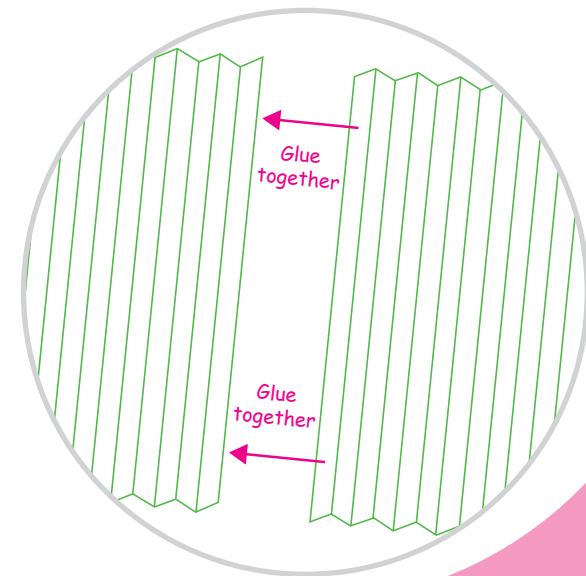
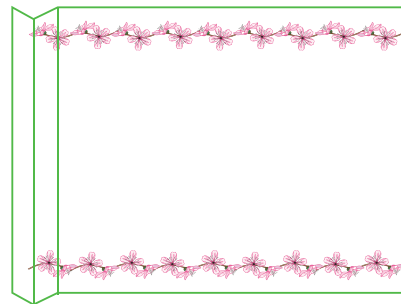


Make a Chinese Fan

Here's a fun way to make a Chinese fan.

Instructions

- 1 Draw your Chinese fan design across 2 A4 sheets of paper, having the paper landscape. **Note:** we are going to fold the pleated paper in half so draw your design on the top half of the paper then turn the sheet around and draw the next half of your design. Look at our designs to help you. Use pens, pencils or paints to colour it in. Alternatively print out the designs on Page 3 and 4 **TWICE**.
- 2 Pleat the 2 sheets of paper, folding over one side and then back the opposite way. Make the folds about 1½ cm wide. Use a ruler to start you off. We have marked 2 grey lines on our design sheets to help you with the first fold. Next stick the 2 sheets together as shown below.



You will need:

Scissors, double sided tape, glue,
2 sheets of white A4 paper, (or coloured
paper if you like), 2 lollipop sticks
(Or pencils if you don't have sticks).
Colouring in pens, pencils or paints.



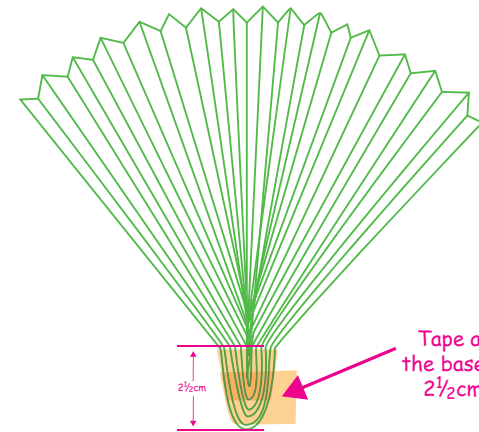
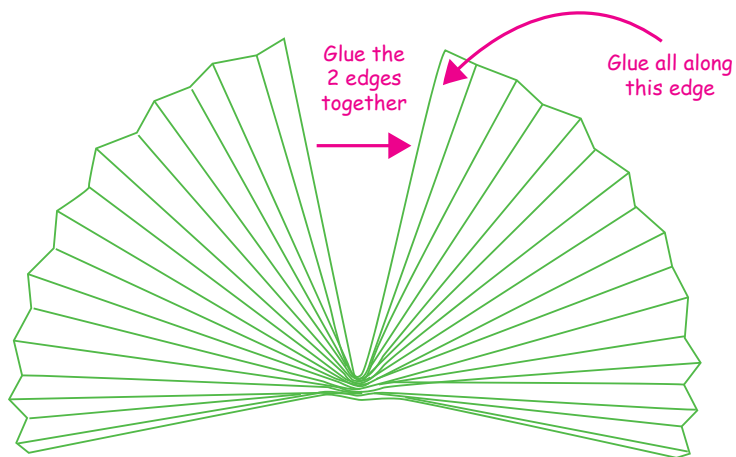

Fold in half



- 3 Now, with all pleats folded up together, fold the paper in half as shown.

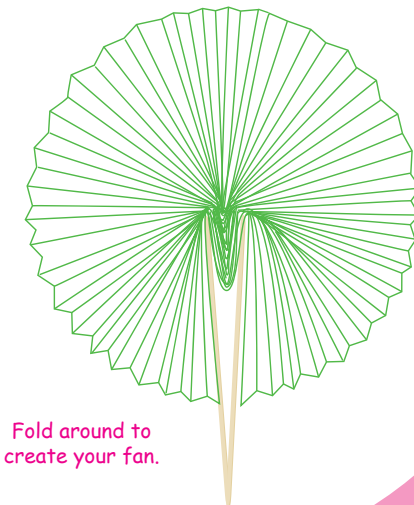
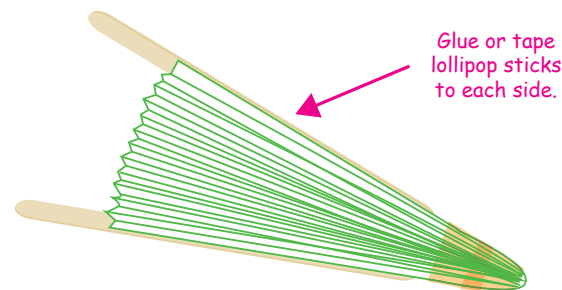
- 4 Pull the pleats together from the middle then glue them together.



- 5 Tape around the base about 2 1/2 cm high.

- 6 Glue, or use double sided sticky tape to attach a wooden lollipop stick or a pencil to each side of the fan, we used green pencils in our picture on page one. Stick them just above the taped end to create the handle. If using lollipop sticks you could paint them what every colour you like.

- 7 Twist the handles around to create your fan!
