PowerPoint presentation

The accompanying PowerPoint presentation has 26 slides with the following learning points:

- Slides 1 to 4: give an introduction to the lesson and describe what sculpture is.
- Slides 5 and 6: provide examples of some of the materials and techniques used to make sculptures.
- Slides 7 to 12: look more closely at the four basic processes of sculpting; carving, modelling, casting and constructing.
- Slides 13 to 22: focus on two artists who work in sculpture, firstly Louise Bourgeois and then Anish Kapoor. We look more closely at their life and work, including some of their most famous sculptures, Maman, Cloud Gate and Orbit. How do the children think these sculptures were made? How do the works of art make the children feel? What do they like or dislike about them?

Activity 1 (slides 23 and 24)

- Slides 23 and 24: ask the children to research other sculptors and compare their work, the materials they used and the message they were trying to communicate through their art. A few sculptors have been listed as a starting point. Next, ask the children to record their research about Anish Kapoor and their responses to one of his sculptures in their sketchbooks, or around a picture of his artwork. They could create a fact file of the artist and his work, using the template provided within this PDF.
- Slide 25: includes some key vocabulary to include on the working wall.

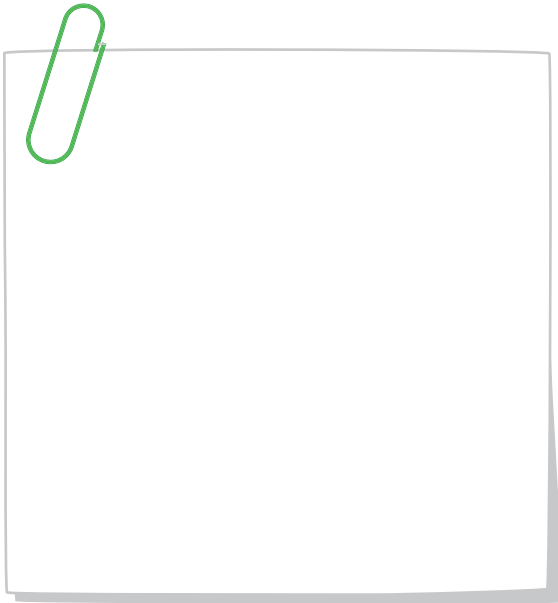
