You will need:

-  Paintbrushes
-  Paint
-  Squeezy paint
-  Sponge
-  Leaves
-  Toothbrush
-  Potato shape
-  Sticks
-  Any other 'painting' tool that springs to mind and hand!
-  Large sheets of paper (for little artists to paint on)

Spread out the large sheets of paper on the floor or table.

Encourage children to make marks on the paper using the paints and tools. Let them have the opportunity of experiencing different ways of applying paint.

Different tables or groups could use different paints or tools, and then the children can look at the different results using different tools and paints.
