

Rabbit puppet

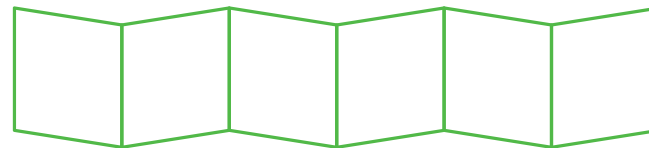
Here's a fun way to make a rabbit puppet.

You will need

Scissors, glue, tape, straws, coloured pens or pencils, cotton thread.

Instructions

- 1 Print out the rabbit's body and feet, stick onto card and cut them out. Cut out the coloured panels on page 5 and 6. Or colour in the rabbit body, feet and panels on page 4, 7 and 8. Stick the body and feet onto card and cut them and the panels out.



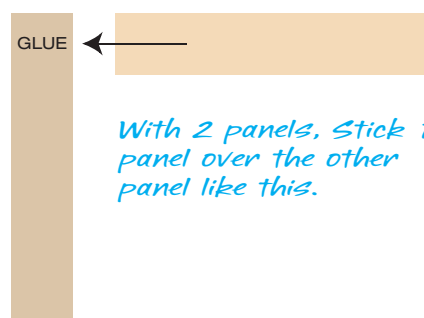
- 2 Making the rabbit's bouncy legs can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to concertina the paper panels in to squares measuring 20mm. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**



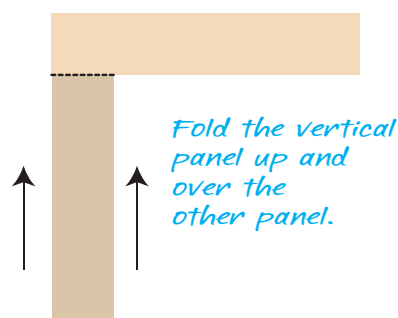

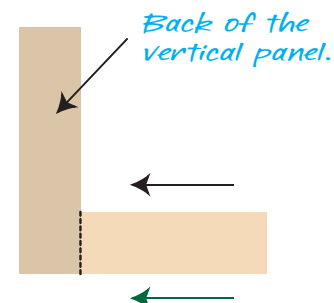
Alternatively try making the rabbit's bouncy legs like this. Stick panel A to the back of panel B. Do the same for the other panels. (You don't need to do this for the simple concertina body option). Now follow the instructions below. You will end up with 4 panels with colour on both sides.



With 2 panels, Stick 1 panel over the other panel like this.

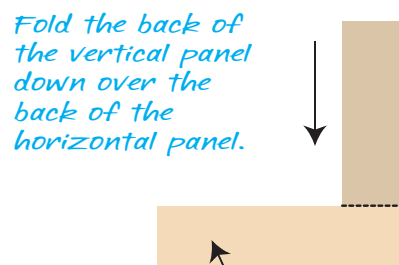


Fold the vertical panel up and over the other panel.

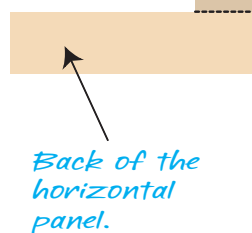


Back of the vertical panel.

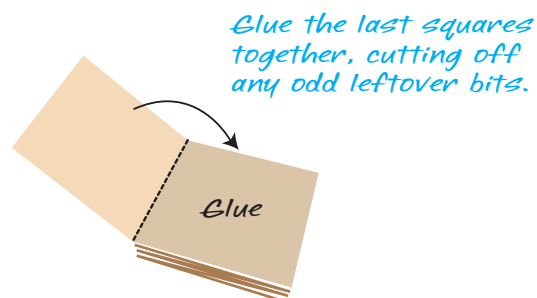
Fold the horizontal panel across and over the back of the vertical panel.



Fold the back of the vertical panel down over the back of the horizontal panel.



Continue to do this until all the paper is used up.

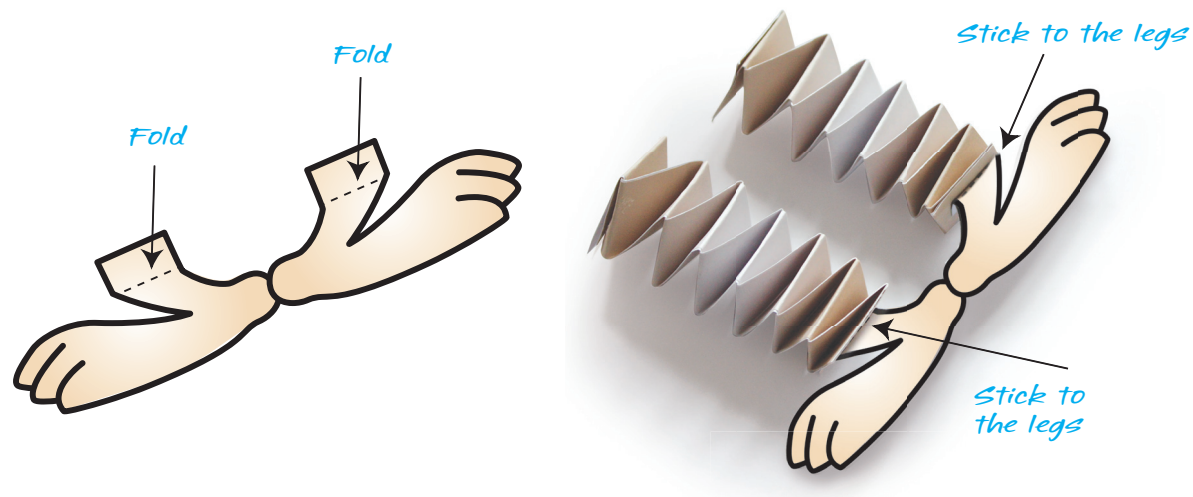


Repeat with the other 2 panels. You will end up with a 2 concertina shapes like this.

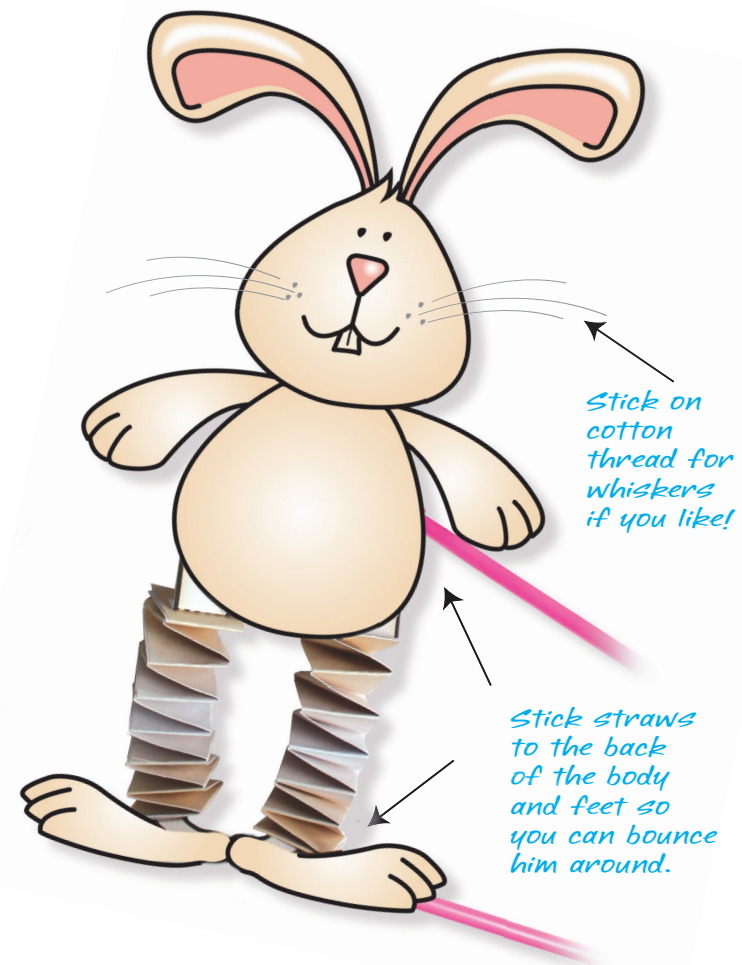
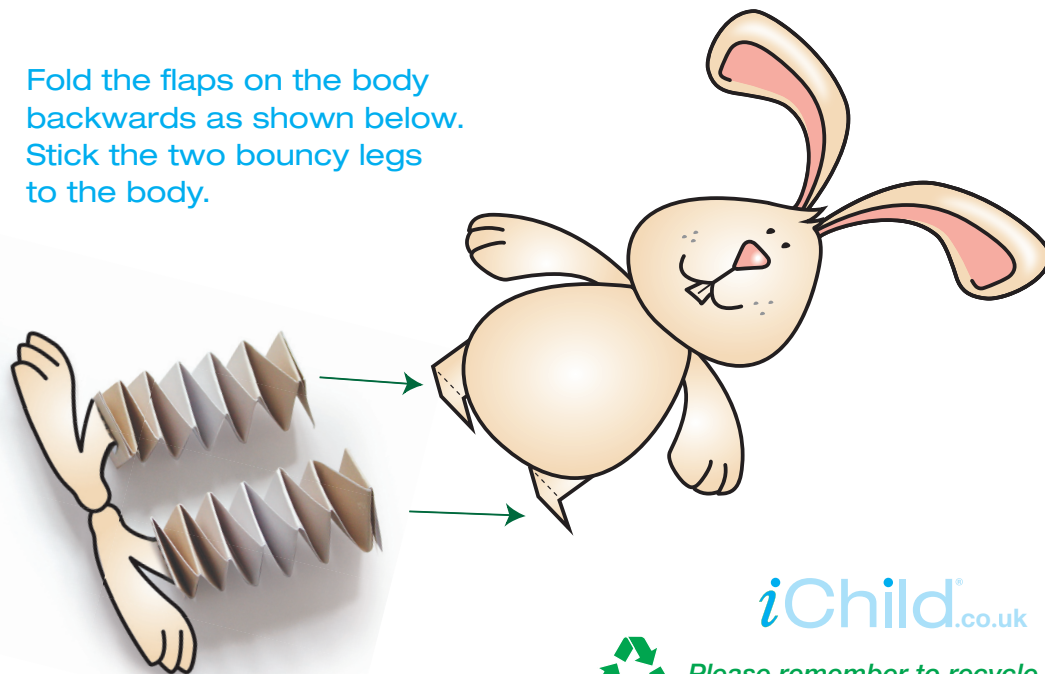

- 4 Fold the flaps on the feet backwards as shown below.
Stick the two bouncy legs to the feet.



- 5 Fold the flaps on the body backwards as shown below.
Stick the two bouncy legs to the body.

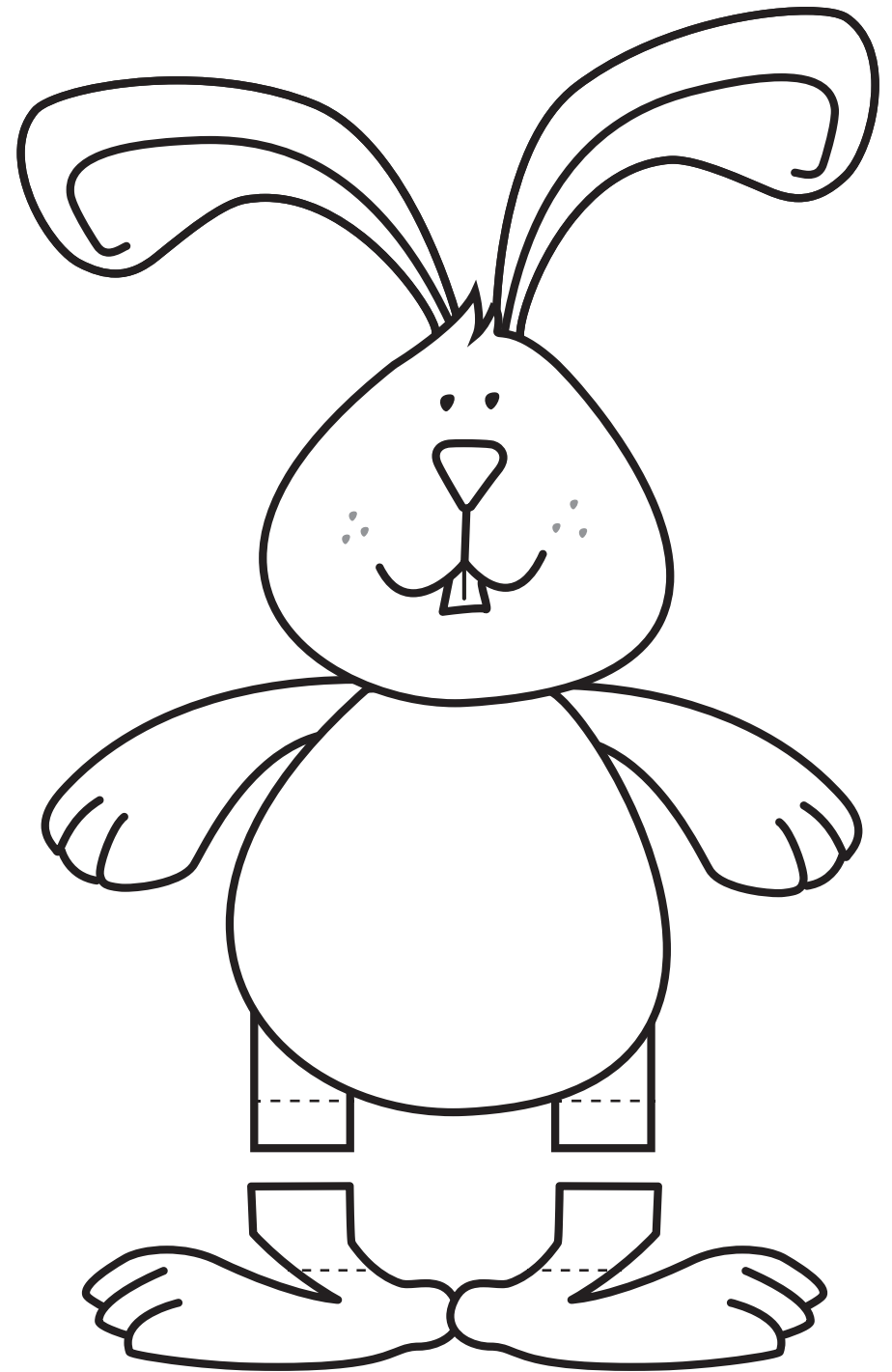
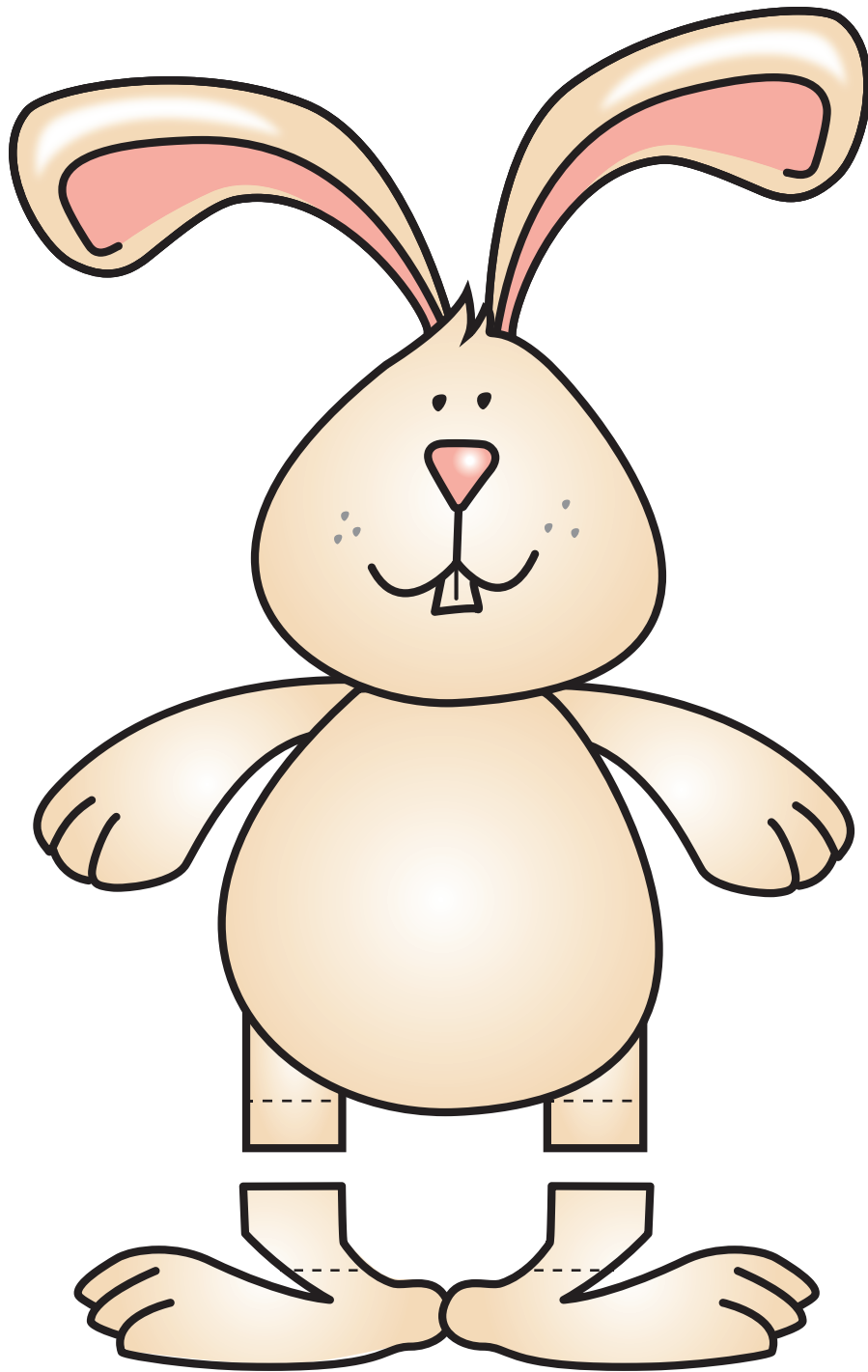

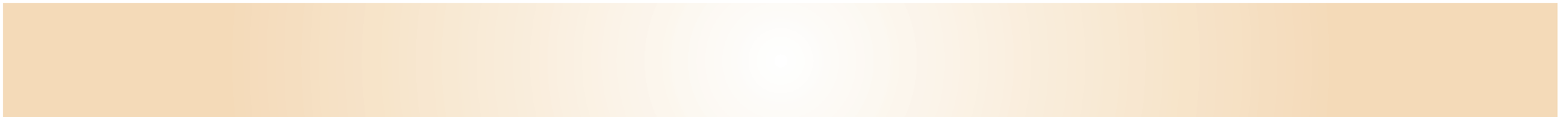
