

Make a Leek Character Craft

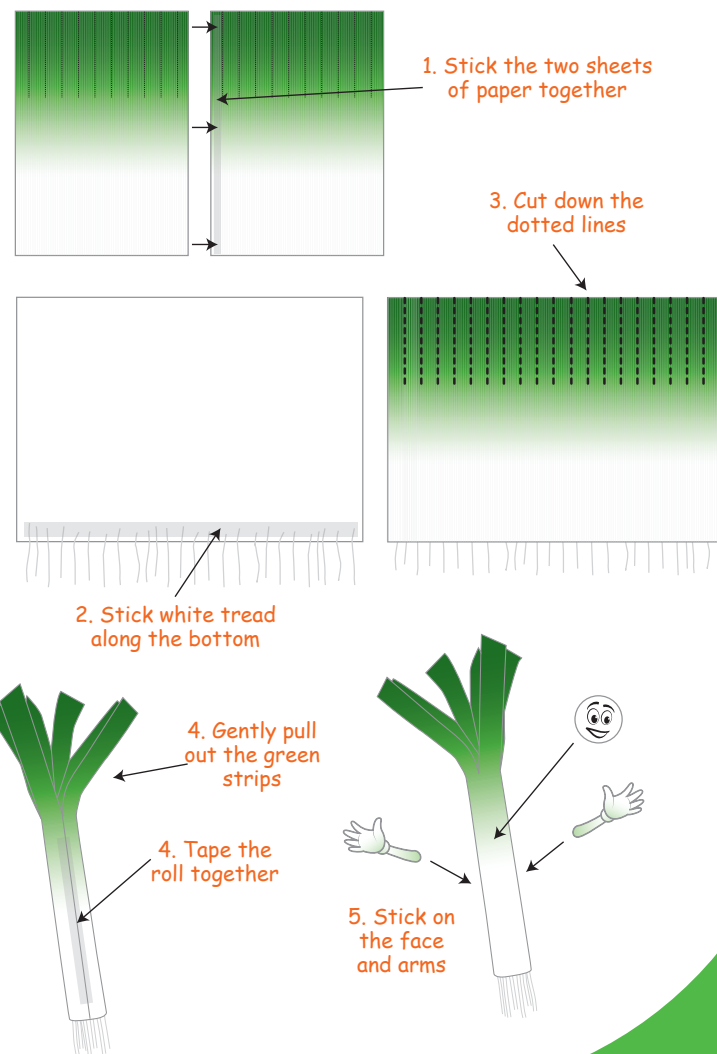
Here's a fun way to make a leek character.

Instructions

- ① Print the next page twice. Cut off any white edges. Place the pages side by side (green at the top, white at the bottom) to make one wide sheet. Alternatively use an A3 sheet of white paper, landscape, and colour the top half green.
- ② Turn the sheet over, right to left, so the green is still at the top but facing the table. Cut 25-30 lengths of white thread roughly 10mm long. Stick the thread along the bottom edge of the sheet.
- ③ Cut along the dotted lines on the front of the sheet.
- ④ Loosely roll the sheet up and tape the roll together. Gently curve out the green strips.
- ⑤ Print page 3. Cut out the arms and your chosen face. Or draw your own face in one of the blank circles. With the taped edge at the back stick the face on the front. Stick arm A on the left side and arm B on the right.

You will need:

Printer paper, scissors, tape, glue, and white thread.

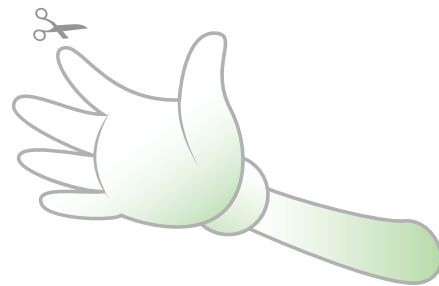
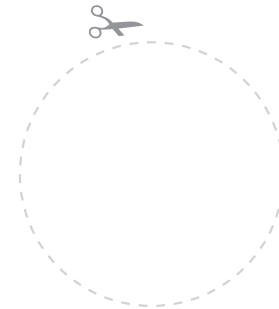
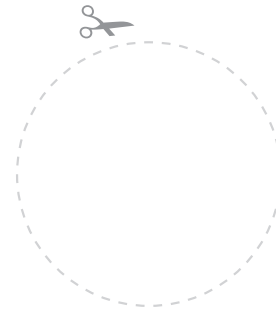
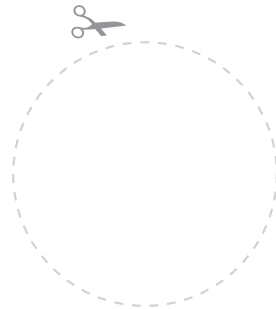
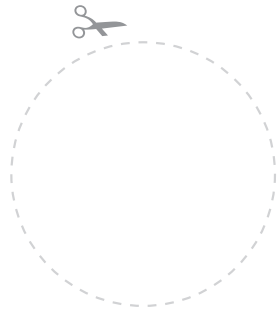
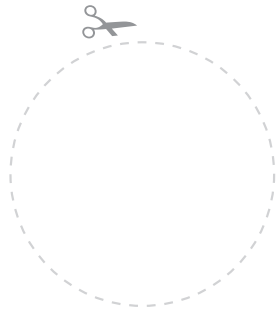
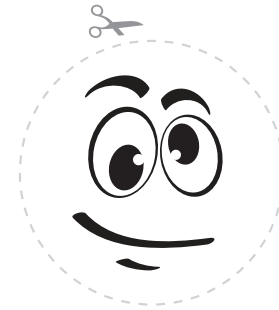
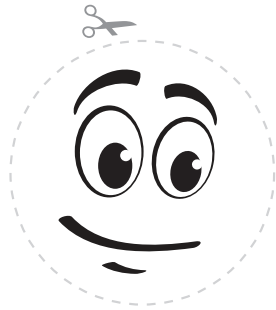

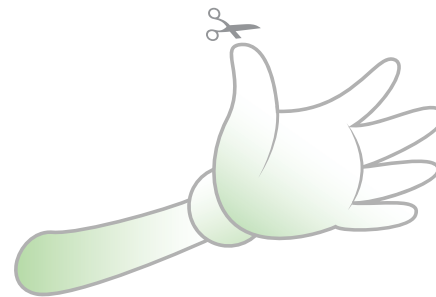
