

Didgeridoo Craft

Here's a fun way to make a didgeridoo.



You will need

*2 kitchen rolls, glue, tape, colouring in pens, pencils.
Attached sheets of Aboriginal art: Black and white on pages 2, 3 and 4. And/or coloured on pages 5, 6 and 7.*

Optional

*Paints for finger painting.
A3 white paper or roll of wrapping paper.*

Instructions

- 1 Stick the kitchen rolls together with tape so you have a nice long tube. You could also use a sheet of A3 paper, rolling it up along the longest edge, and ask an adult to help stick it together to form a tube. Or you could use the tube found in a roll of wrapping paper.
- 2 Colour in the Aboriginal art design sheets on pages 2, 3 and 4. Or use the coloured sheets on pages 5, 6 and 7. (Or both!) Cut them out and stick them to your tube. Be as creative as you like! You could even create patterns by finger painting on the tube.
- 3 Once the glue and paints (if finger painting) are dry, put your didgeridoo to your mouth and hum.

You now have a fantastic
didgeridoo!
