

St. George's Day Craft

Here's a fun way to make a St. George's Day craft.



You will need:

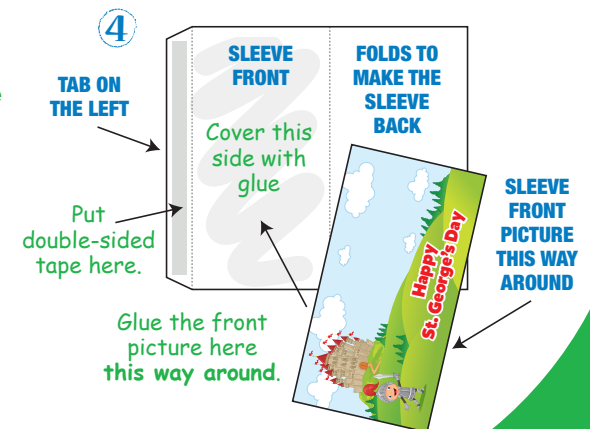
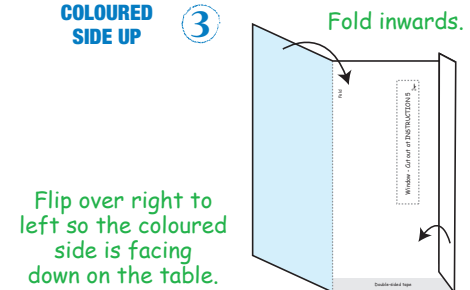
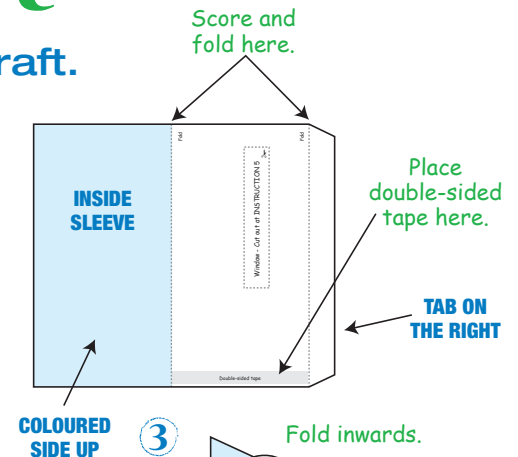
3 sheets of A4 thin printer card, scissors, craft knife for cutting the window, glue stick, half inch double-sided tape small square of corrugated cardboard or a sticky foam square and a ruler for scoring the card.

Instructions

- 1 Print pages 3 to 5 on to printer card.
- 2 Cut out the black dotted line for the tab on page 3. Cut out the images on pages 4 and 5. **Do not cut out the window just yet!**
- 3 Using a ruler score the fold lines. Place double-sided tape where shown along the top edge. Fold the card inwards.
- 4 Turn the card over by flipping it right to left, so the tab is now on your left and coloured side is faced down on the table. Place double-side tape on the tab. Then using the glue stick cover the sleeve front with glue. Make sure to go right up to the edges. Stick the picture for the sleeve front here as shown.

- 5 Turn the card back over and cut out the window along the dotted lines.
- 6 Stick down the bottom edge and the tab to make the sleeve. Do this by folding the tab in first, then fold the left side in to create the back of the sleeve. Press down to stick together.
- 7 Slide the card slider into the sleeve.
- 8 On the back of the dragon stick a small square of corrugated cardboard (or a sticky foam square) in the middle, no bigger than 10mm. This helps it slide. Put a piece of double-side tape over the square.
- 9 Push the slider all the way in, stick the dragon to the left of the slider, where the white dot is, through the window. Make sure it's only stuck to the slider and not the sleeve front.

You now have a fantastic

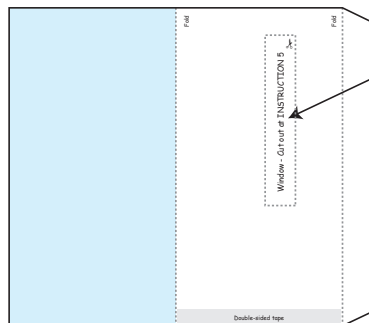

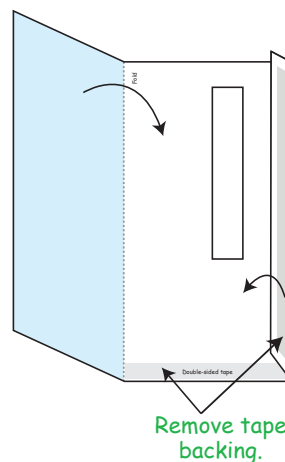
SLEEVE FRONT



INSIDE SLEEVE

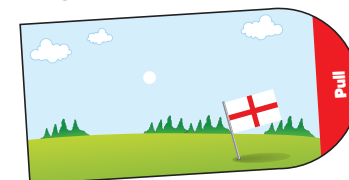


5 Turn over and cut out the window.

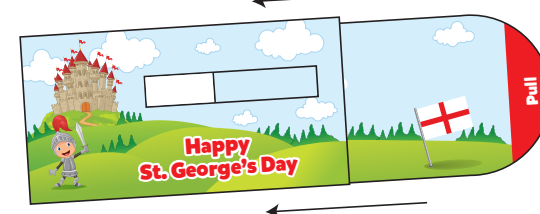


6 Stick the sleeve together by peeling off the tape backing. Fold the tab in first then fold the left side in to create the back of the sleeve. Press down to stick together.

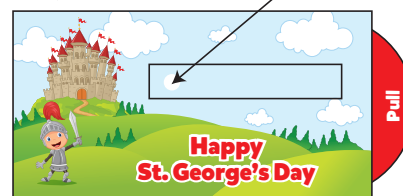
SLIDER



7 Slide the slider into the sleeve.



9 Push the slider all the way in. Stick the dragon to the left of the slider where the white dot is, through the window. Make sure it's only stuck to the slider and not the sleeve front.



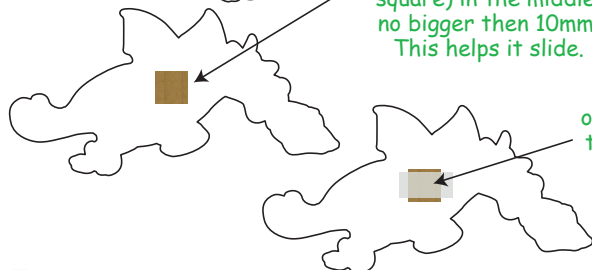
To make the dragon fly, pull up the slider.



8 Turn the dragon picture over and stick a small square of corrugated cardboard (or a sticky foam square) in the middle, no bigger than 10mm. This helps it slide.



Put a piece of double-side tape over the card square.

Fold

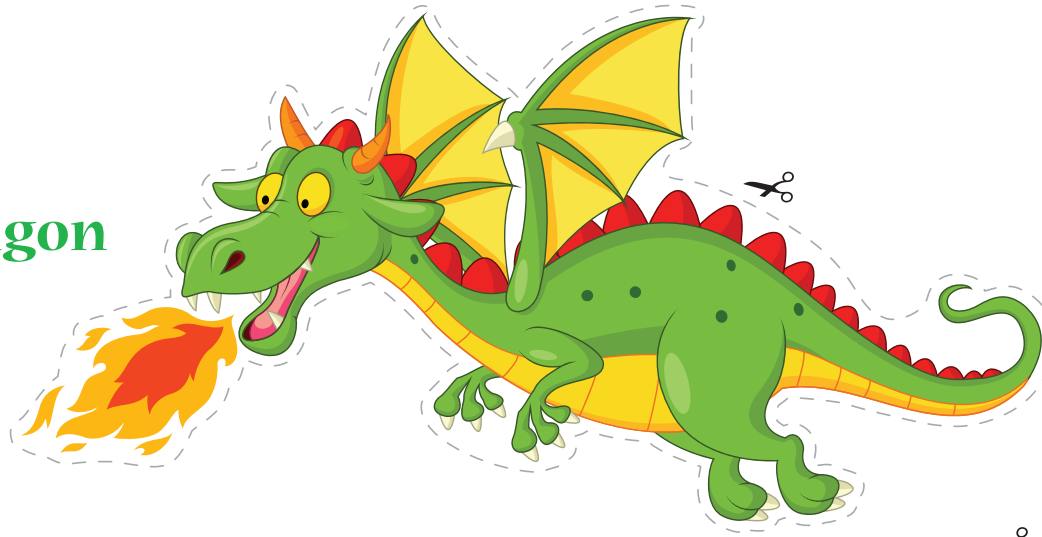
Cut along dotted line. Put double-sided tape on the BACK of this tab.
