

Potato print a Shamrock

You'll need

*Large potato, craft knife,
pencil, flat bowls, green fabric paint,
paper towels, a white item to print onto.*



Instructions

- ① Cut a potato in half (*get an adult to do all the cutting*).
- ② Use a pencil to lightly draw a shamrock on the potato's surface. Cut away the parts of the potato around the design and blot it on a paper towel.
- ③ Pour a thin layer of green paint into a flat bowl and press the potato into the paint. Practice printing a few patterns on scrap paper first.
- ④ Next, stamp a pattern on the front of your chosen item, it could be a T-shirts, sweatshirts, an apron, napkins, tablecloth or tea towel.
- ⑤ Have fun creating your own shamrock pattern. Try cutting different shapes in the potato too!
