Instructions

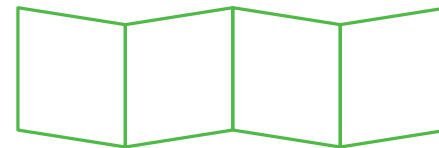

Print out the monkey's body, stick on to thin card and cut out. Cut out the coloured panels on page 5. Or, colour in the monkey's body and panels on page 6 and 7.



You will need

Scissors, glue, tape,
2 straws, thin card,
coloured pens,
or pencils.

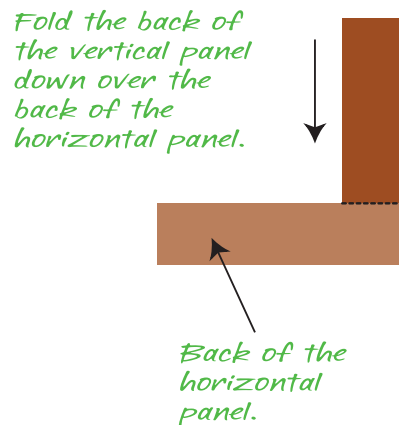
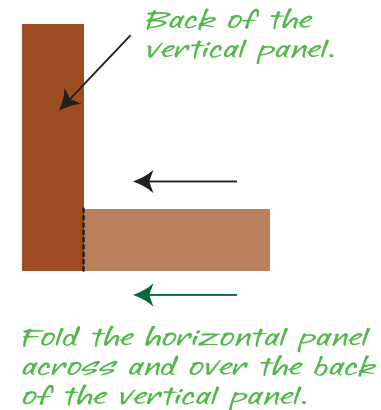
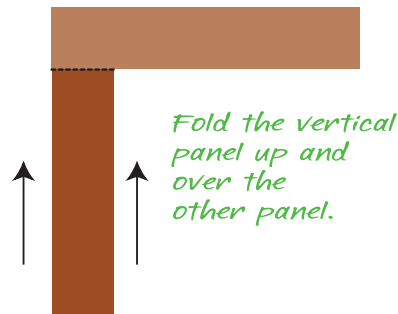
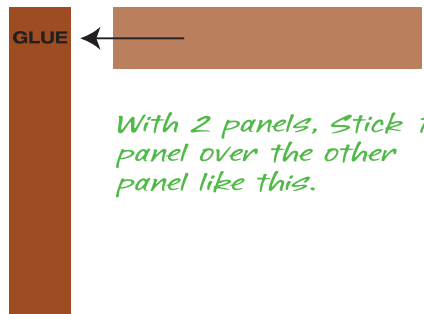
Making the monkey's bouncy body can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to concertina the paper panels in to squares. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**



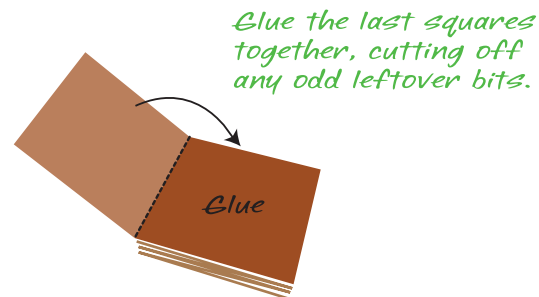

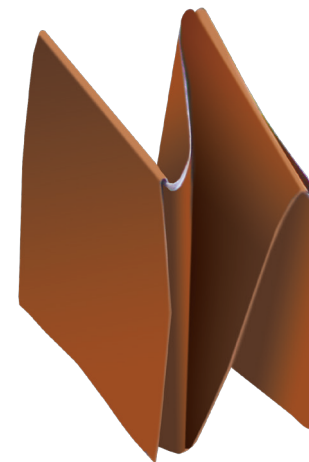
Alternatively try making the monkey's bouncy body like this. Stick panel A to the back of panel B. Do the same for the other panel. (You don't need to do this for the simple concertina body option). Now follow the instructions below. You will end up with 2 panels with colour on both sides.



Continue to do this until all the paper is used up.

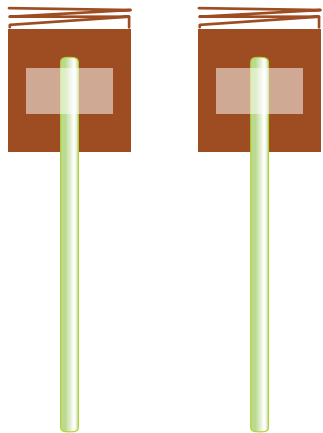


You will end up with a concertina shapes like this.

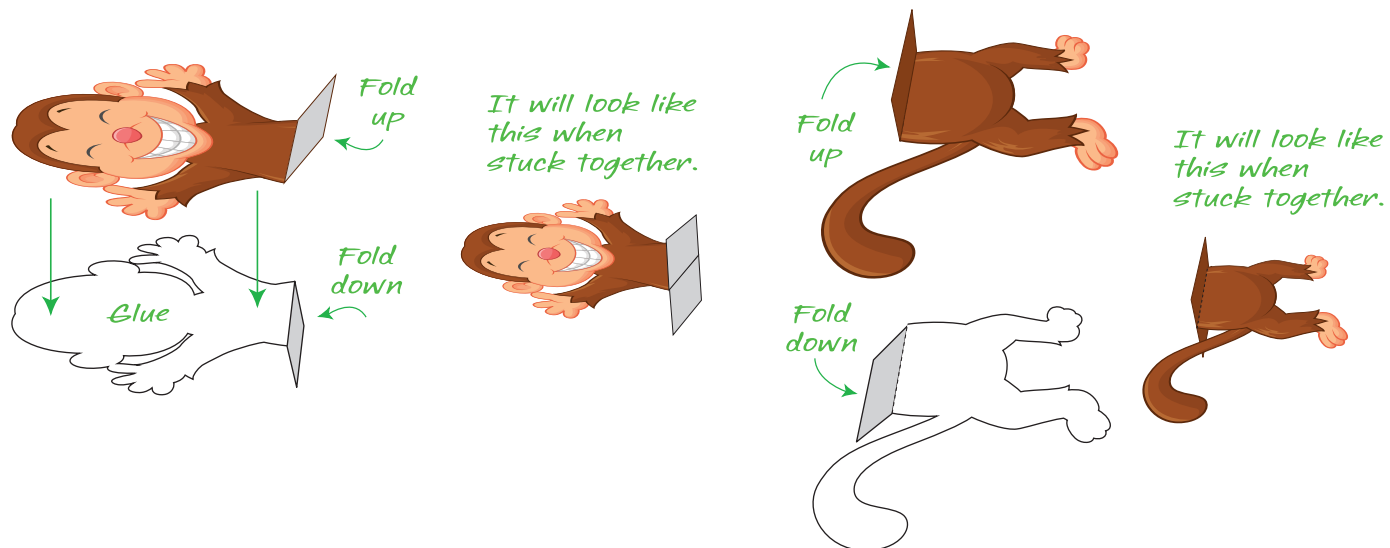


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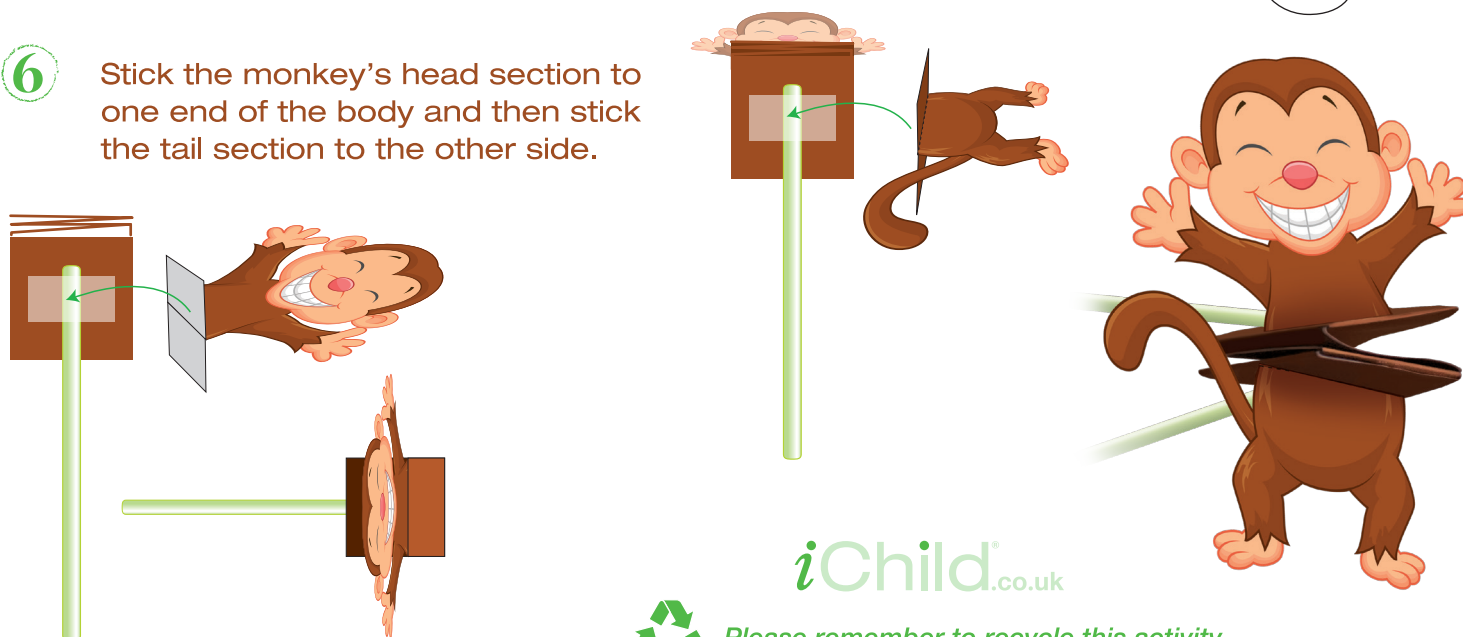
- 4 Tape straws to each end of the body. (One at each end).



- 5 Fold the flaps on the body cut outs, as shown below. Then stick the two sides together.



- 6 Stick the monkey's head section to one end of the body and then stick the tail section to the other side.

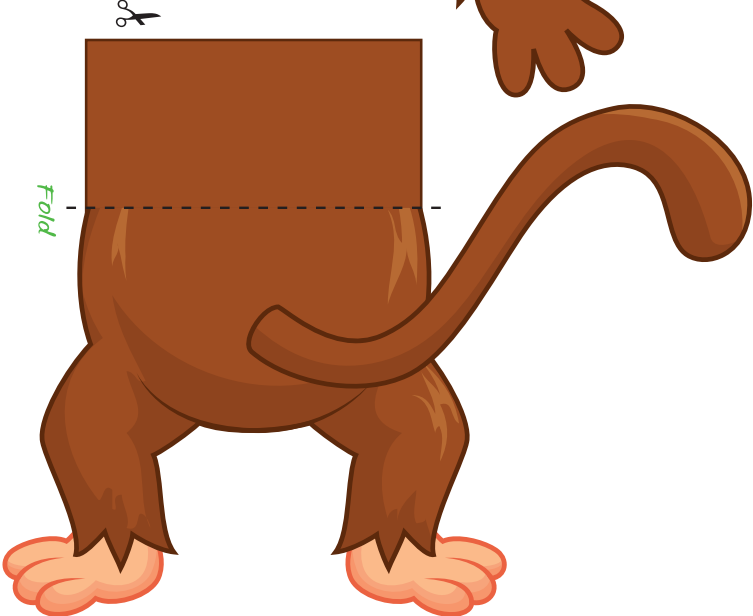
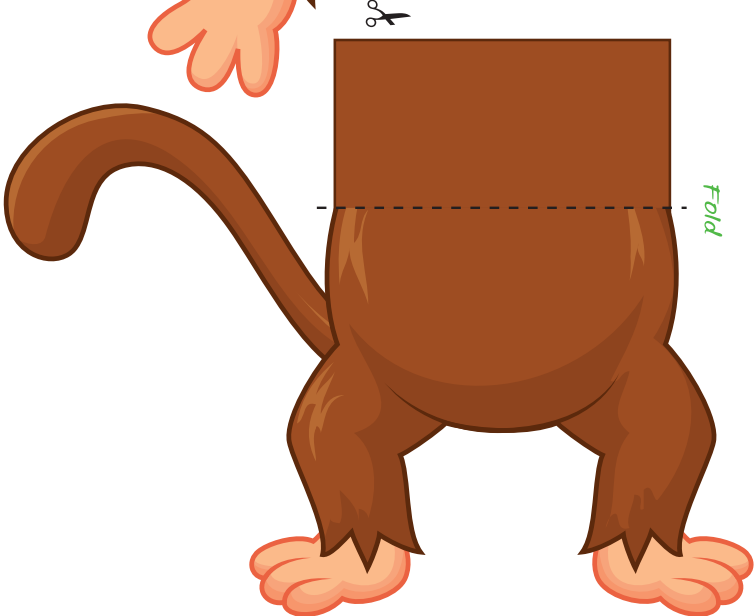
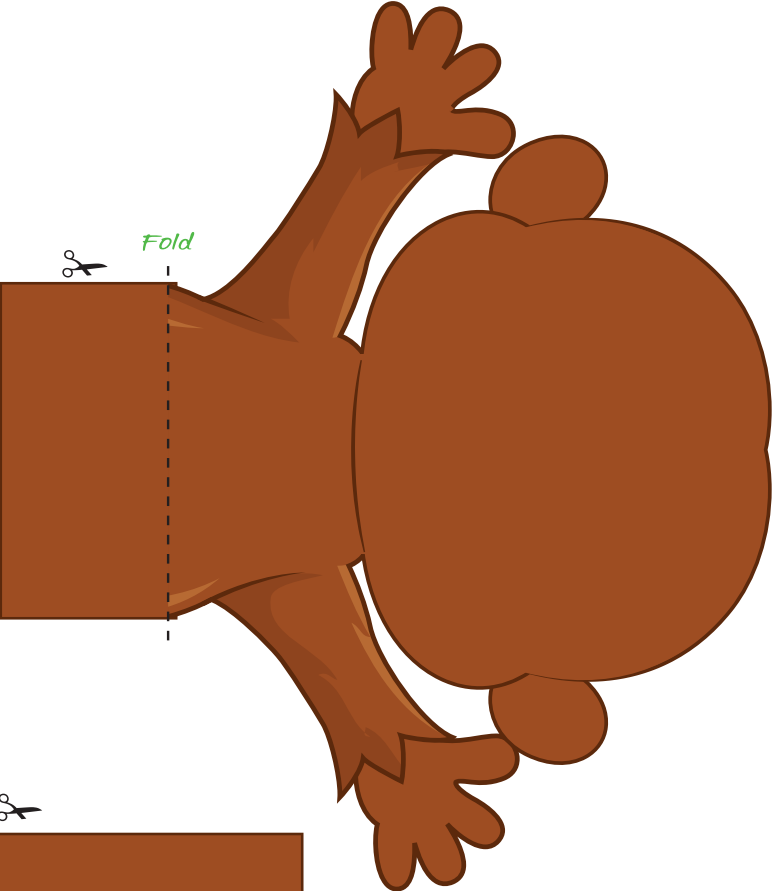
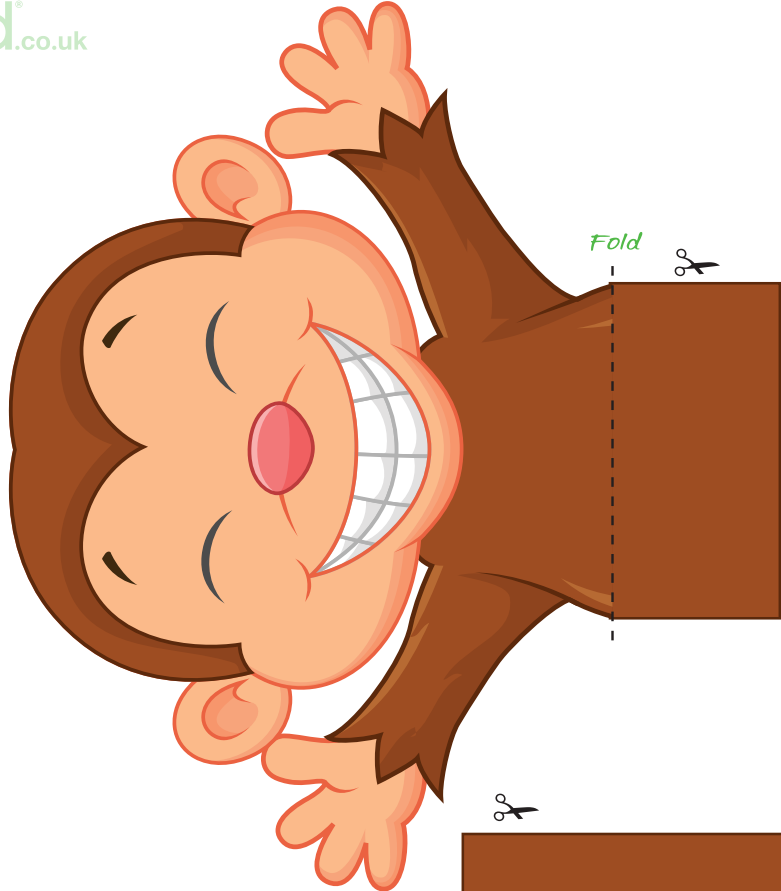


Now you have a fantastic monkey puppet!

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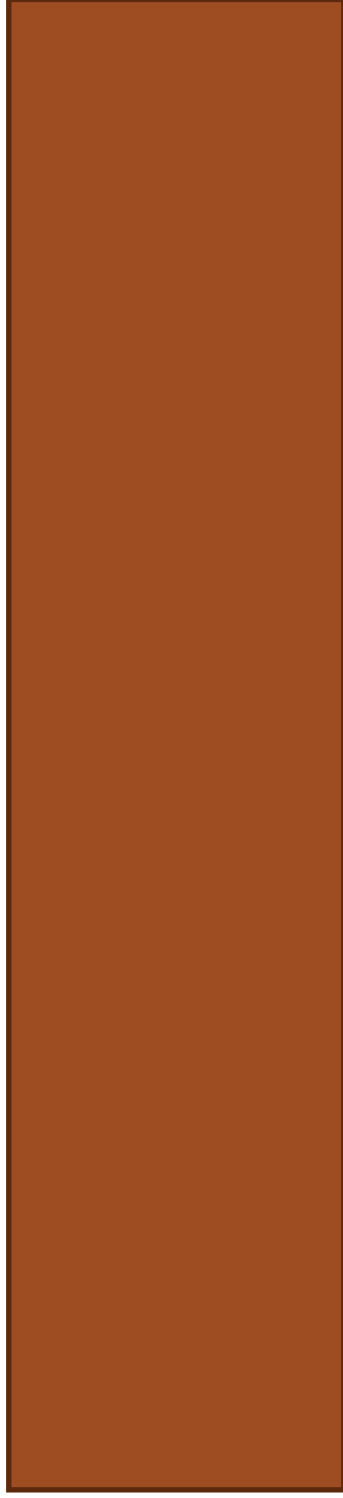
