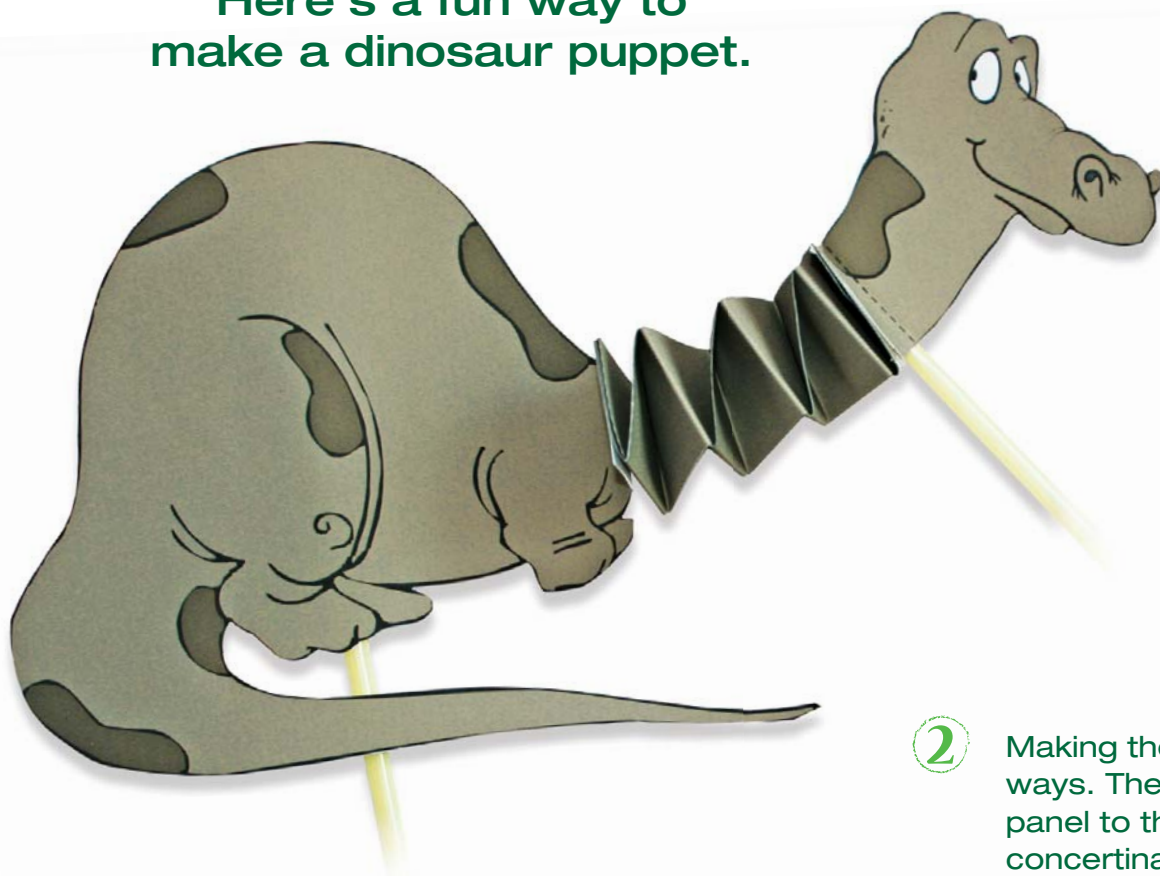


DINOSAUR PUPPET

Here's a fun way to
make a dinosaur puppet.

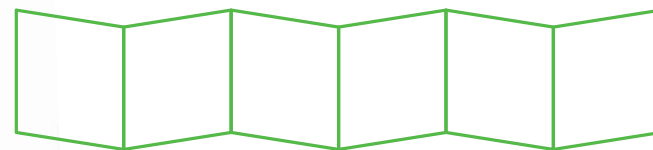


YOU WILL NEED

*Scissors, glue, tape,
straws, coloured pens or pencils.*

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Print and cut out the dinosaur heads, bodies and coloured panels on page 4, 5 and 6. Or colour in and cut out the dinosaur heads, bodies and panels on page 7, 8 and 9.



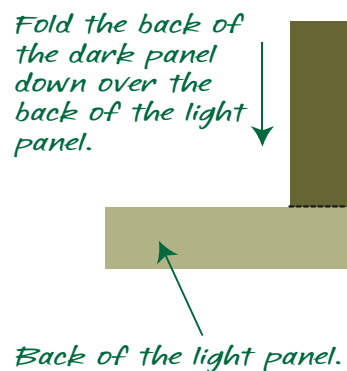
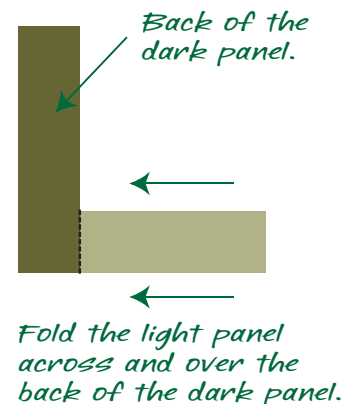
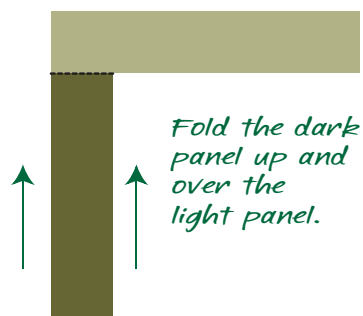
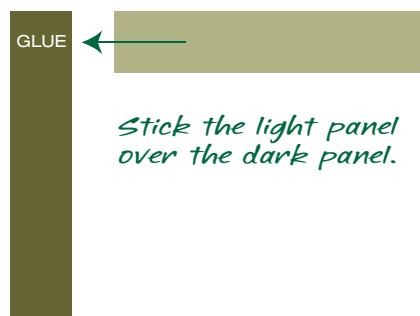
- 2 Making the dinosaur's neck can be done in two ways. The **simple** way is to stick the light green panel to the back of the dark green panel, then concertina the paper into squares measuring 30mm. **Now follow the instructions from number 4.**



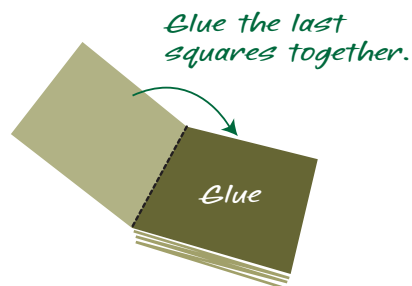

Alternatively try making the dinosaur's neck like this. Stick the coloured panels together (ie light green to light green, dark green to dark green) so you've a light green panel and a dark green panel. (You don't need to do this for the simple concertina body option). Now follow the instructions below.



Continue to do this until all the paper is used up.

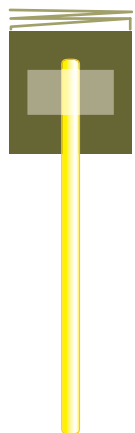


You will end up with a concertina shape like this.

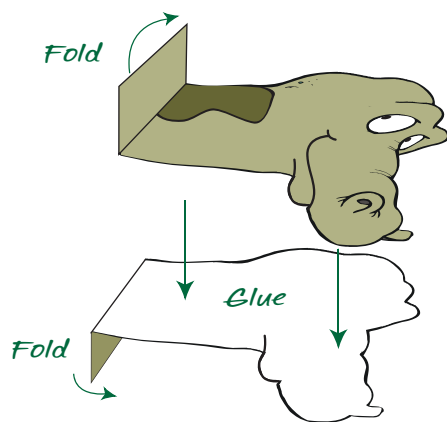

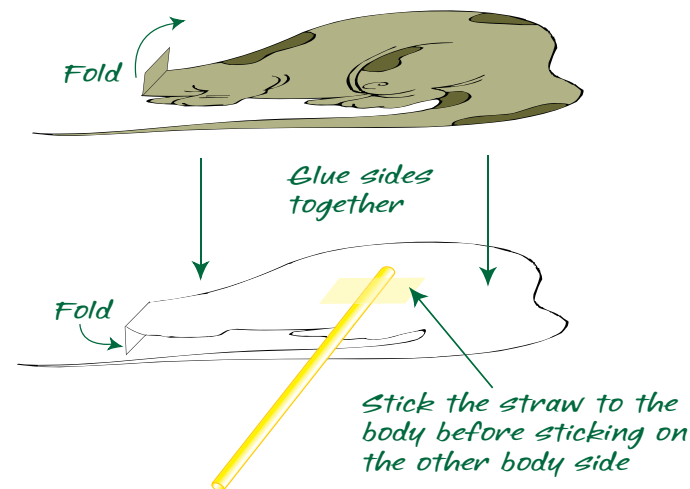
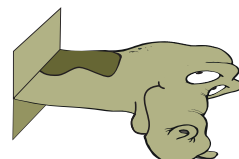
- 4 Tape a straw to one end of the neck. This will be the head end.



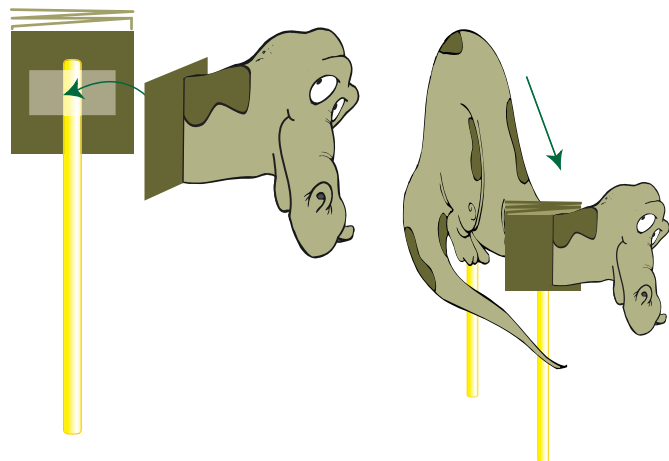
- 5 Fold the flaps on the head and body cut outs, as below. Stick the two heads together. Now stick one straw in the middle of your two body cut outs.



It will look like this when stuck together.



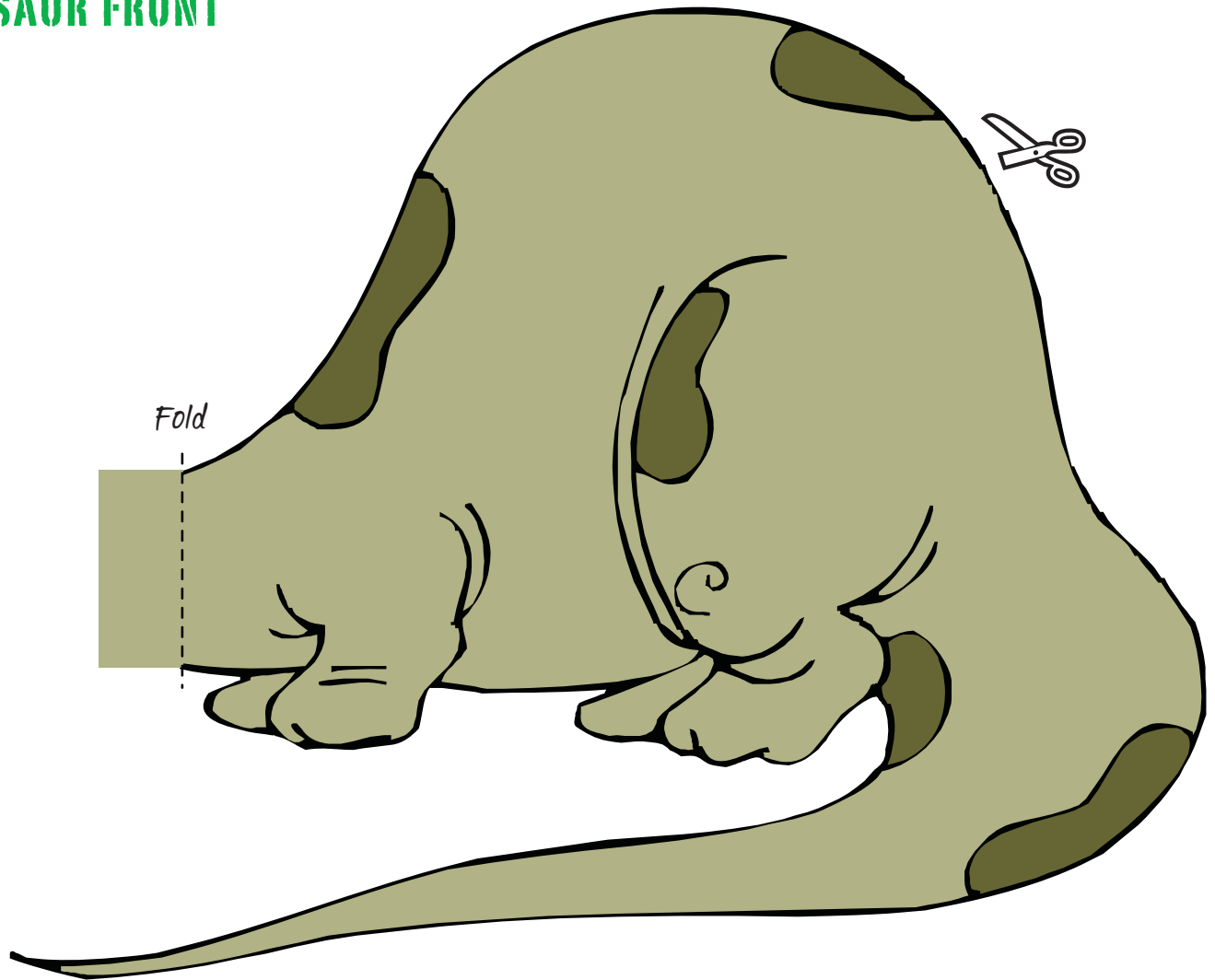
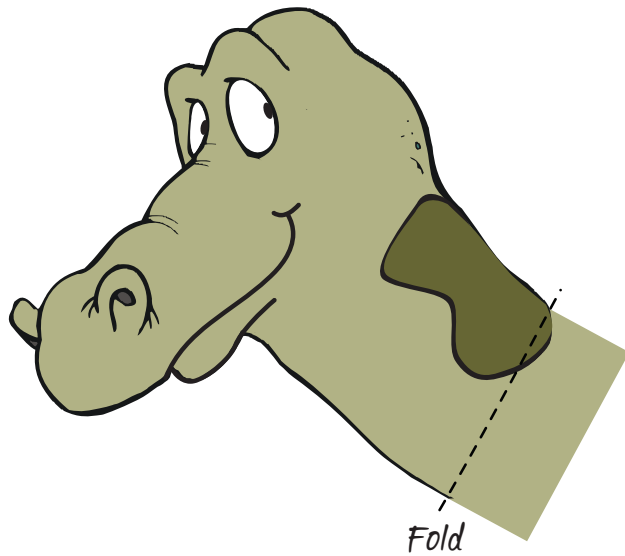
- 6 Stick the head to the straw on the concertina neck you've already made. Then stick the other end of the concertina neck, to the body.



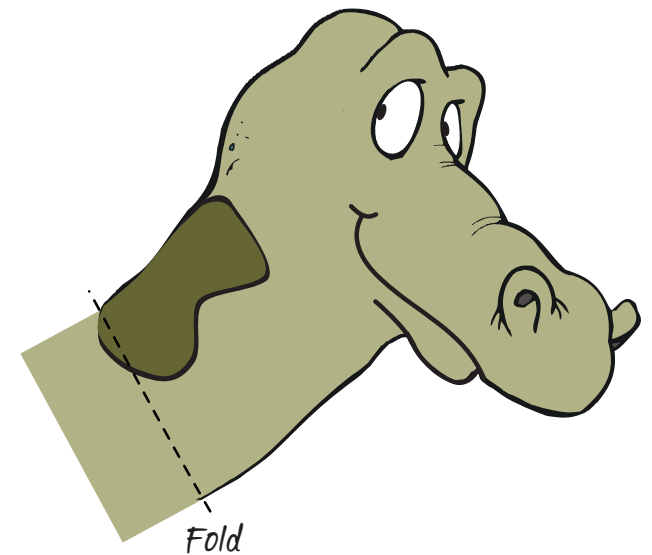
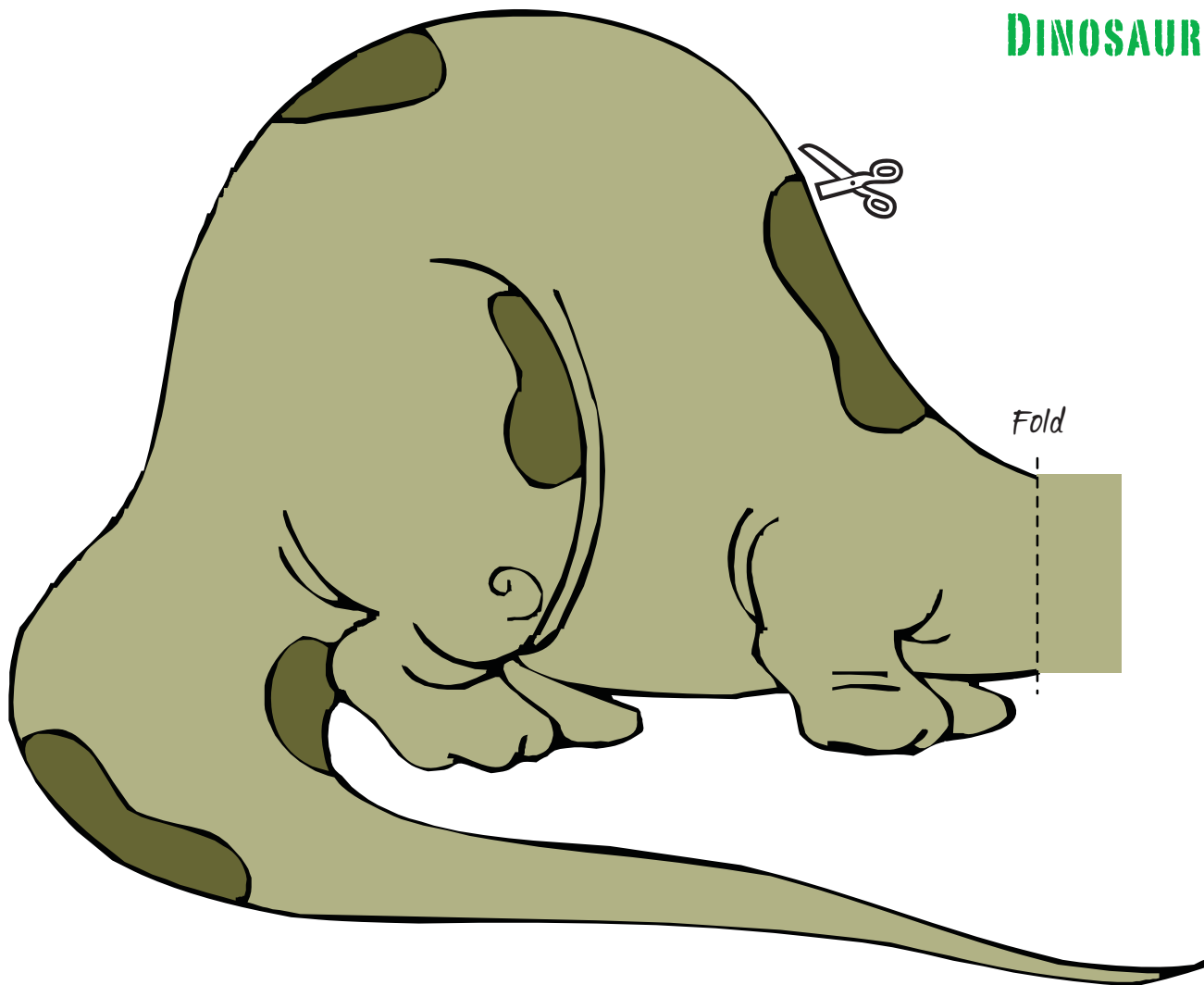

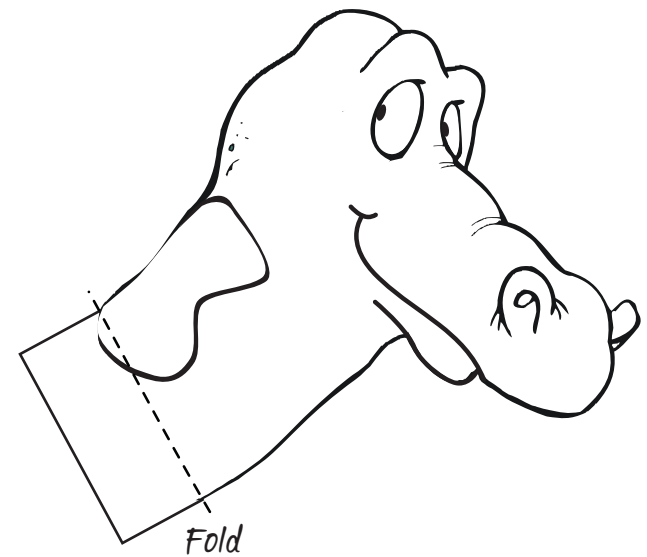
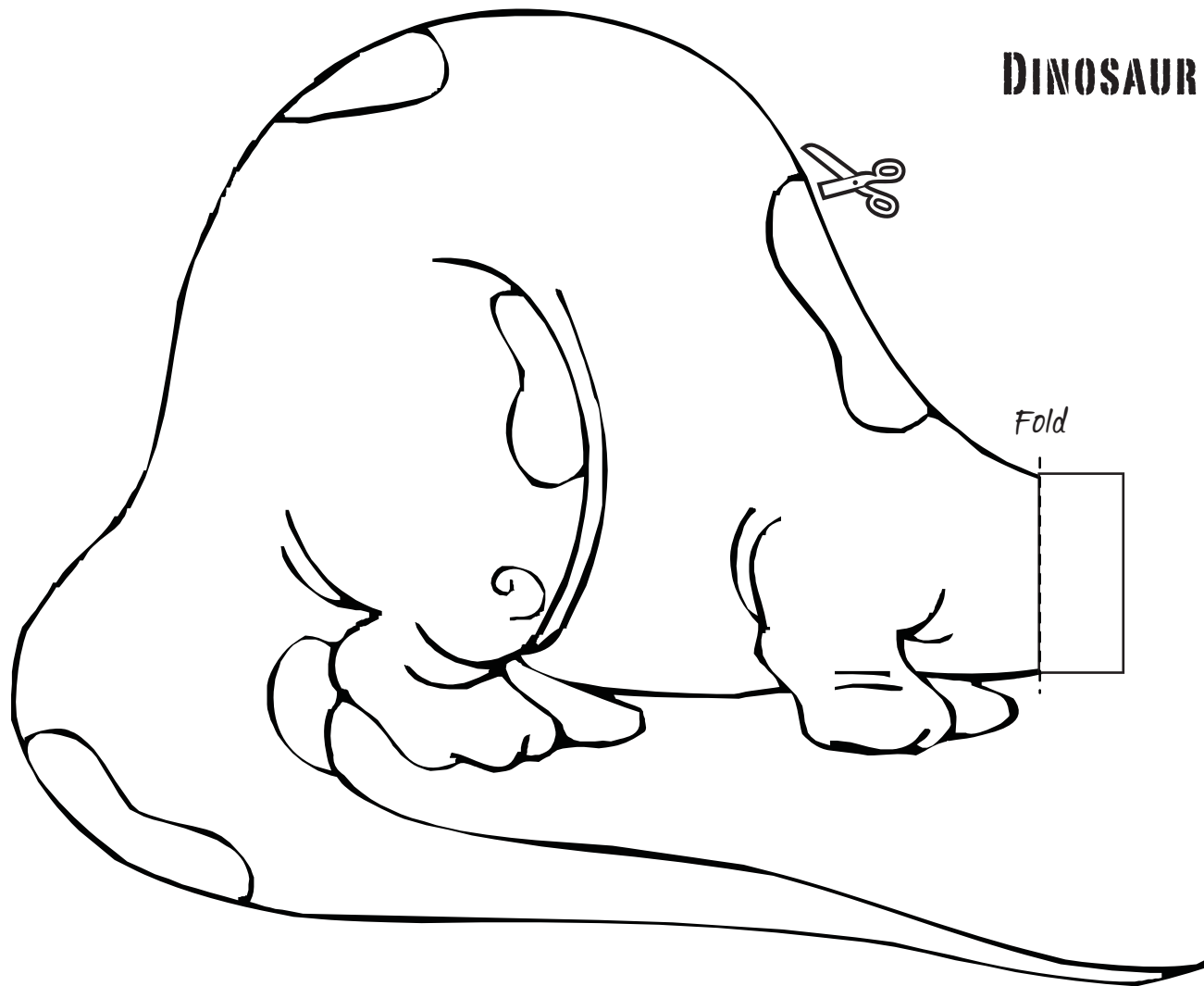
PANELS FOR THE NECK
