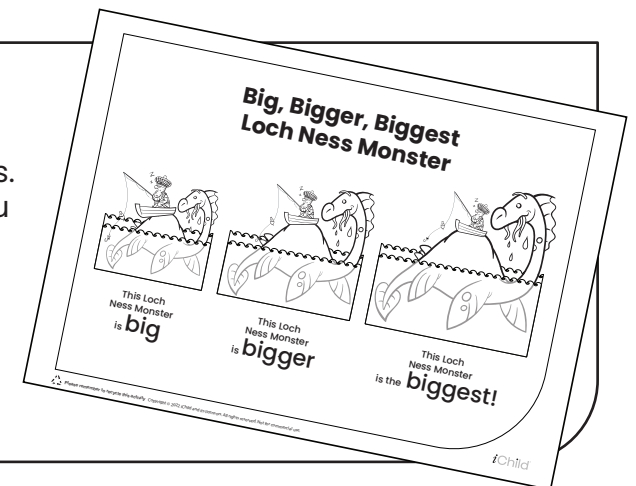


Mathematics

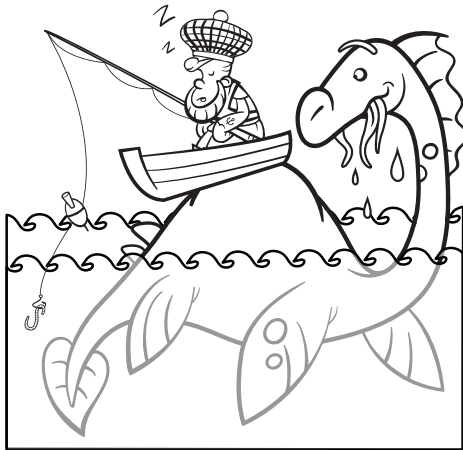
Supporting spatial reasoning and looking at the relationship between the images. They're the same but different sizes! Children can compare the sizes and develop their mathematical language.

Instructions

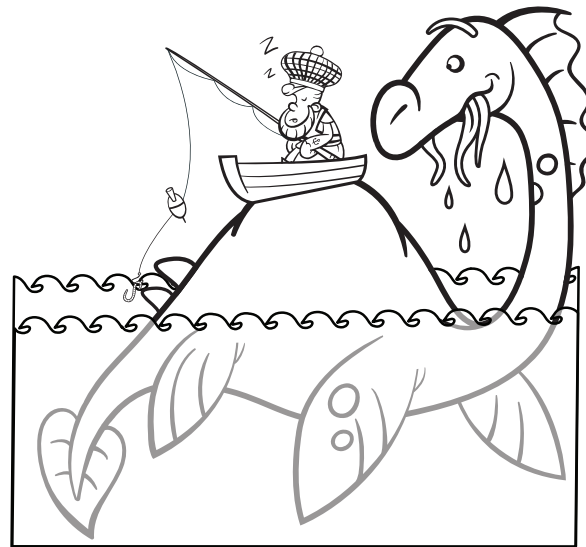
