

Make a Rose Craft

Here's a fun way to make a rose.

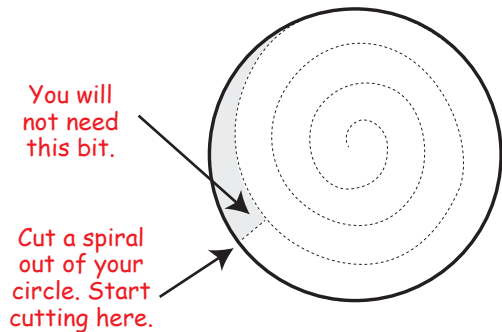


You will need

*Red paper,
green paper,
scissors,
green flexible straw
and PVA glue.*

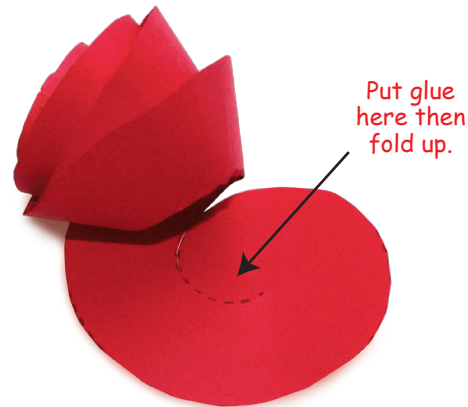
Instructions

- 1** Cut a circle out of red paper. We've used a circle that has a diameter of 150mm.
- 2** Draw a spiral, or you can print the template on page 3 onto coloured paper. We've used red but you could use, pink, white or yellow. Alternatively, use the coloured sheet on page 4.
- 3** Cut along the spiral line until you get to the middle.
- 4** Start rolling up the spiral from the outside in until it's all wound up. Keep it tight for now so it's easier to roll up.

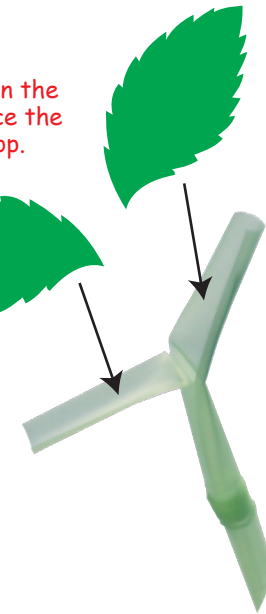

- 5 Once it's rolled up, let it unwind until it starts to look like a rose. Then put some glue on the round end that's left and fold it up to stick to the bottom. (This is a bit fiddly, you may need an adult to help.) Hold it for a few minutes then put aside to dry.
- 6 Cut down the sides of your green flexible straw, about 20mm. Then fold the sides down.
- 7 Print and cut out the leaves from page 4 (or draw your own leaves on green paper and cut them out). Glue them to the folded down sides of the straw as shown.
- 8 Put some glue on the leaves and stick to the underside of the rose. Leave to dry.
- 9 Once the glue is dry bend the straw a little. You can make bigger roses by making your circle bigger at the beginning, see step 1.



Cut straw down the sides then place the leaves on top.



You now have a fantastic
Rose!
