

# Make a Sparkler

Here's a fun way to make a sparkler!



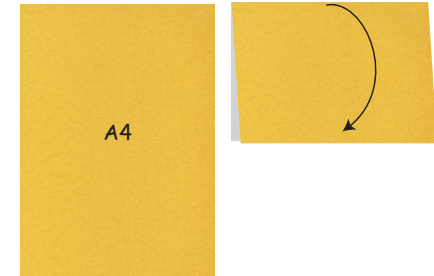
## You will need

*A4 Yellow paper, A4 gold tissue paper, scissors, 2 tinsel pipe cleaners, glue, sellotape, wooden dowel stick, (or you could use a pencil or chopstick) and a metallic gold pen (optional use an orange pen if you like!).*

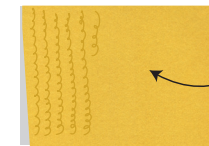
## Instructions

- 1 Fold the portrait A4 yellow paper and the gold tissue paper in half.
- 2 Draw metallic gold wiggly lines about 1cm apart going down the yellow paper.
- 3 Cut strips along the yellow paper on the open edge, in between the wiggly lines. **Do not cut all the way to the folded edge. Leave 1 inch of paper uncut.**
- 4 Cut the gold tissue paper in the same way giving you strips about 1cm wide. Don't worry if some are a bit smaller than others.

A4 folded in half.

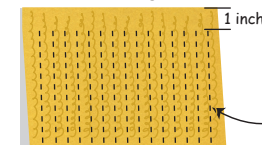


Folded edge.



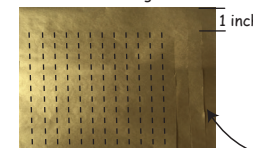
Draw wiggly lines about 1cm apart going down the page.

Folded edge.



Cut strips between your lines. Don't cut all the way to the edge, leave 1 inch.

Folded edge.



Cut stripes along the unfolded edge. Don't cut all the way to the edge, leave 1 inch.



Please remember to recycle this activity

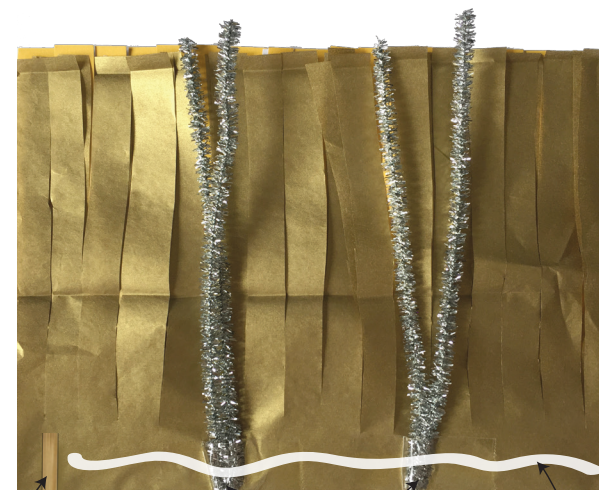
- 5 Run glue along the uncut edge of the yellow paper and stick the gold sheet to it lining up the edges.
- 6 Fold the tinsel pipe cleaners in half and tape them along the uncut edge as shown.
- 7 Tape the wooden stick to the bottom left end of the paper.
- 8 Put a line of glue along the paper edge as shown.
- 9 Gently start rolling the paper around the stick. Once you've rolled all the paper secure with tape.
- 10 Gently open out the strips.

You now have a fantastic  
**Sparkler!**

Try making different colour sparklers! Green, orange, blue, red, pink! Whatever you like! Use glitter pens for added sparkle.



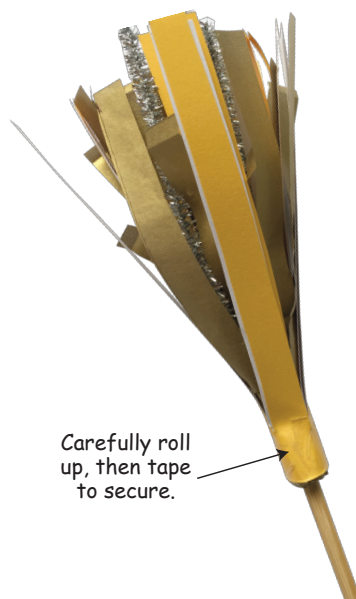
Glue the gold sheet to the yellow sheet by running glue along the uncut edge.



Tape the wooden stick here.

Tape folded tinsel pipe cleaners here.

Run glue along here.



Carefully roll up, then tape to secure.



Open out the strips.
