

Christmas Wreath



You will need

Paper plate, glue, scissors, tissue paper, ribbon, Christmas pictures.

Optional items

Coloured pens or paints, glitter.

Here's a fun way to make a wreath for Christmas.

Instructions

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Cut the centre out of a paper plate to leave just the outside ring. (you may need an adult to help you with this). Turn it so the plate is upside down. This forms the base of the wreath.

Cut out Christmas coloured tissue paper into strips. Glue them onto the paper plate ring. This will create a colourful base to stick your Christmas images on. Or you can paint it, or use coloured pens if you don't have any tissue paper.

Use Christmas images cut out from magazines or old Christmas cards to stick around the wreath base. If you don't have any images use the ones on the next two pages. Add glitter to make them sparkle if you like.

Tie a bow with the length of ribbon, then glue it to the top of the wreath. Glue or tape a ribbon hook to the back of the wreath so your Christmas wreath can now be hung up.
