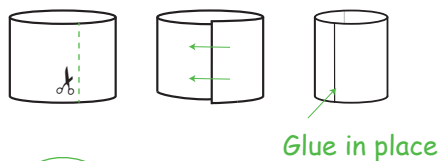


Pine Cone Christmas Tree Craft

Here's a fun way to make a Christmas tree with a pine cone.

You will need:

Pine cone, red and green acrylic paint, paint brush and palette, card tube, glitter glue, coloured beads, yellow felt, scissors and glue. Cut out decorations from the next page.



Glue in place

Paint the
cone green



Decorate
the base

Paint the
base red



Instructions

- 1 Have fun finding pine cones on your walk. Wash and dry the pine cones before starting this craft.
- 2 Paint the pine cone green and leave to dry. Decorate the cone tips with glitter glue to make them sparkle.
- 3 Make the base by cutting 3cm from a card tube. If it looks too big for your cone, cut the tube as shown and wrap around until you have the size you need, then glue in place.
- 4 Paint the base red. (Or any colour of your choice). Decorate as you like, or you can cut out and use the presents on the next page.
- 5 Once your pine cone tree is dry, glue beads or coloured sequins on the tree.
- 6 Glue the pine cone to the base.
- 7 Cut a star out of felt and add a dot of glitter to make it shine. Glue onto the tree top.
