

Autumn Leaf Suncatcher

Here's a fun way to make a leaf suncatcher.



You will need:

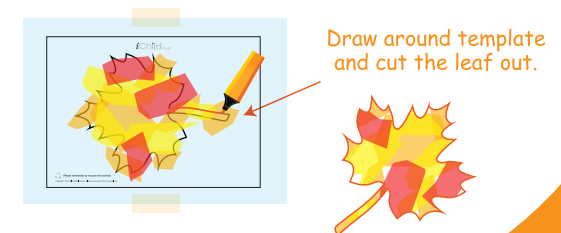
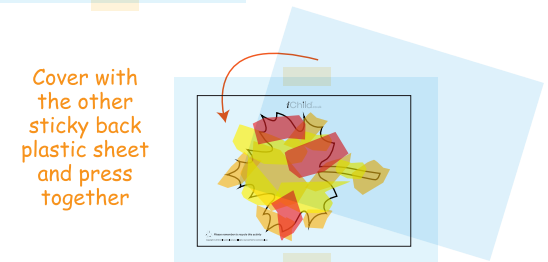
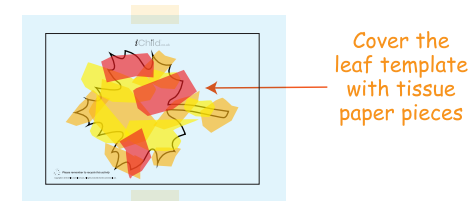
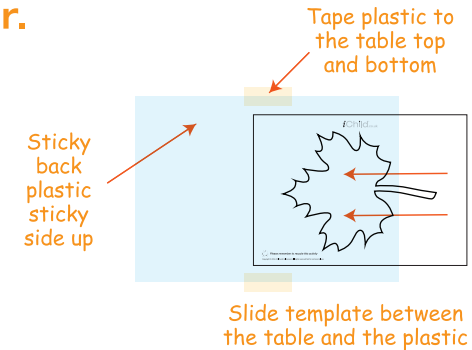
Roll of sticky back plastic (the type you cover books with). Red, yellow and orange tissue paper. Scissors, tape, double-sided tape or blue tac, orange permanent marker pen.

Instructions

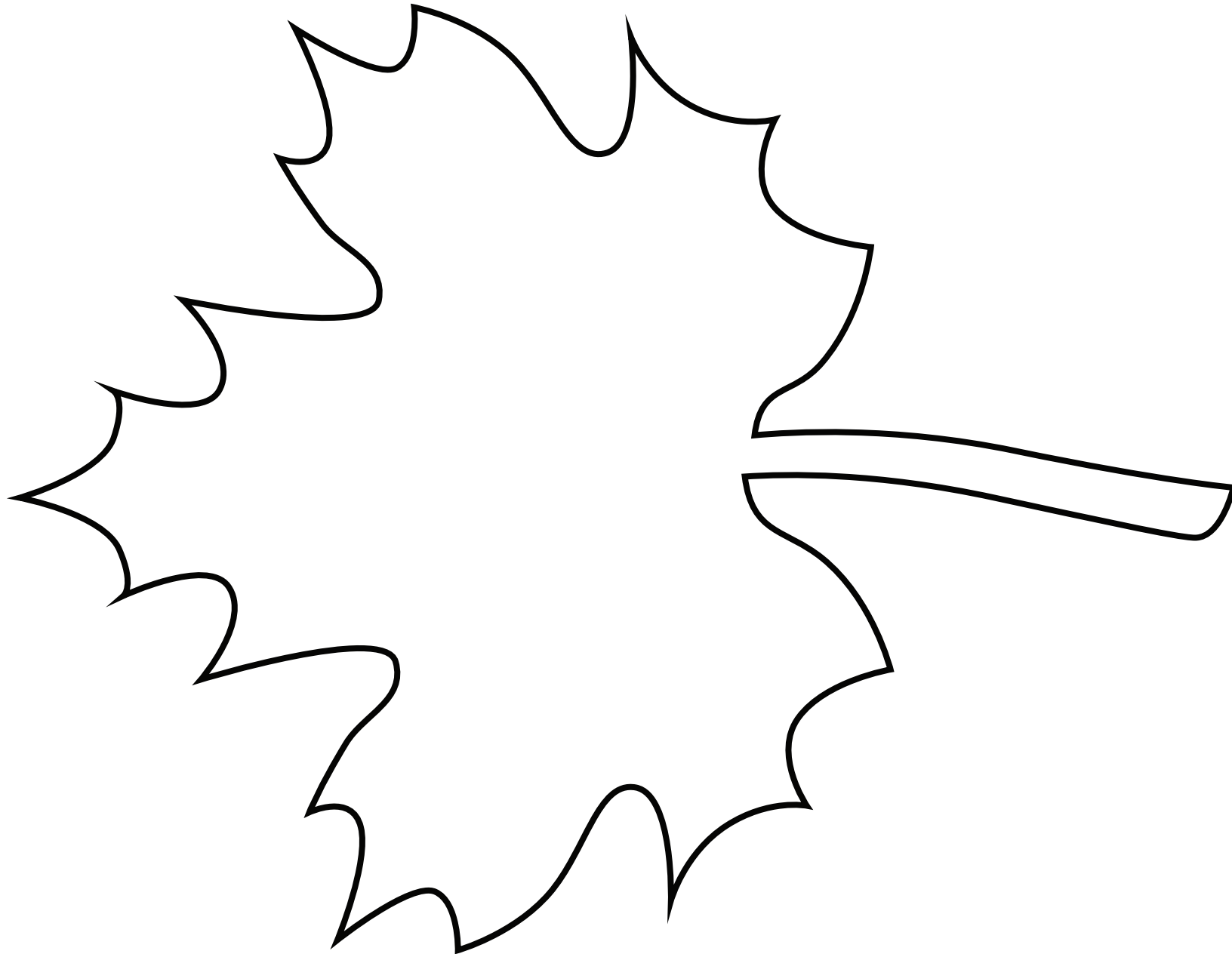
- ① Print the leaf templates from pages 2-4.
- ② Tear up pieces of red, yellow and orange tissue paper. Then cut out 2 sheets from the roll of sticky back plastic. Make them slightly bigger than the leaf template.
- ③ Peel the backing paper from one of the sheets and place on the table, sticky side up. Stick tape to the top and bottom to fix it to the table and stop it moving about.
- ④ Slide your chosen leaf template between the table and the plastic sheet, then cover the leaf area with pieces of tissue paper using the template as a guide.
- ⑤ Peel the backing from the other sticky back plastic sheet and cover your leaf design, sticky side down this time, and press together.
- ⑥ Trace the leaf outline with a permanent pen then cut it out.
- ⑦ Put small pieces of double sided tape or blue tac on your leaf and stick to a window.

Repeat the above to make more leaves!

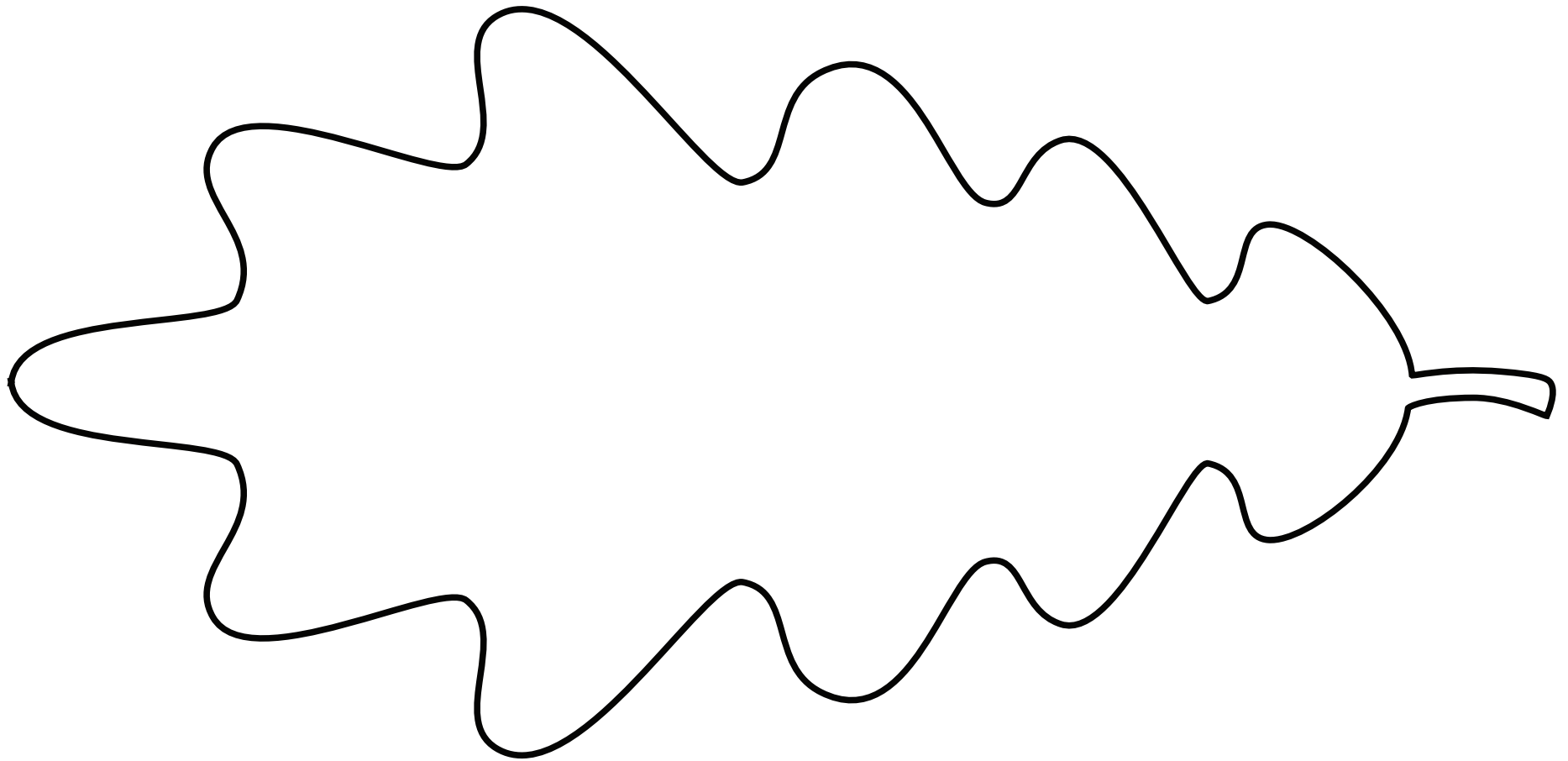

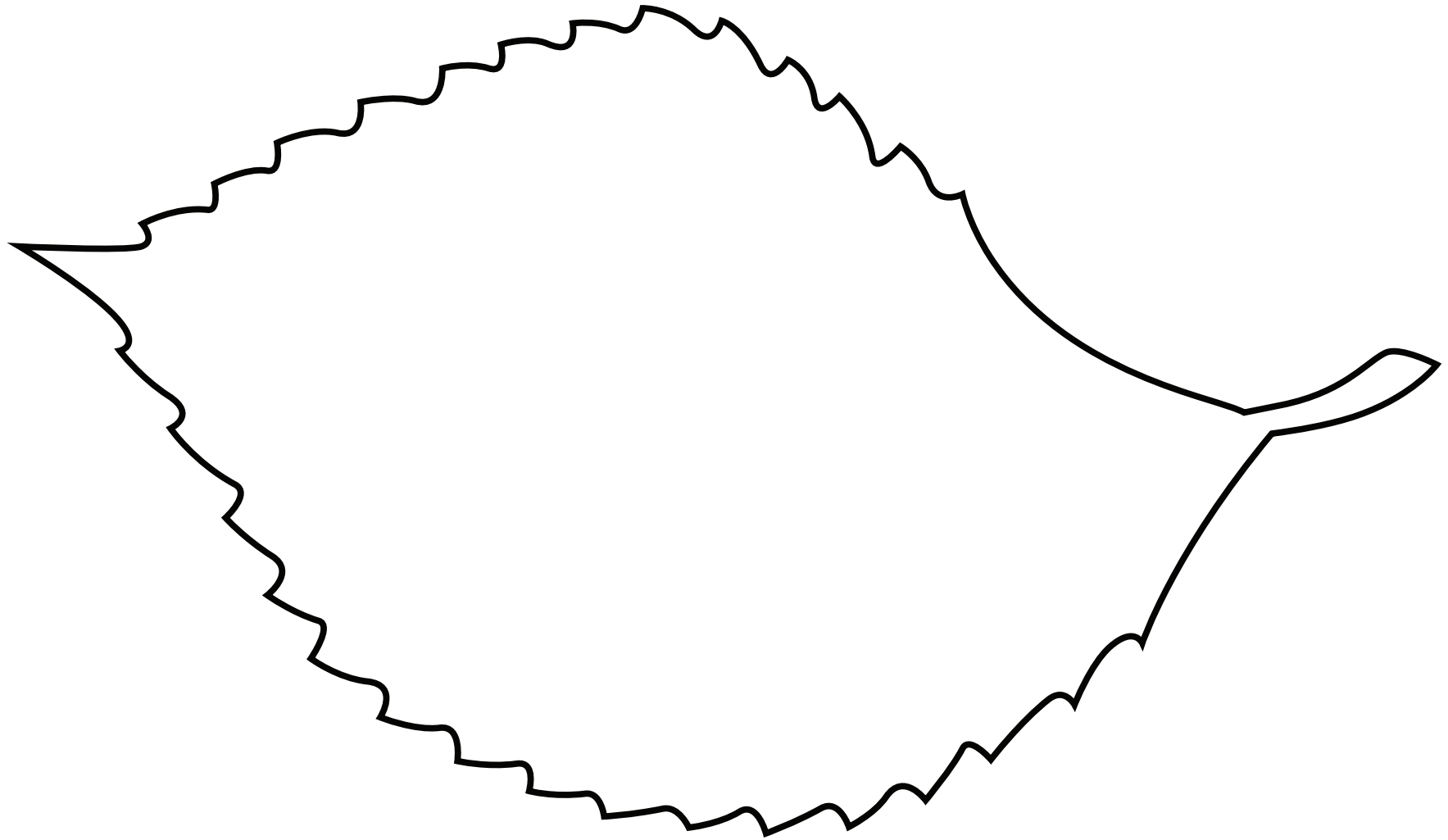
