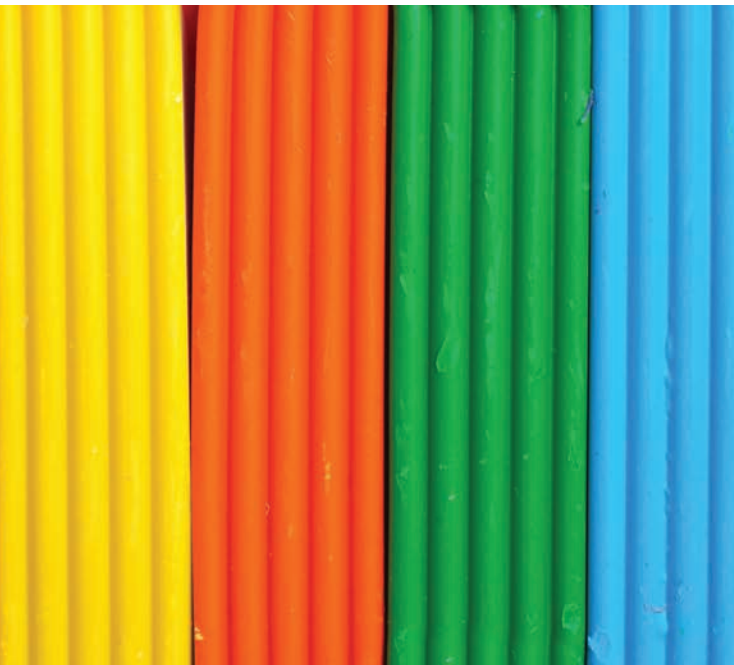

Resources for the lesson

- Variety of junk modelling materials.
- String
- Tape
- Card, newspaper, paper.



PowerPoint presentation

The accompanying PowerPoint presentation has 13 slides with the following learning points:

- Slides 1 to 4: introduce the lesson. Remind the children of what a sculpture is and some of the materials and tools which can be used.
- Slide 5: look back at the sculptures studied in detail during previous lessons, such as Maman and Cloud Gate. The children are looking to build and progress on what they've learnt so far, in readiness for building their own sculptures.
- Slide 6: now ask the children to review their sketches of their sculpture from the previous lesson. Have they chosen which sculpture they'd like to create? If the children do not have sketches, they can be created in this lesson.
- Slides 7 and 8: ensure there is a range of junk modelling materials for the children to choose from. Ask them to select the materials they'd like to use, do they have the correct properties to create the sculpture they want?
- Slide 9: what challenges might the children face when making their sculpture? What might help them overcome these, for example, can they choose some back up materials if the ones they've chosen are not appropriate?

Activity 1 (slide 10)

- Slide 10: now to the part they've been waiting for...building their sculpture! Ask the children to construct each part of their sculpture. They could place their sculpture inside a box to give it a sense of space, just like being in an art gallery room.
- Slide 11: display the sculptures around the classroom for everyone to see. Ask each child to discuss what they like about their artwork, what is going well, or what they might have done differently. Record their observations in their sketchbooks.
- Slide 12: includes some key vocabulary to add to the working wall.
