

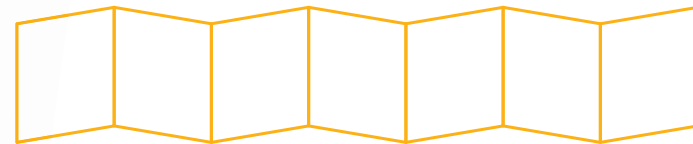
Tiger puppet



Here's a fun way to make a tiger puppet.

You will need:

Scissors,
Glue,
Tape,
Straws,
Coloured pens or pencils.



Instructions

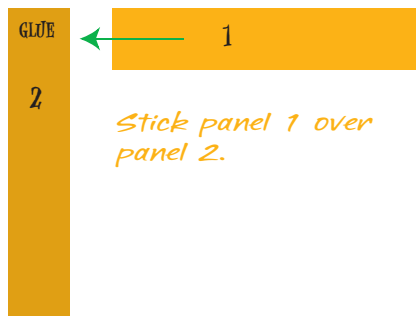
- 1 Print and cut out the tiger parts, and the coloured panels on page 4 and 5. Or colour in and cut out the tiger parts and panels on page 6 and 7.

- 2 Making the tiger's concertina body can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to stick 2 panels together, then concertina the paper into squares measuring 50mm. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**

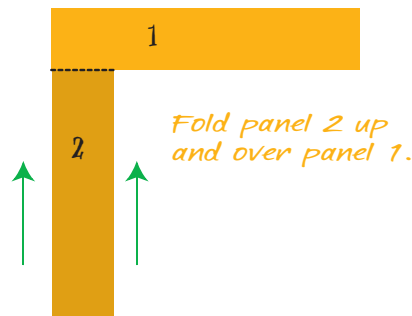

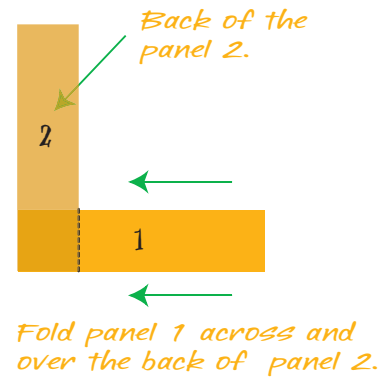
- 3 **Alternatively try making the tiger's body like this.** Stick the coloured panels together (ie so you have a front and a back). Now follow the instructions below.



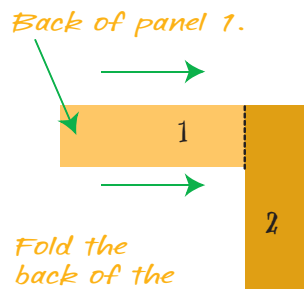
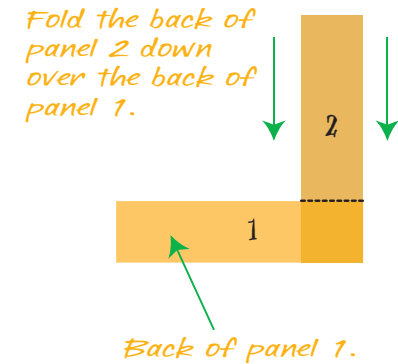
Stick panel 1 over panel 2.



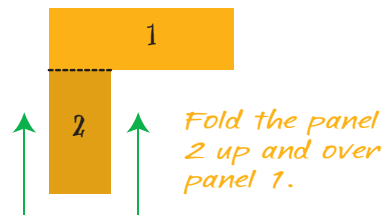
Fold panel 2 up and over panel 1.



Fold panel 1 across and over the back of panel 2.



Fold the back of the panel 1 across and over panel 2.



Fold the panel 2 up and over panel 1.

Continue to do this until all the paper is used up.

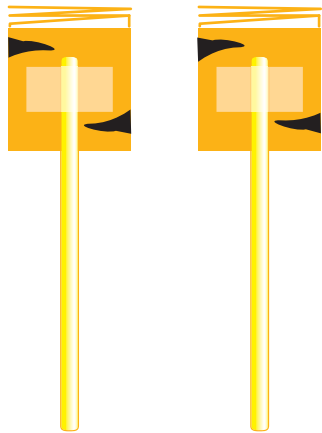


You will end up with a concertina shape like this.

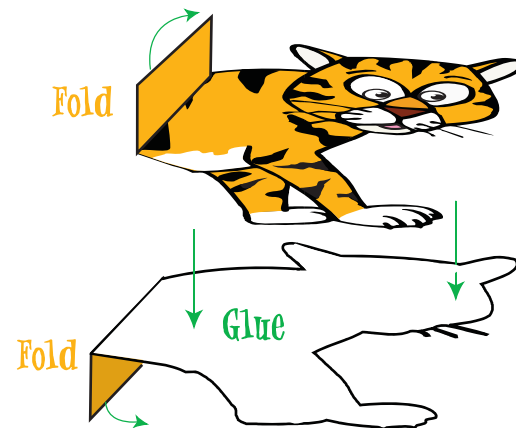


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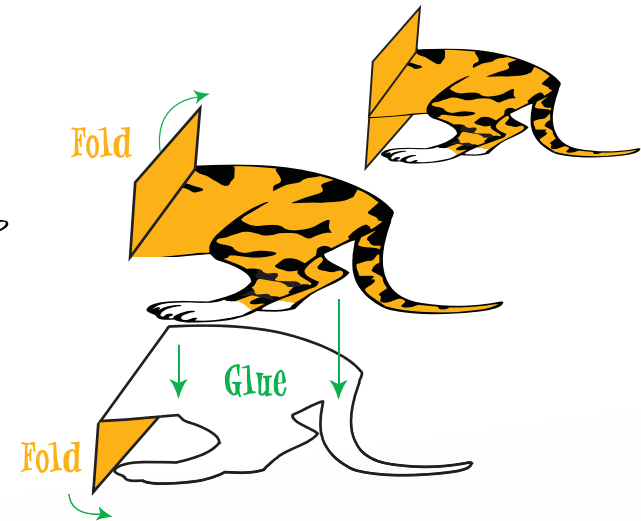
- ④ Tape straws to each end of the body. (One at each end).



- ⑤ Fold the flaps on the head end and tail end cut outs, as below. Stick the two head ends together and the two tails ends together.

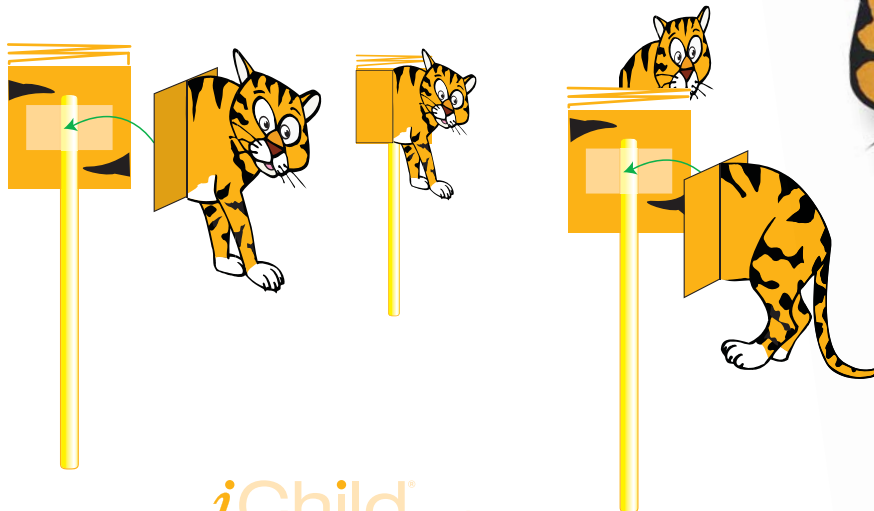


It will look like this when stuck together.

- ⑥ Stick the head end of the body to one end of the concertina body and the tail end to the other.



Now you have a fantastic tiger puppet!
