Here's a fun way to make a sheep puppet.



You will need

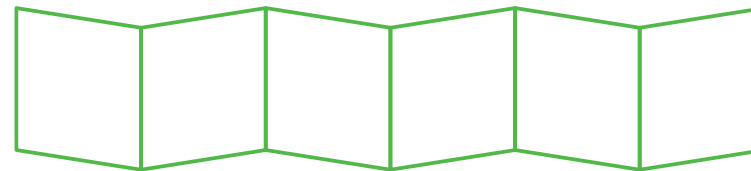
Scissors, glue,
tape, straws.

Optional

Coloured pens
or pencils.

Instructions

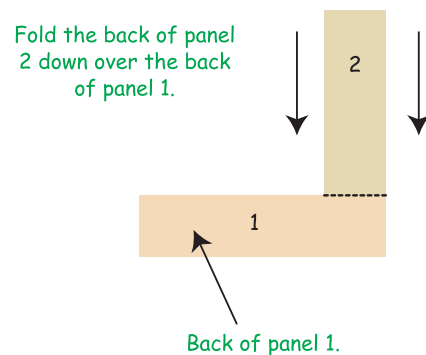
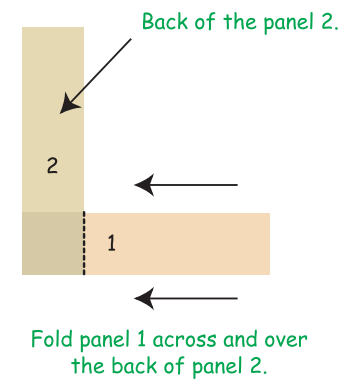
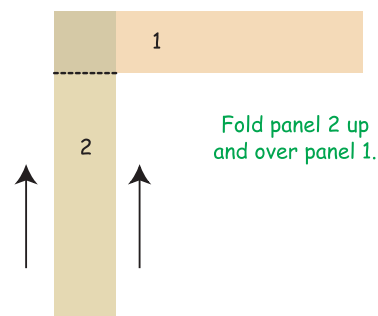
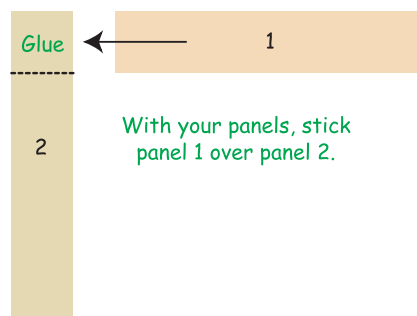
- 1 Print out the sheep parts and coloured panels on page 4, 5 and 6. Or colour in the sheep parts and panels on page 7, 8 and 9.
- 2 Making the sheep's concertina body can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to concertina one of the paper panels into squares measuring 50mm. If there is a little bit of panel left over on the last square cut it off. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**



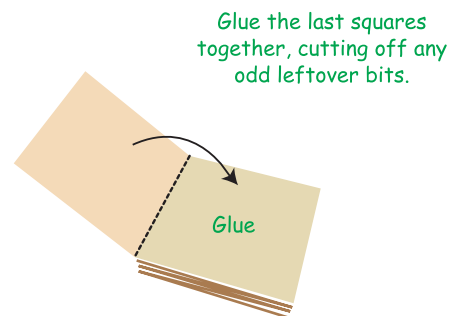

Alternatively try making the sheep's body like this. Stick the coloured panels together (ie so you have a front and back the same colour. (You don't need to do this for the simple concertina body option). Now follow the instructions below.



Continue to do this until all the paper is used up.

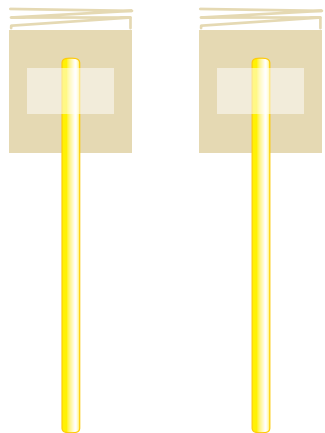


You will end up with a concertina shape like this.

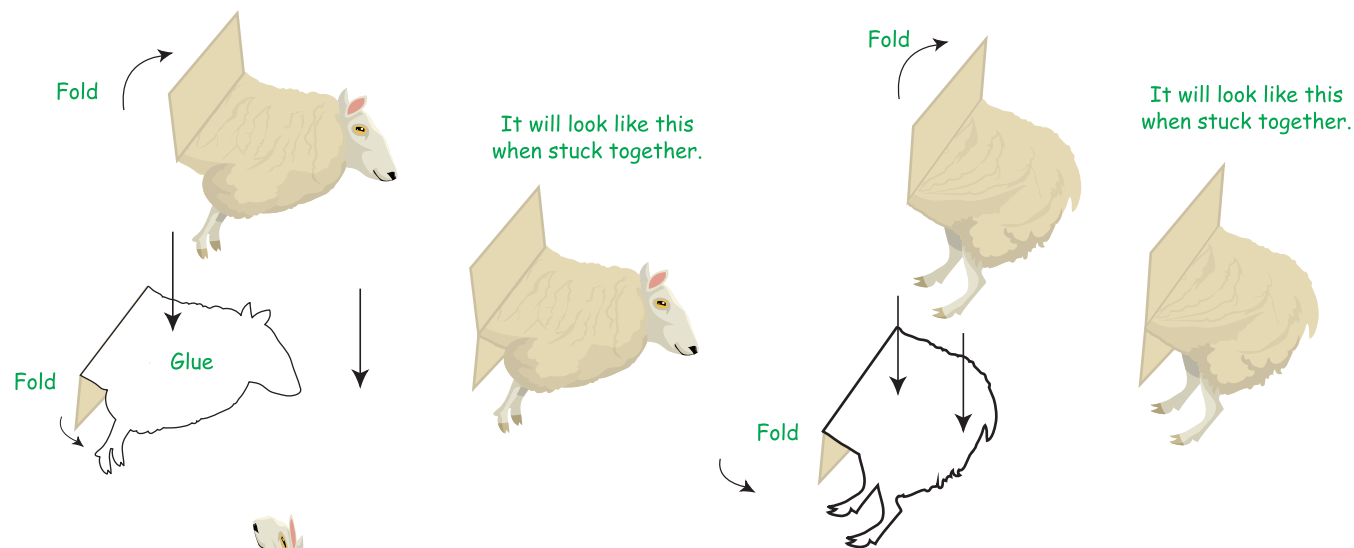


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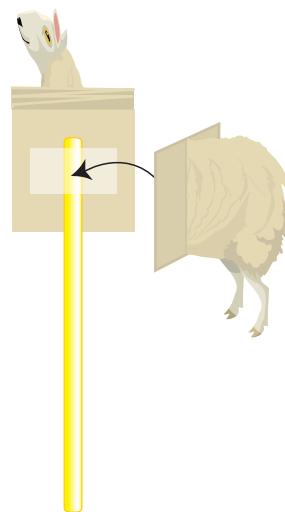
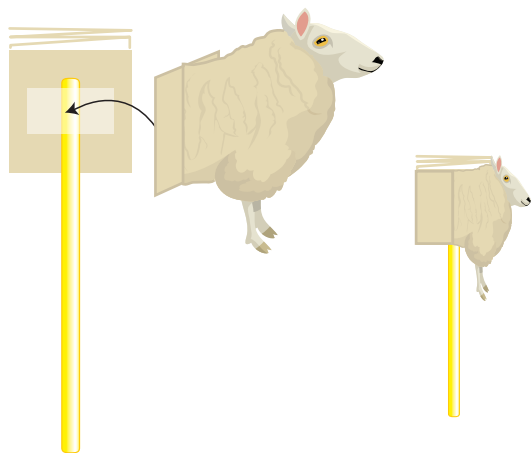
- 4 Tape straws to each end of the body. (One at each end).



- 5 Fold the flaps on the head and tail cut outs as below. Stick the two heads together and the two tails together.



- 6 Stick the head to one end of the body and the tail to the other.



Now you have a fantastic
sheep puppet!

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
