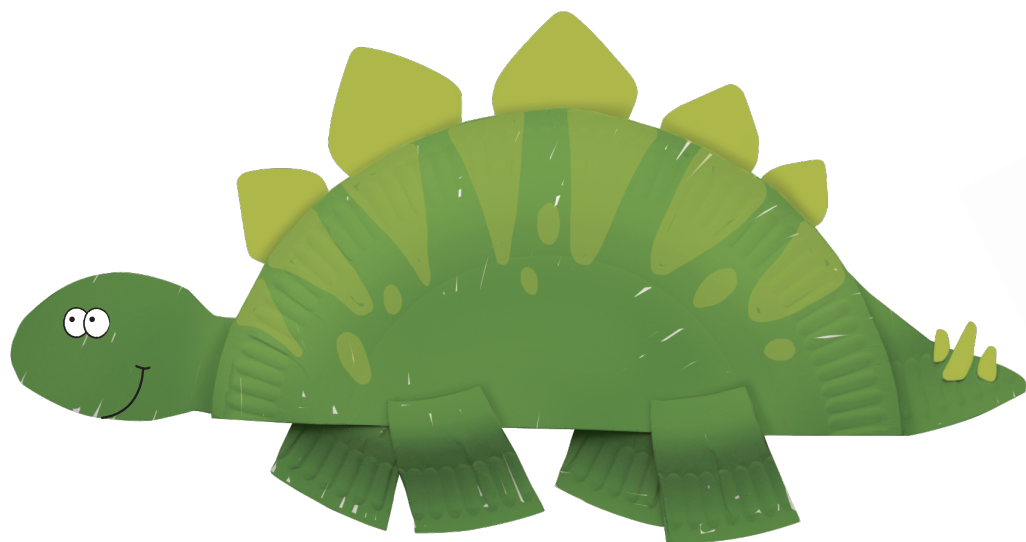


Paper Plate Dinosaur

Here's a fun way to make a Dinosaur.



You will need:

1 white paper plate
1 sheet of A4 card
Scissors
Double sided tape
Glue
Pencil
Coloured pens,
pencils, paints
or tissue paper.

Instructions

- 1 Using the templates on page 3 and 4 draw the shapes you will need for your dinosaur. You can do this by cutting them out and drawing around them. Draw on to the **BACK** of the paper plate.

Draw your dinosaur shapes on the back of a paper plate.

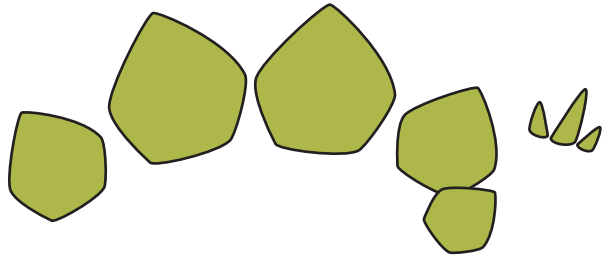
- 2 Once all the parts are drawn, colour them in however you like, then cut them out.

Cut them out.

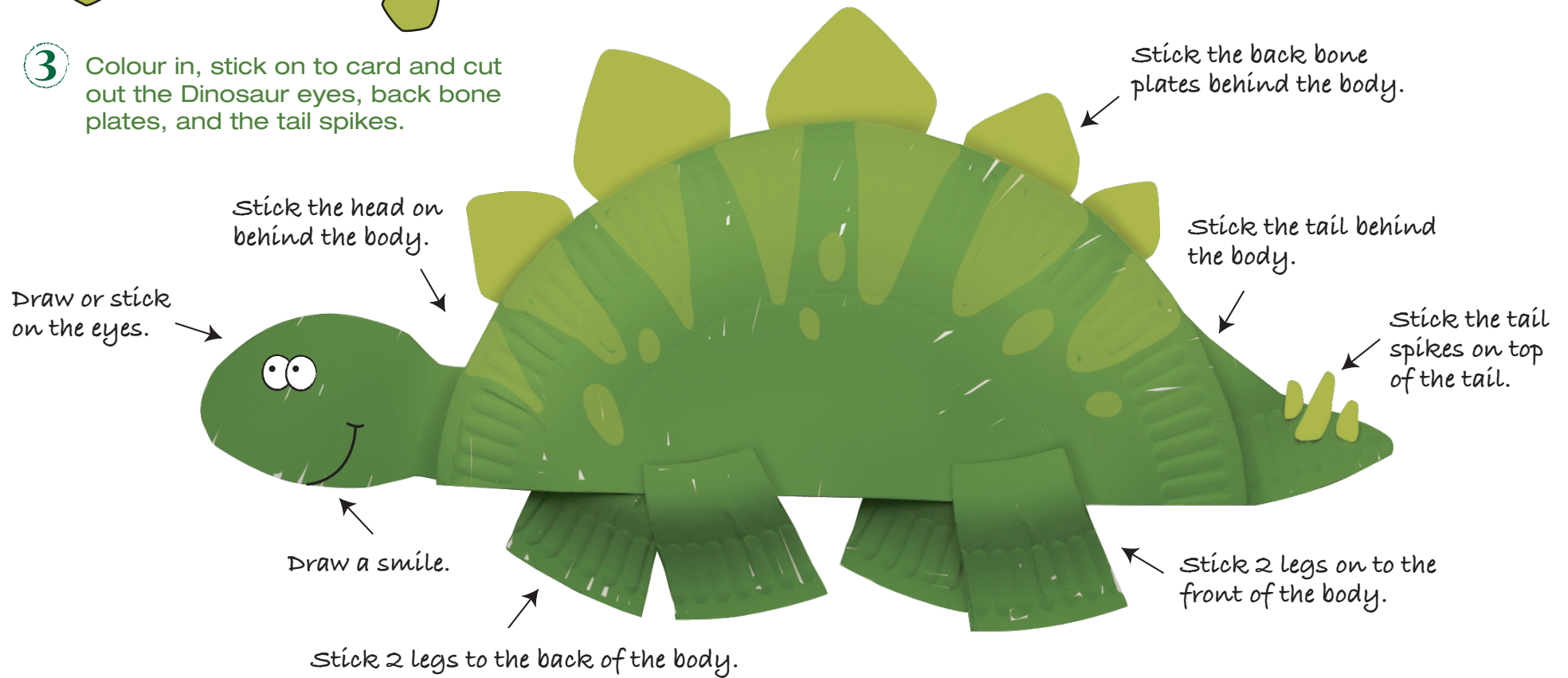
Colour in the shapes.

- ③ Colour in, stick on to card and cut out the Dinosaur eyes, back bone plates, and the tail spikes.



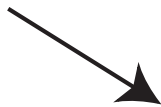
- ④ Use double sided tape to stick all the elements together as shown. Then draw on a smiley face.

Dinosaur!

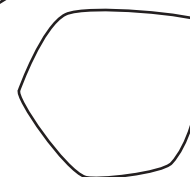
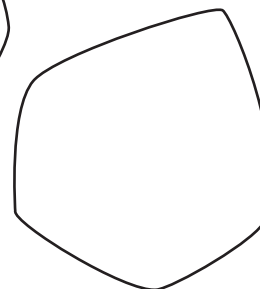
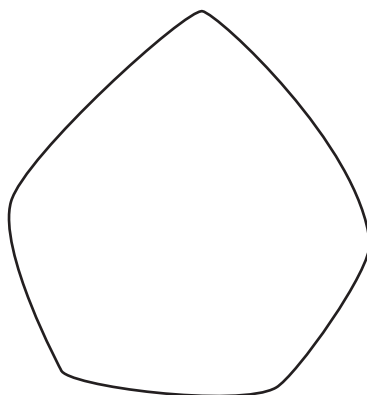
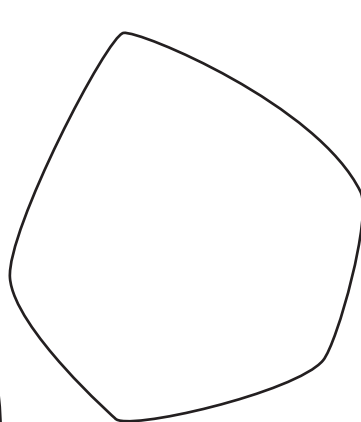
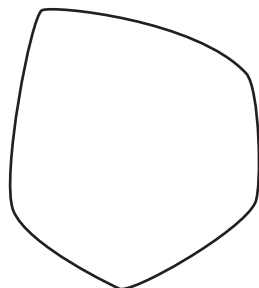

Cut out the eyes.

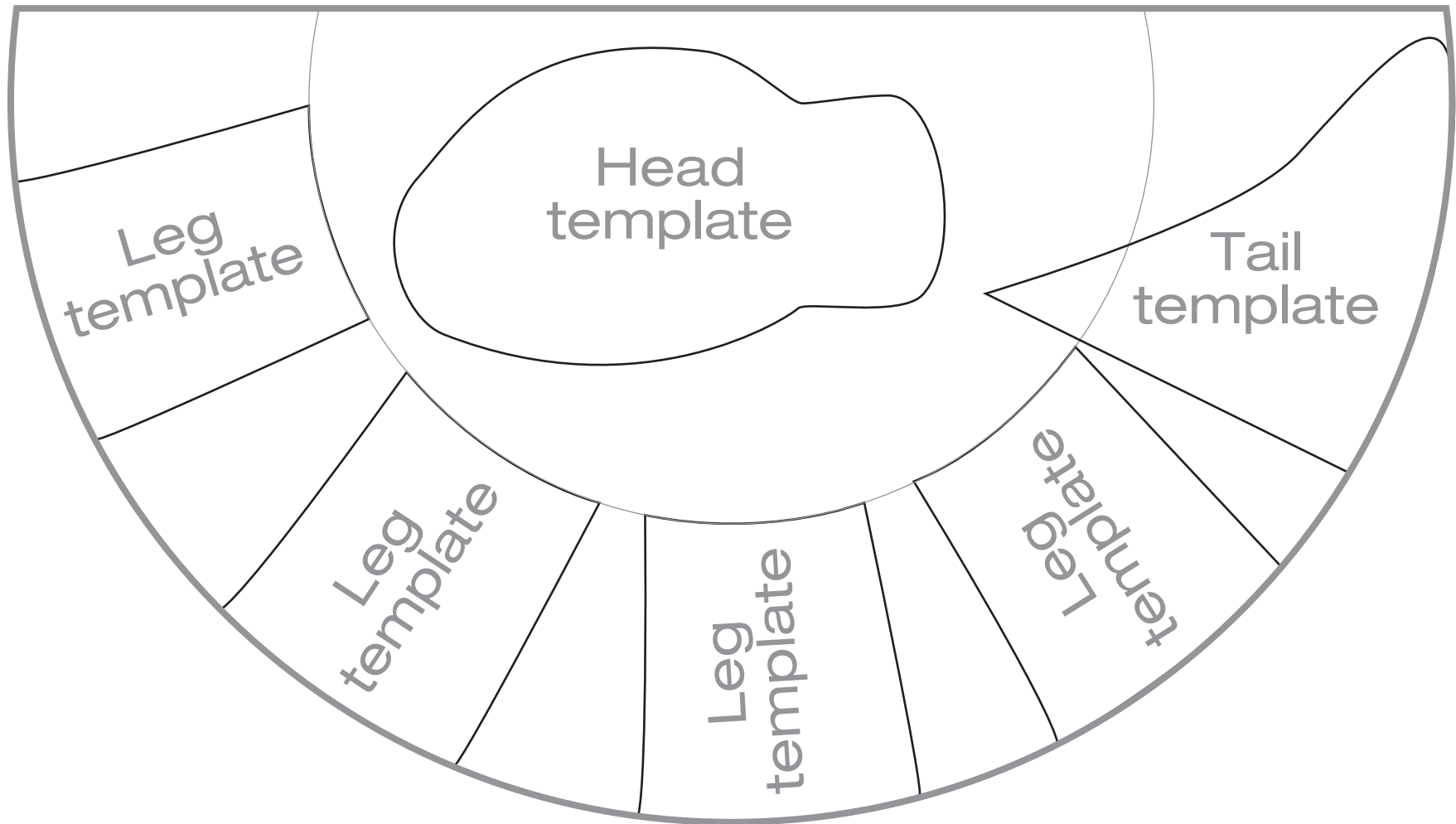
Body template
