



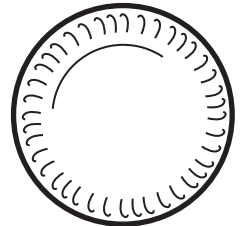
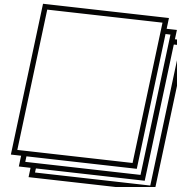
How To Make A Dragon Mask

You will need to ask your Mum or Dad to help you with this activity!

Instructions:

- 1 Cut coloured strips out of your card, 3cm wide and approximately 30cm long. Fold the strips down into squares to give a ruffled effect. Glue these paper strips around the edges of one plate.
- 2 Tape the lollipop stick to the back of this plate and glue the second paper plate to the back of the first plate so that the stick is in between the two plates.
- 3 Paint the dragon face template. Cut it out and glue on top of the jagged shape.
- 4 Experiment by attaching small craft bells and more ruffled paper strips to the plates. During the Chinese New Year (usually in January or February depending on the year) people celebrate over a 15 day period ending with the Lantern Festival when families celebrate in brightly coloured traditional dress and decorations. So, the more colours you use, the more authentic your mask will be!
- 5 In most cultures, dragons are considered to be evil or bad. In China, a dragon is considered to bring good luck.

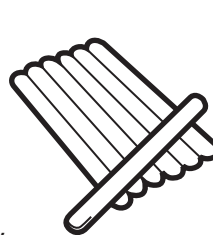
