

Advent Calendar

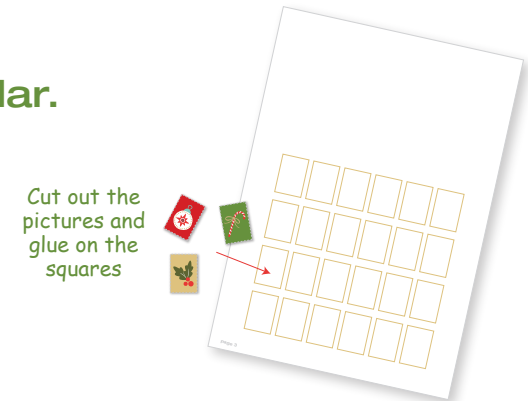
Here's a fun way to make an advent calendar.

Instructions

- 1 Print pages 2 and 3 on to card. Print page 4 on to paper.
- 2 Cut along the dotted lines on the advent calendar front to make the windows. The craft knife works best here, and you will need to place this onto the cutting mat.
- 3 Cut out the pictures on page 4.
- 4 Stick the pictures wherever you like in the boxes. Alternatively, print page 4 onto card and use it as it is.
- 5 Glue the front to the back by running the gluestick along all the edges, then carefully run a thin line of glue between the pictures using the edge of the gluestick. Take care not to get glue on the pictures or the doors will not open. (You can use thin strips of double-sided tape if you prefer).
- 6 Carefully line the top edge of the calendar front with the back then press the rest of the sheet down to cover your pictures.
- 7 Write numbers 1-24 in the circles on the front of the calendar doors. You can dot the numbers around so they're not in order for more fun finding the correct doors on the day. Make the Santa image door number 24.

You will need:

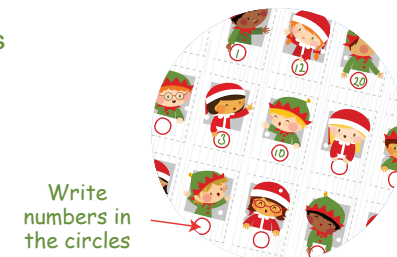
Card, gluestick (or double-sided tape), craft knife, ruler, scissors, cutting mat (If you don't have a cutting mat, an old folded newspaper or magazine will do).



Glue or tape between the images



Line up the top edges and press down.



Write numbers in the circles
