The second page is blank for you to add in your own special places. You can even use the little map to deepen children's understanding of where their home is in relation to the country.

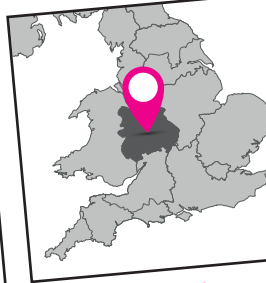

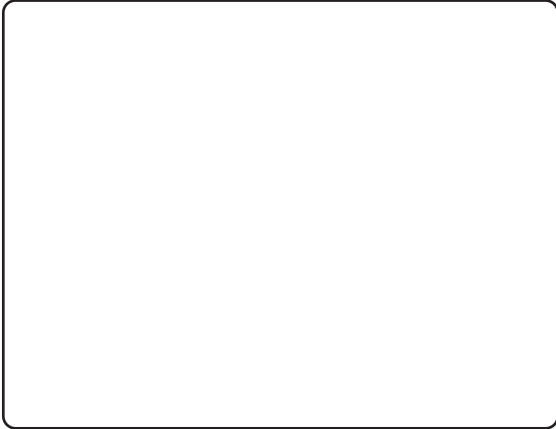

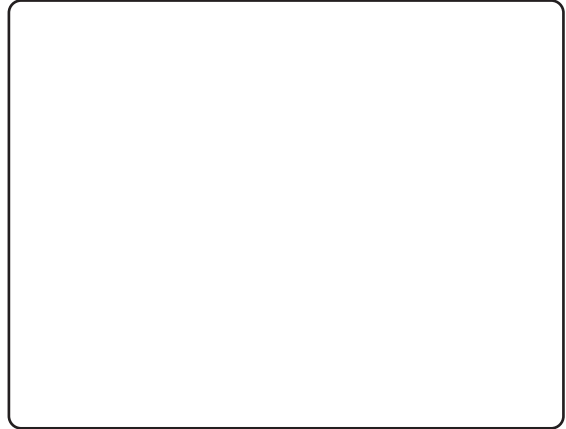
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
