

# Chinese Rooster Puppet

Here's a fun way to make a rooster puppet.

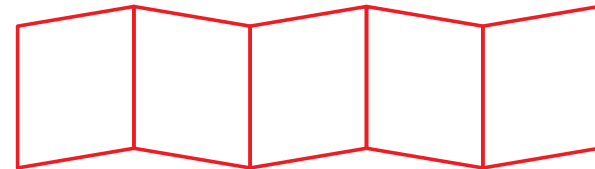
## You will need:

Scissors, glue, tape,  
2 yellow straws,  
coloured pens  
or pencils.



## Instructions

- 1 Print and cut out the rooster and coloured panels on pages 4, 5 and 6. Or colour in and cut out the rooster and panels on pages 7, 8 and 9.

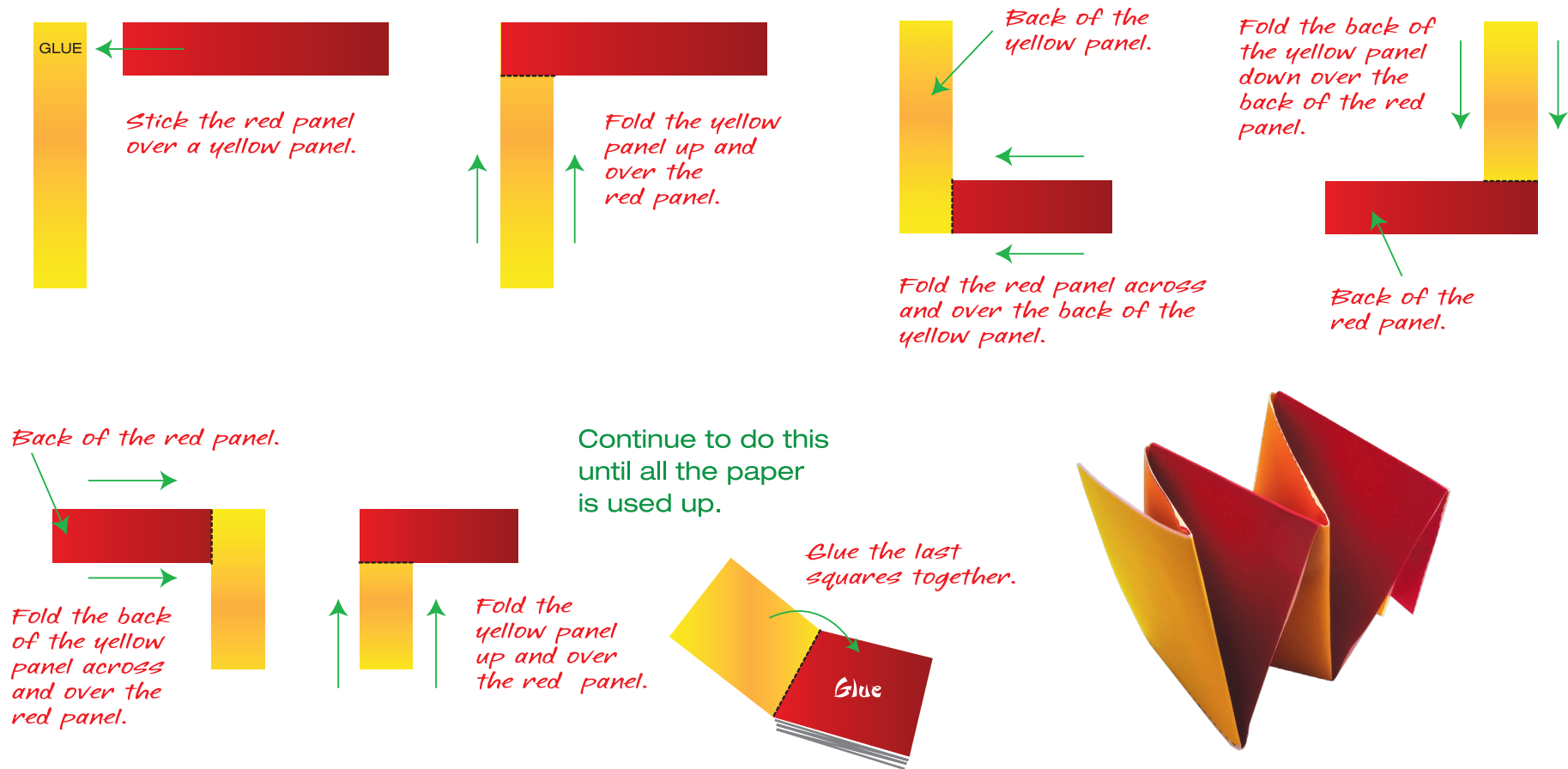


- 2 Making the rooster's neck can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to stick the red panels together then concertina the paper into squares measuring 50mm. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**

- 3** Alternatively try making the rooster's neck like this. Stick the red panels together, then the yellow panels (ie glue white side to white side, so both sides of the panel are red and yellow when glued together. You don't need to do this for the simple concertina body option). Now follow the instructions below.

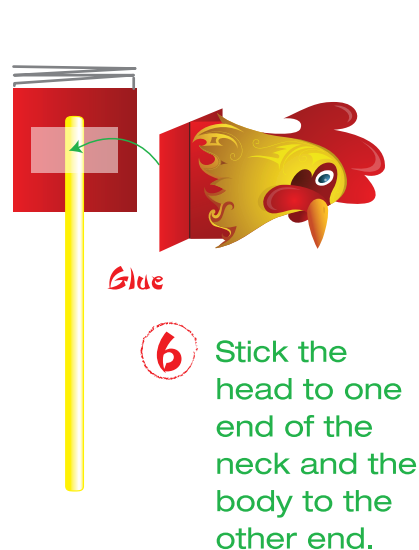
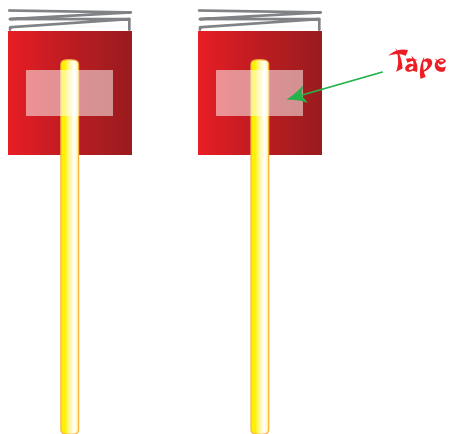


You will end up with a concertina shape like this.

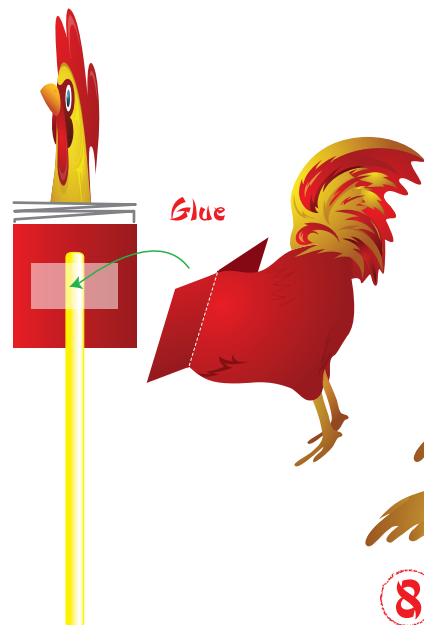

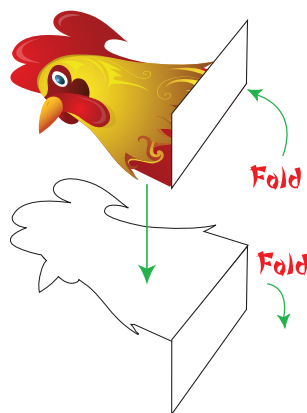
- 4 Tape straws to each end of the concertina shape (one at each end).



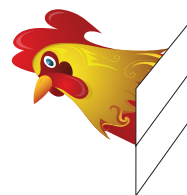
- 6 Stick the head to one end of the neck and the body to the other end.



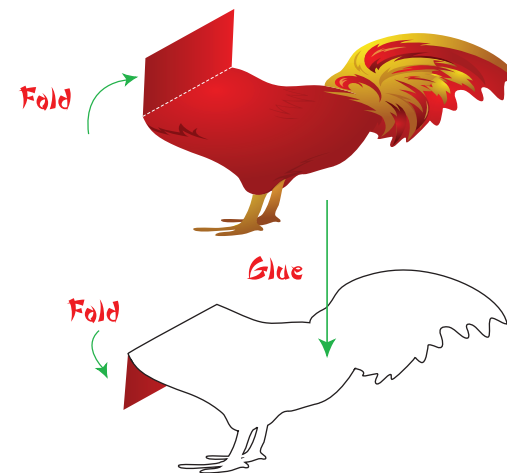
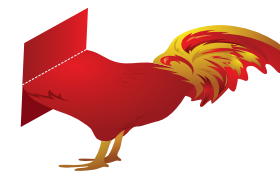
- 5 Fold the flaps on the head and body cut outs, as below. Stick the two heads together and the two bodies together.



*It will look like this when stuck together.*

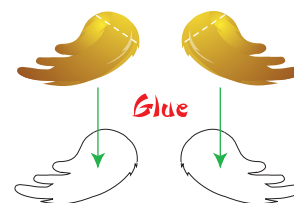

- 7 For the wings, glue the backs onto the fronts for both.



- 9 Glue the wings to the puppet.

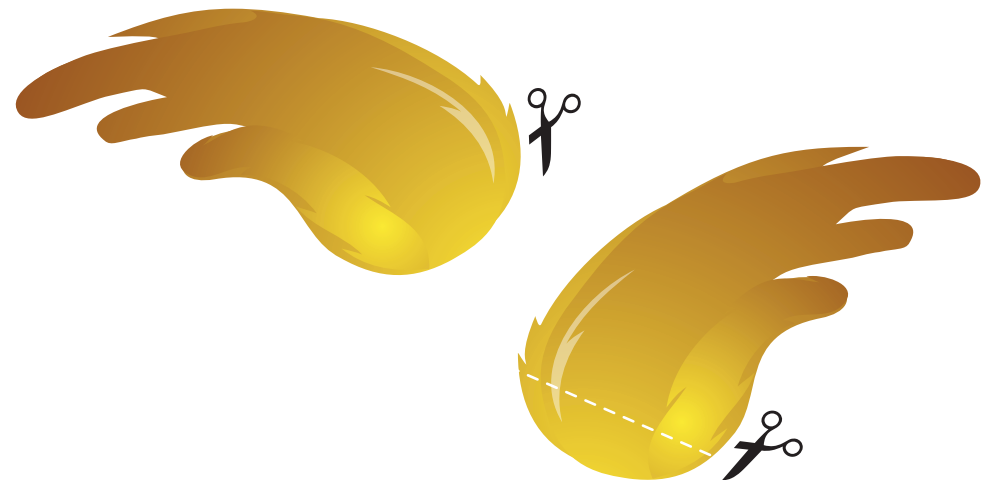
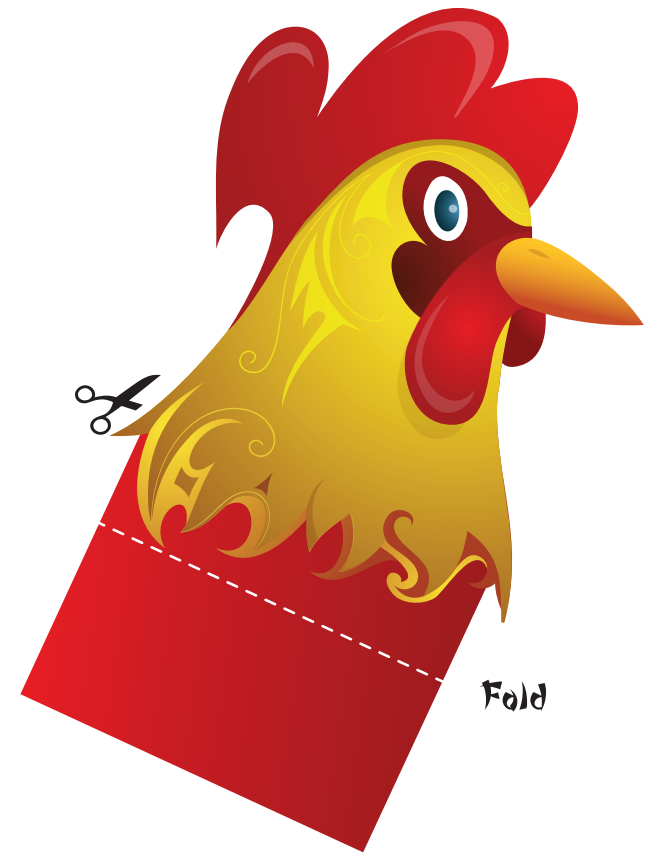
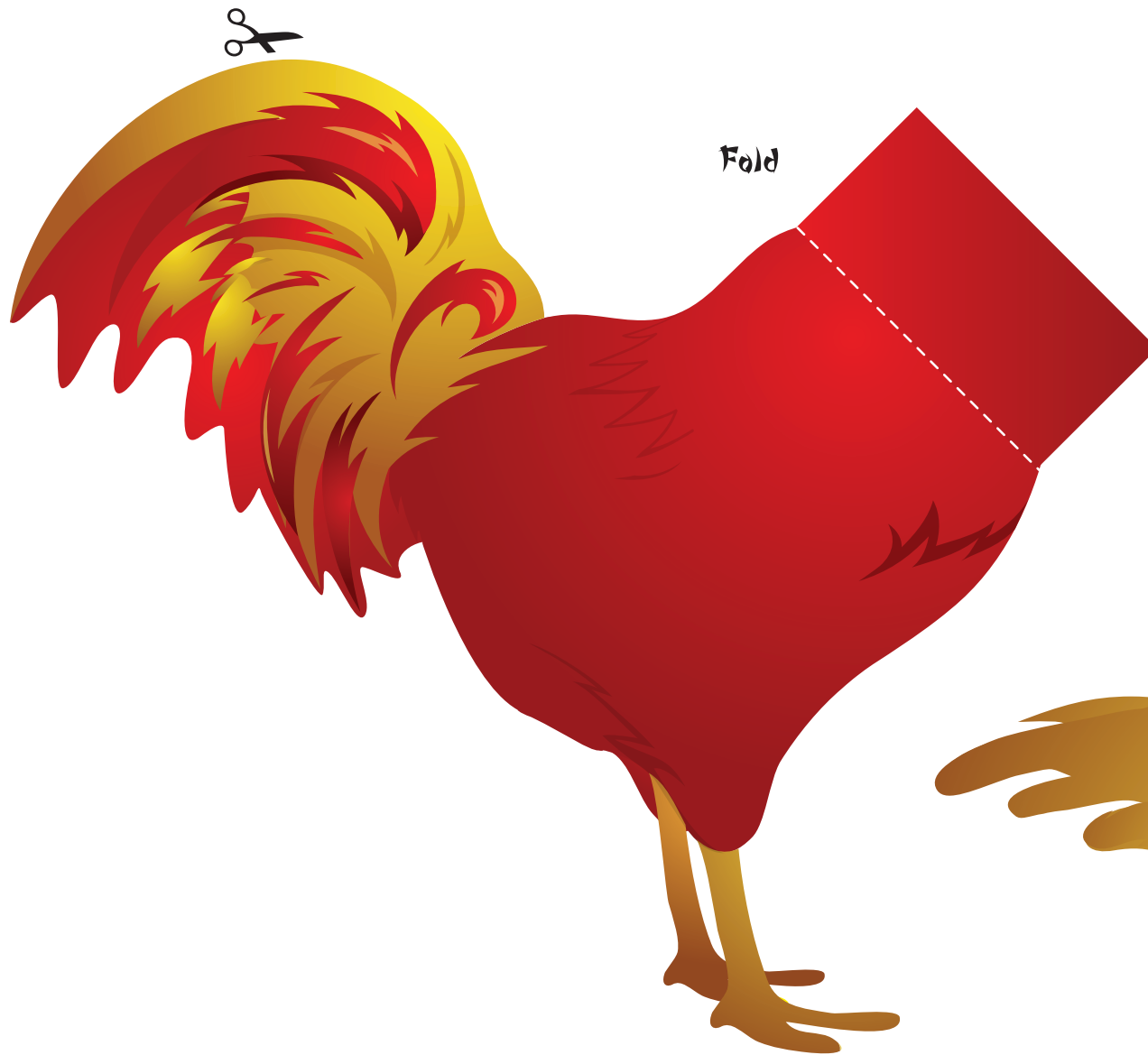


- 8 Fold the dotted lines backward on both wings

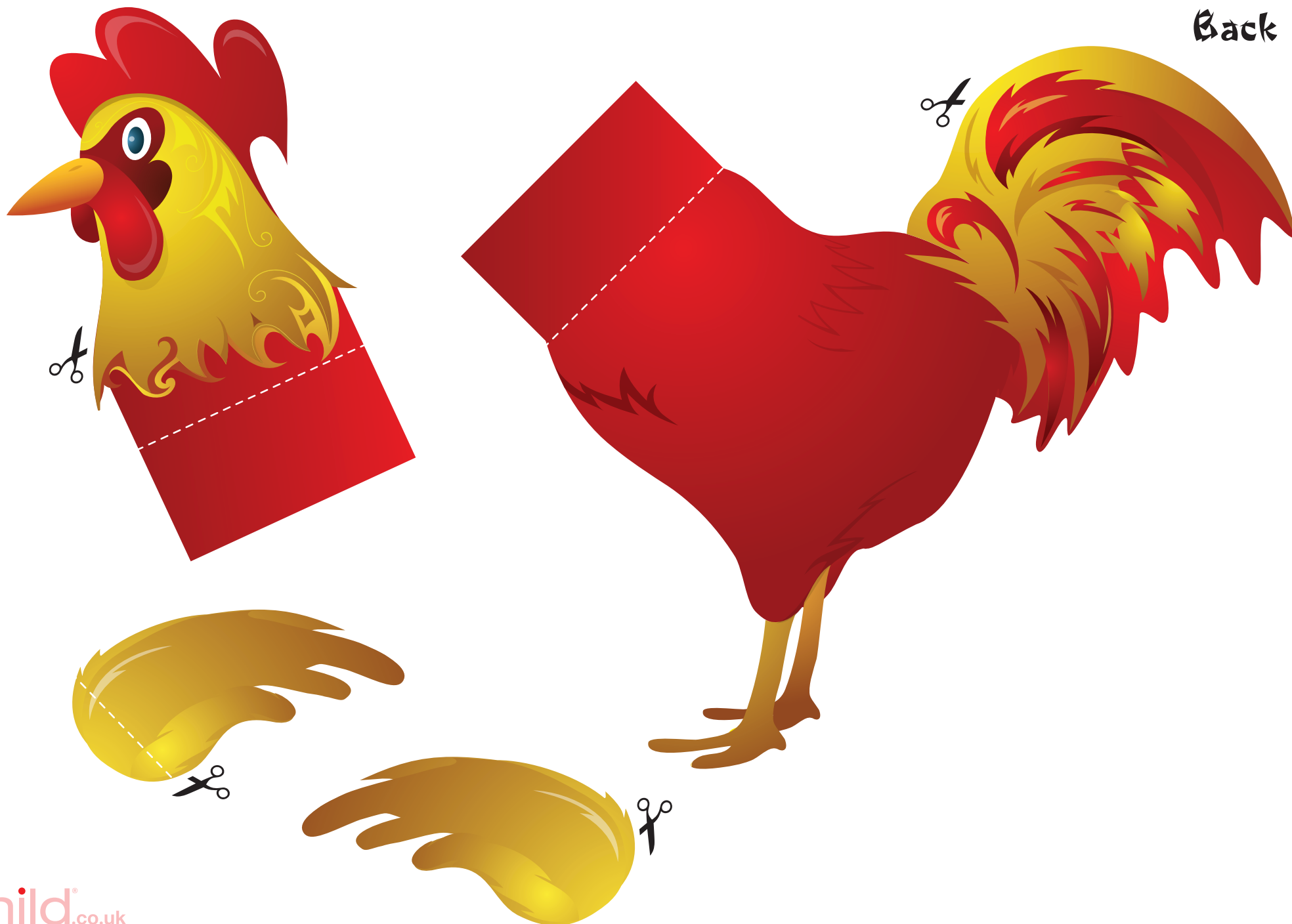

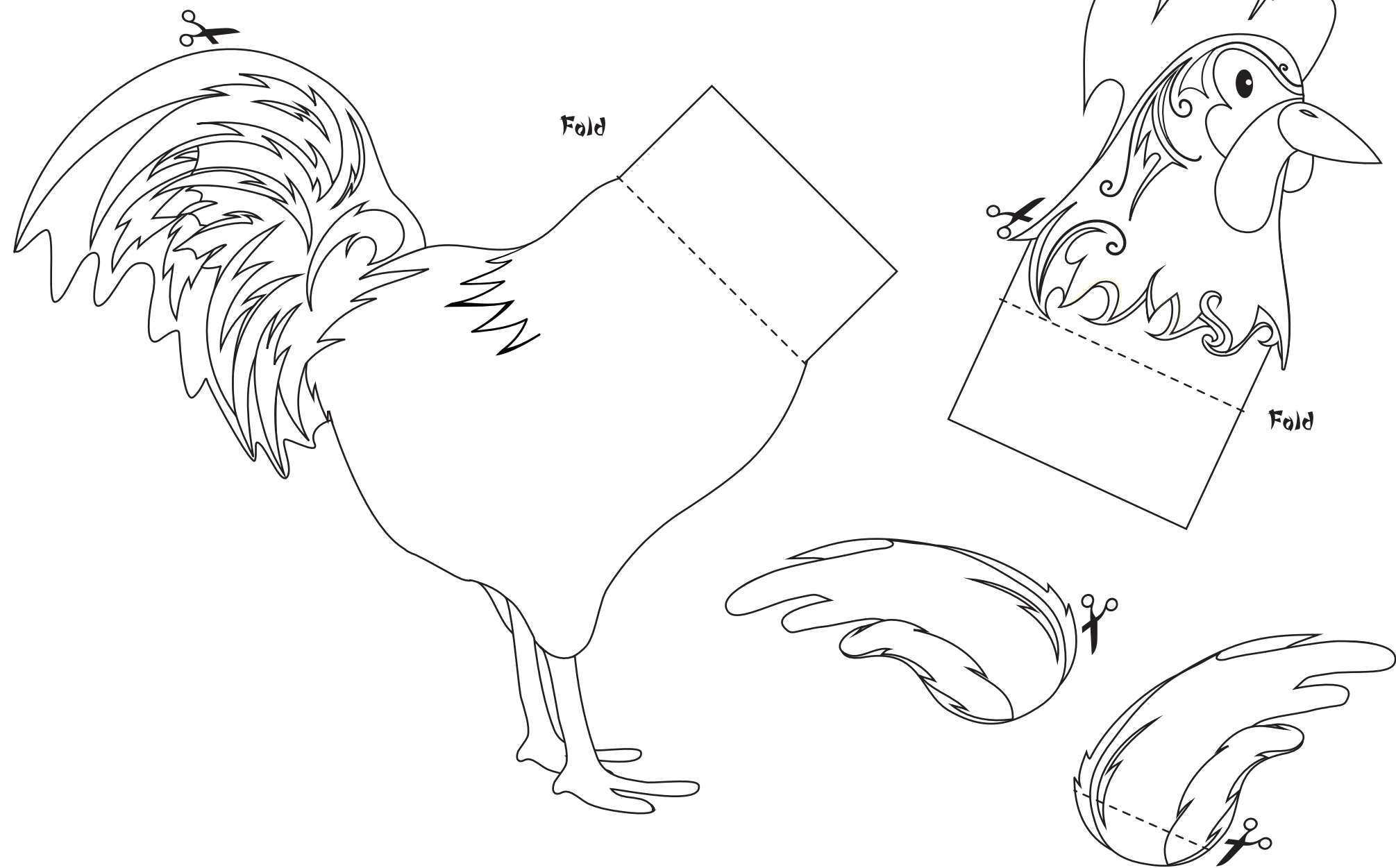

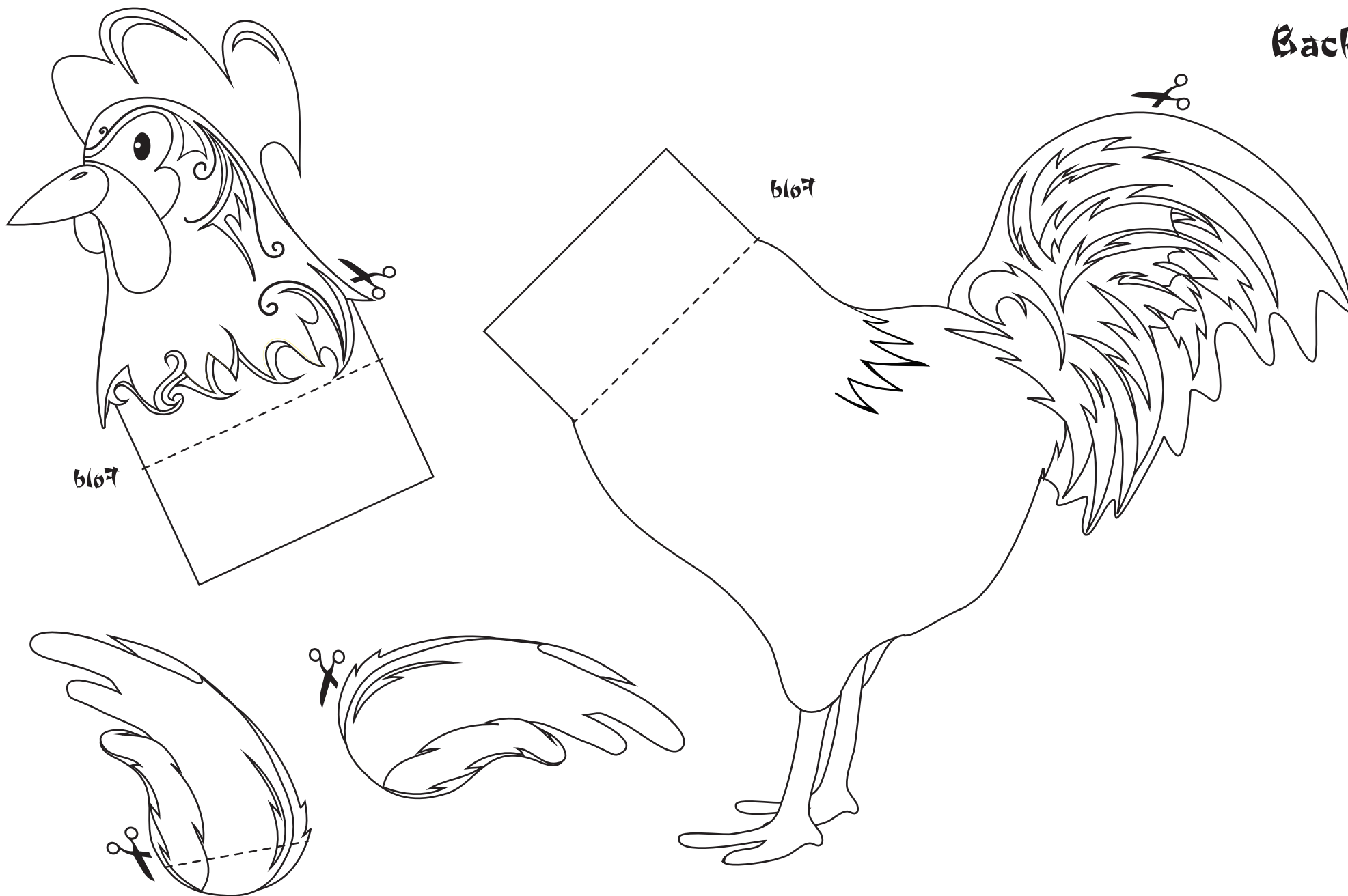
