

Firework Decoration

Here's a fun way to make decorations for bonfire night.

You will need

Scissors, tape, glue, thread, toilet roll, thin card, coloured tissue paper, paints and coloured glitter (optional).

Instructions

1

Cover your toilet roll with red tissue paper or paint it red.

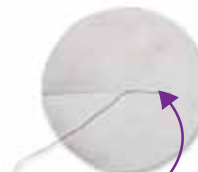
Next make a cone shape by using the template on the last page. Print out onto thin card or print out and stick onto thin card. Now Cover with red tissue paper or paint it red. Cut the circle out, then cut a line down to the centre of the circle. Tape a long piece of thread onto the back of the shape. Now thread through the cut line. (as shown below). Move the two edges around to make a cone shape. Tape or glue the edges in place.

- 3 Glue or tape the cone to the top of your red toilet roll. (It's a little easier if you place glue all around the toilet roll rim then stick the cone on). You can now decorate your firework with glitter, or stars, or anything you like!

- 4 Cut out strips of coloured tissue paper about 15mm wide and 150mm long. If you like you can use the coloured strips on the next page.

Now hang your firework decoration up for everyone to see!

Decorate with stars or glitter



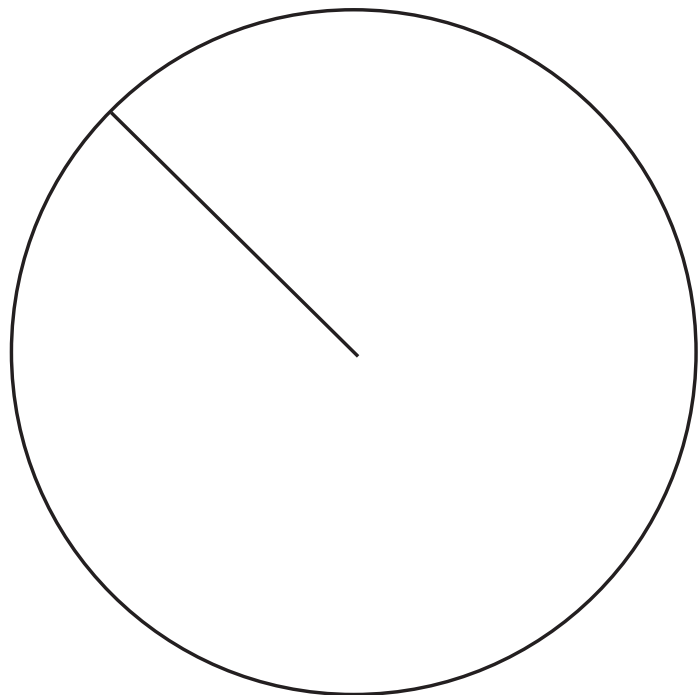
Glue paper strips inside the tube.



Glue or tape the cone on.
