Learning Objectives:

- to make a bag decoration

Curriculum Links:

The Design, Make and Evaluate aspects are covered.

Design

- use research and develop design criteria to inform the design of innovative, functional, appealing products that are fit for purpose, aimed at particular individuals or groups

Make

- select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks (for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing), accurately

Evaluate

- evaluate their ideas and products against their own design criteria and consider the views of others to improve their work

Keywords

Fabric. Template. Knot. Needle. Running stitch. Sew. Thread. These can also be found at the end of this PDF.

Before this lesson you will need:

- Design templates (at the end of this PDF)
- Fabric, felt material
- Scissors
- Needle
- Thread (perhaps thimble and needle-threader)
- Scissors
- Glue



The main part of this lesson is practical. Before the children have a go, the teacher can give them a practical demonstration to remind them how to thread a needle and how to do running stitch.

Depending upon the available time, you may wish to split this lesson into two stages. The first stage can introduce the activity, explain what the children will need to consider and go through safety measures. The second stage can be the practical element of the lesson, the make itself.

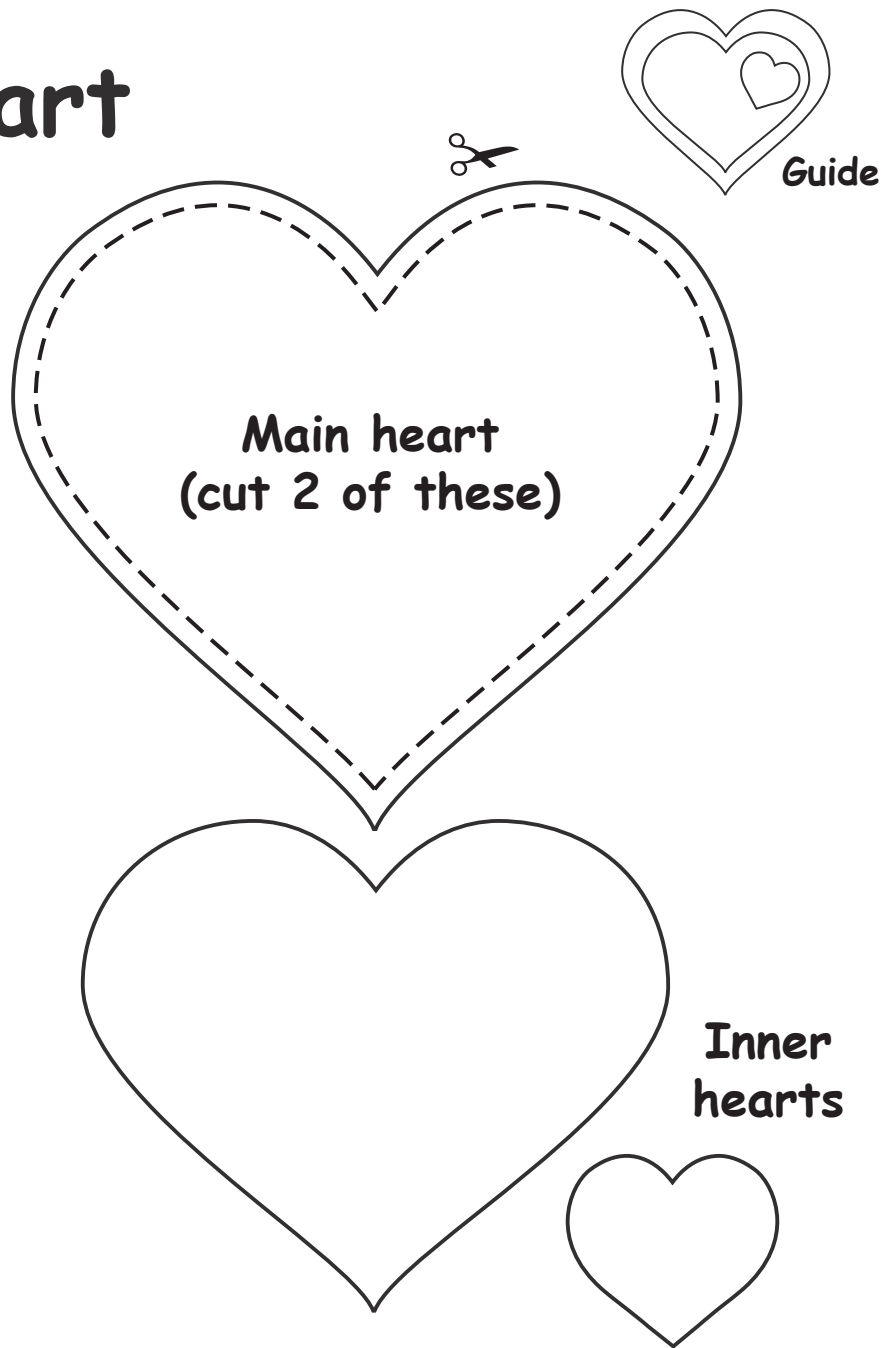
PowerPoint Presentation

The accompanying PowerPoint has 13 slides with the following learning points:

- Slides 1 and 2 introduce the lesson.
- Slide 3 shows four designs which correspond to the templates on the following pages. Show the children the designs and templates, the children can choose the template they would like to use for their decoration.
- Slide 4 asks the children how they will attach their decoration to their bag. The bag could be their school bag, or perhaps it is a present.
- Slide 5 the tools we will need for this lesson.
- Slide 6 asks the children to consider the colours they will need for the appearance of their decoration.
- Slide 7 goes through the safety measures the children need to consider.
- Slide 8: Threading a needle. The teacher will demonstrate a reminder of how you thread a needle. The teacher will also demonstrate what happens if you forget to tie the knot in the thread.
- Slide 9 and 10: Running stitch. The teacher will demonstrate running stitch.
- Slide 11: The Make. Sets out the steps children will need to make their own decoration. If you are splitting this lesson into two stages, you may wish to begin the second lesson here.
- Slide 12: Evaluation.
- Slide 13 is the closing slide.

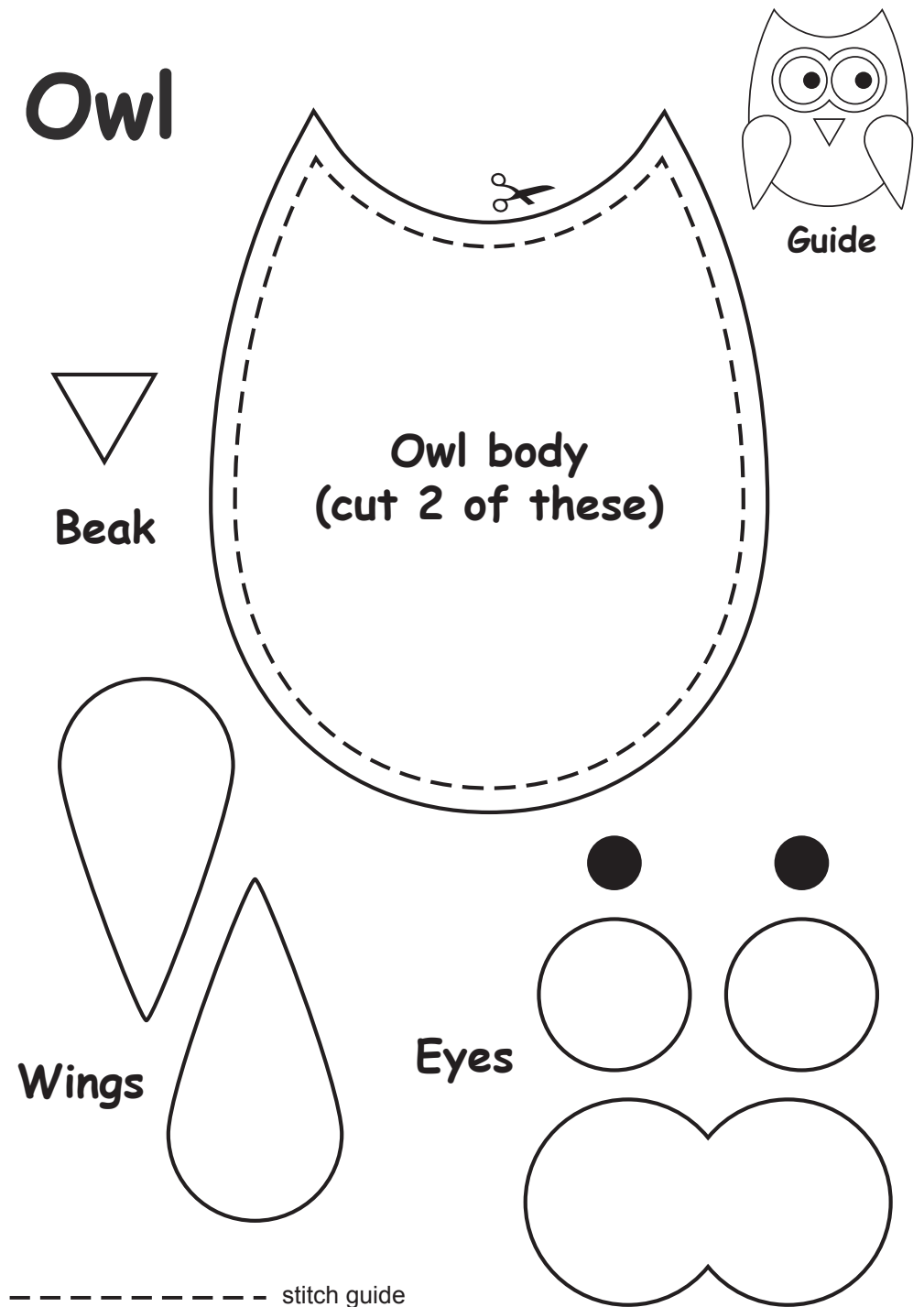

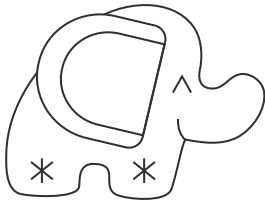

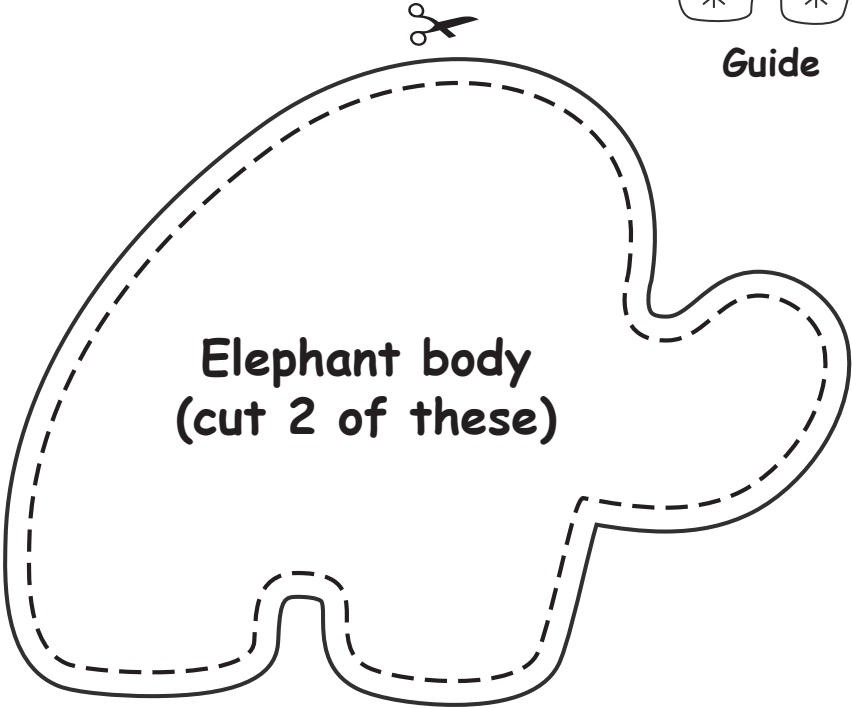

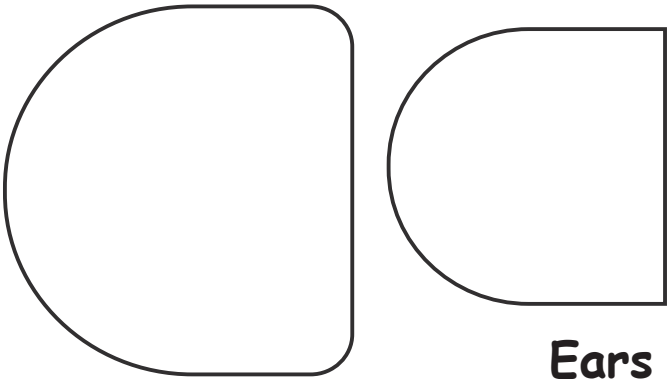
Elephant

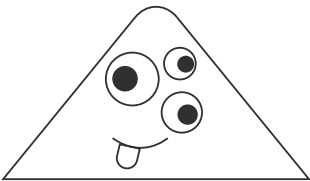
Elephant body
(cut 2 of these)



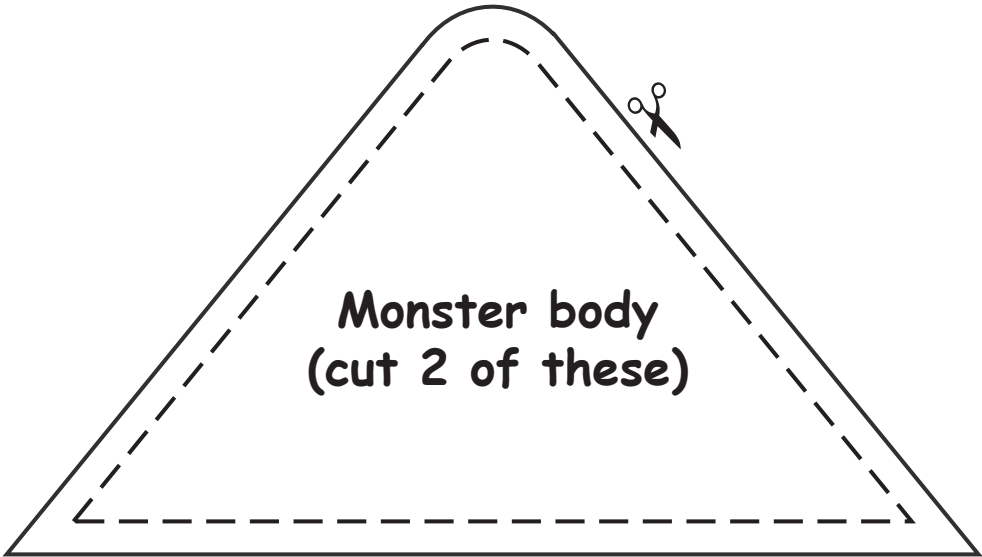
Ears

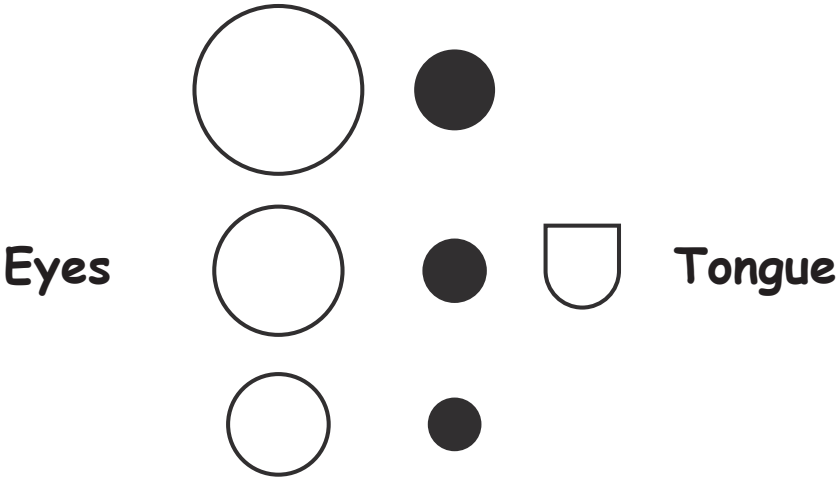
