

Easter Bunny Ears

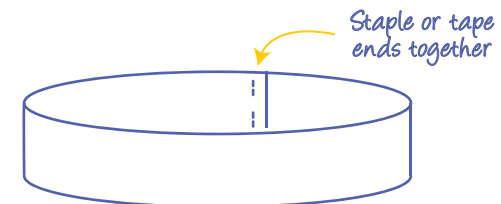
Here's a fun way to make bunny ears.

You will need:

Two different colours of felt, about A4 size. (Grey, white or brown for the outside of the ears, pink or cream for the inside). Thin card, scissors, tape, stapler. Pipe cleaners, colouring in pens (optional), headband (optional).

Instructions

- 1 Firstly, lets make the head band. Using thin card, cut out a strip about 30mm thick and long enough to wrap around your forehead. Make sure you make it little bit longer so you can staple/tape the ends together. Alternatively you could use a child's headband. Decorate with felt if you like!



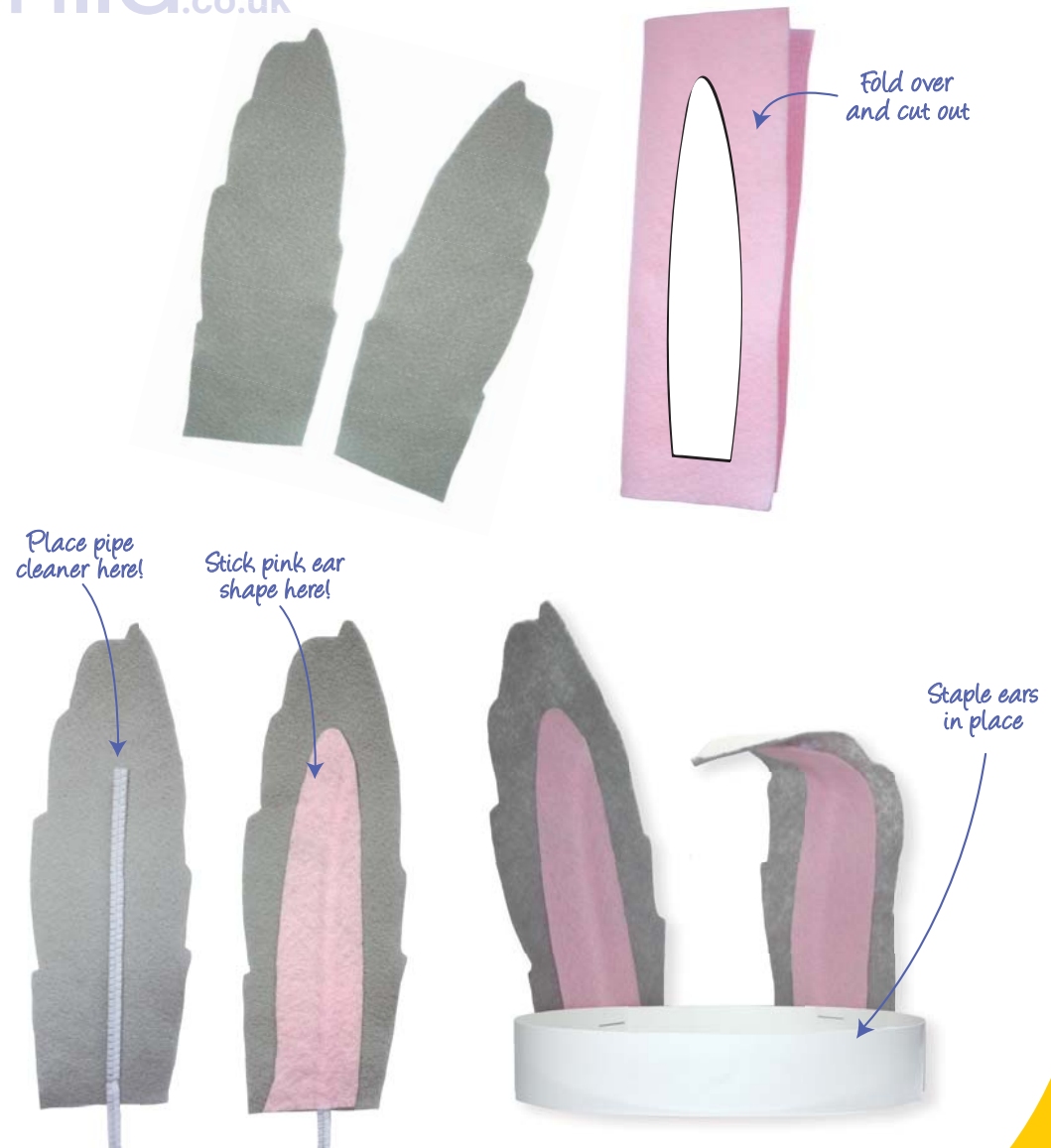
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- 2 Now for the ears. Fold the grey felt in half and cut out your bunny ear shape. This should give you 2 ears the same colour and size. Do the same for the pink felt but make the shape smaller. Alternatively you can use the paper ears on page 3 and 4. You could even create your own colours by colouring in the ear shapes on page 4 and 5. Use the shapes as a guide if you like by pinning them to your felt and cutting around them.

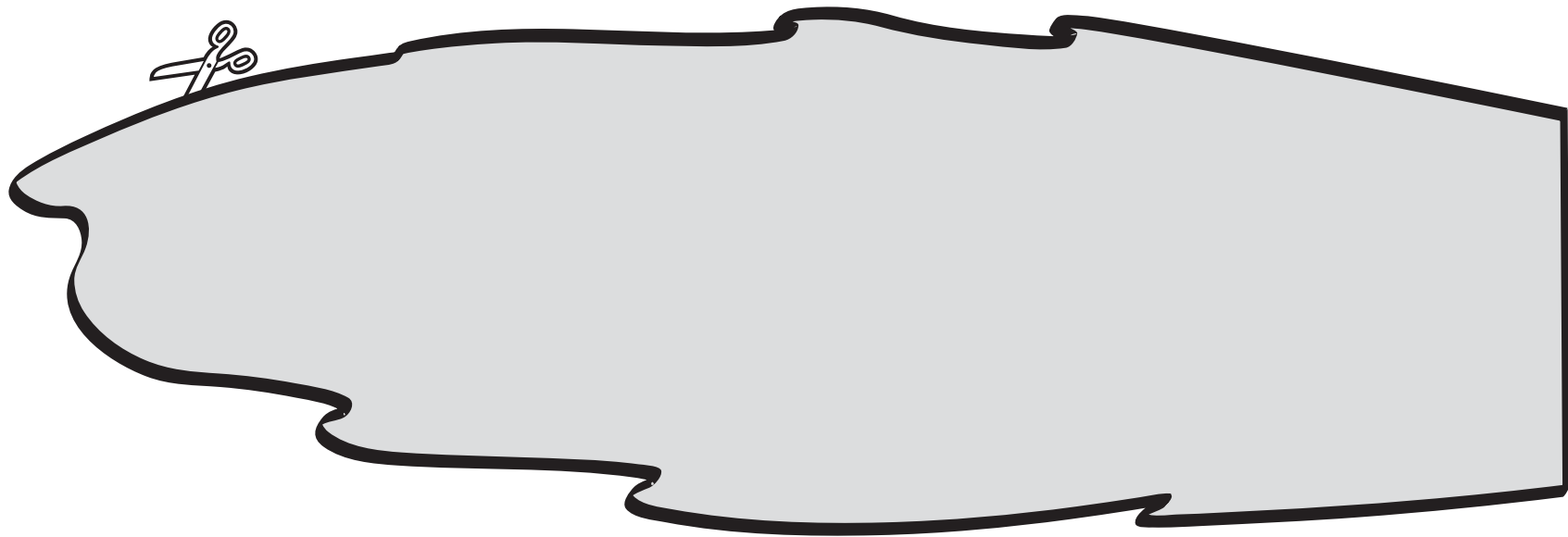
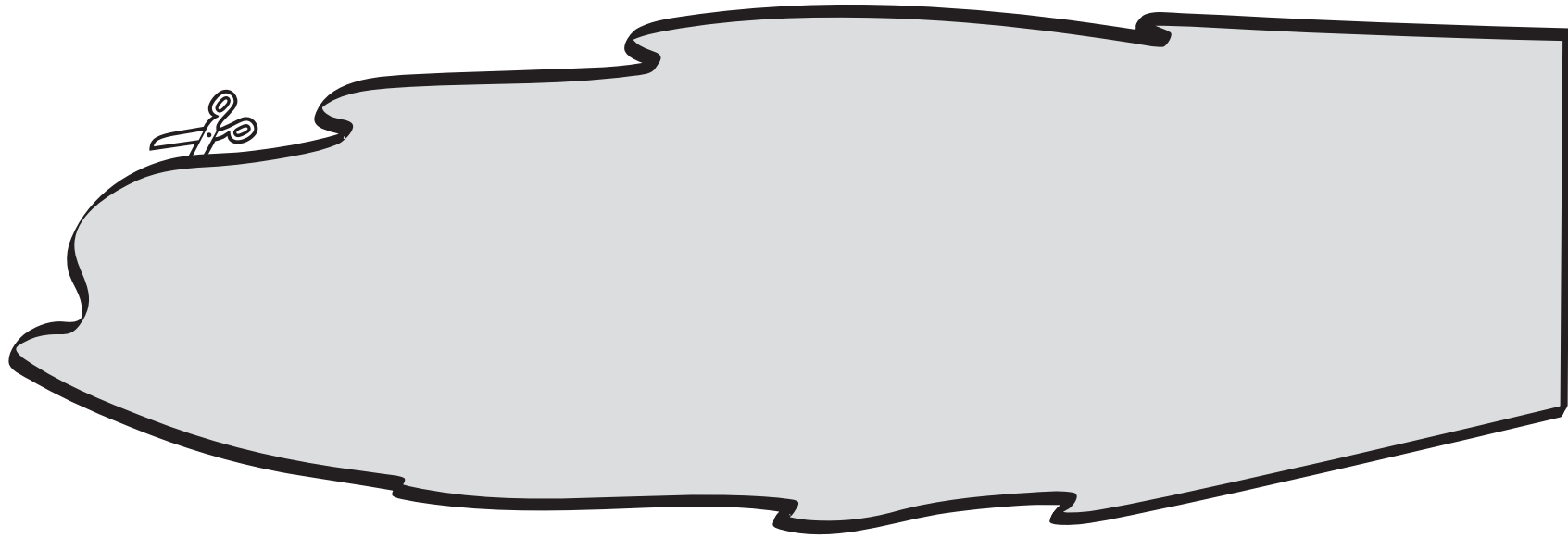
- 3 Next place a pipe cleaner in the middle of the grey ear shapes. Use glue or double sided tape to attach the pink felt over the top.

- 4 Next attach the ears to your headband with staples or tape and bend the ears however you like! If you have a child's headband, attach the ears by winding the remaining pipe cleaner around until secure. In both cases cut off the unwanted remaining pipe cleaner.

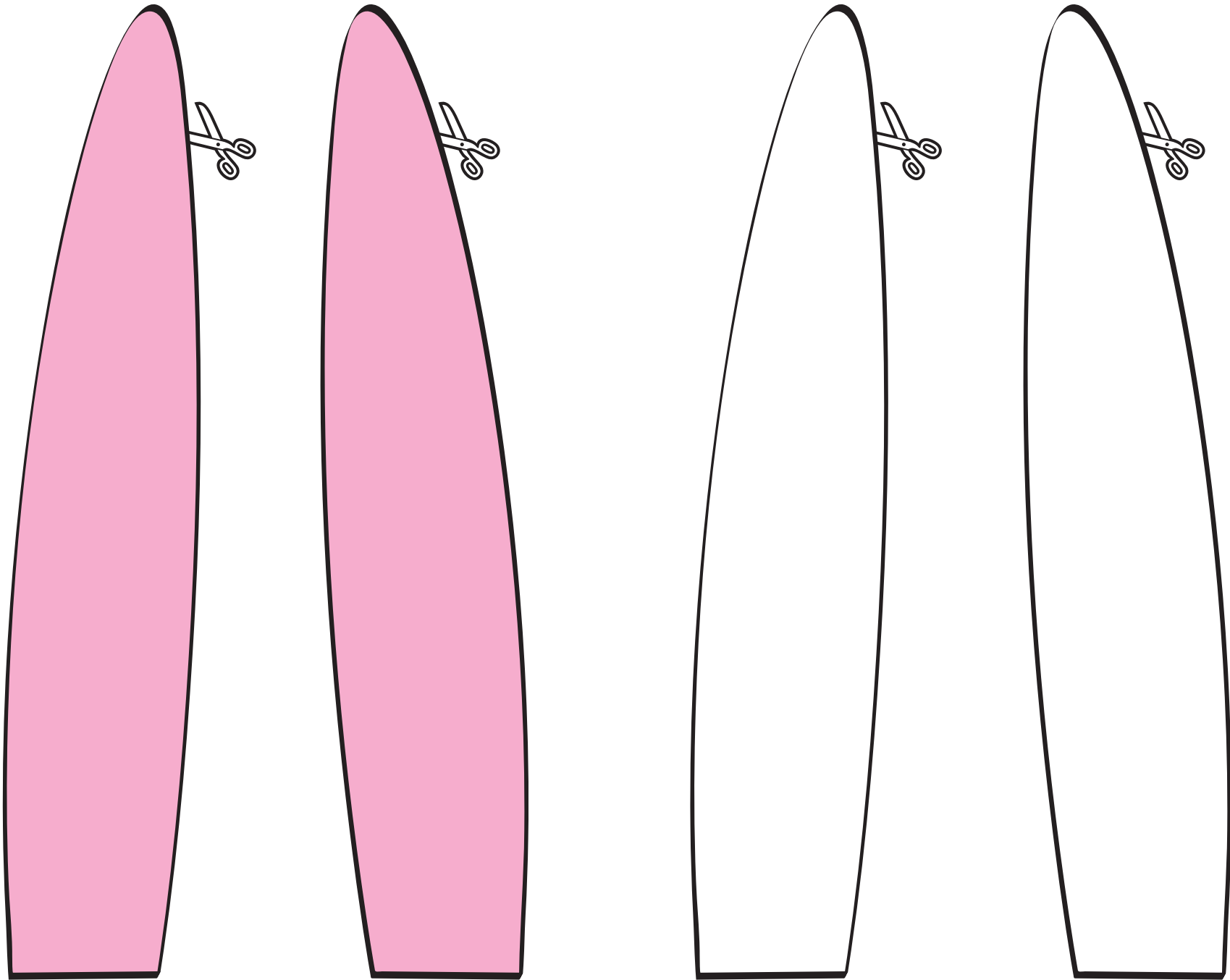

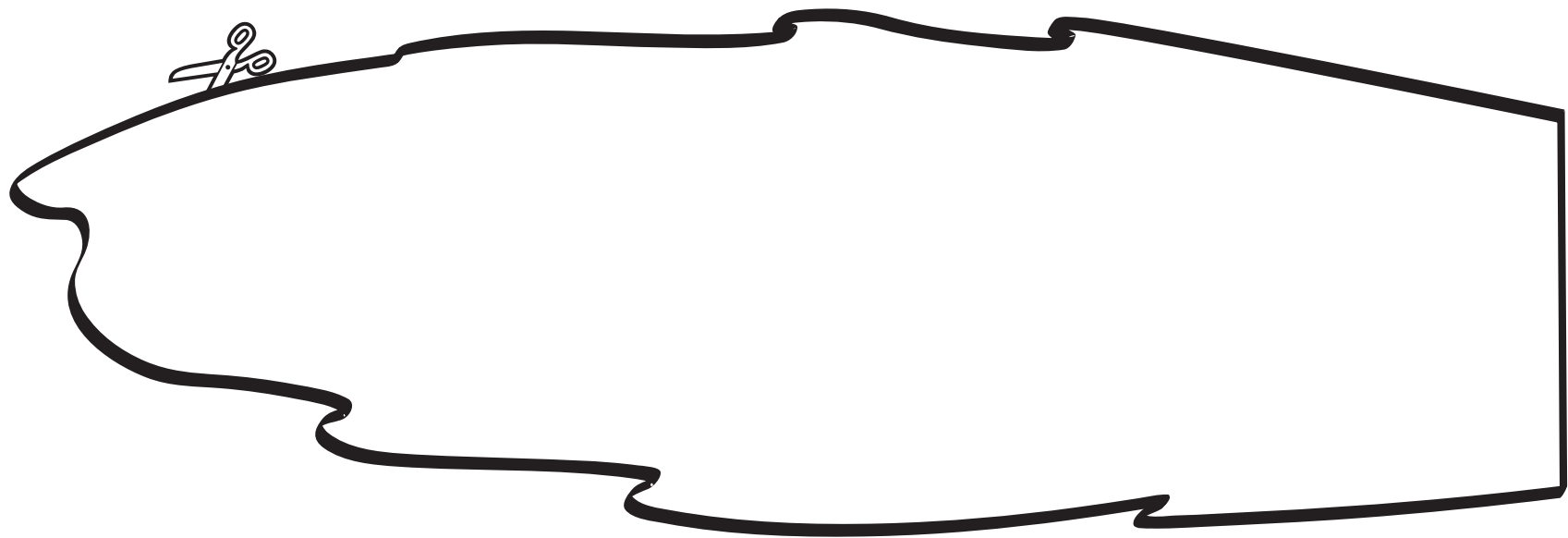
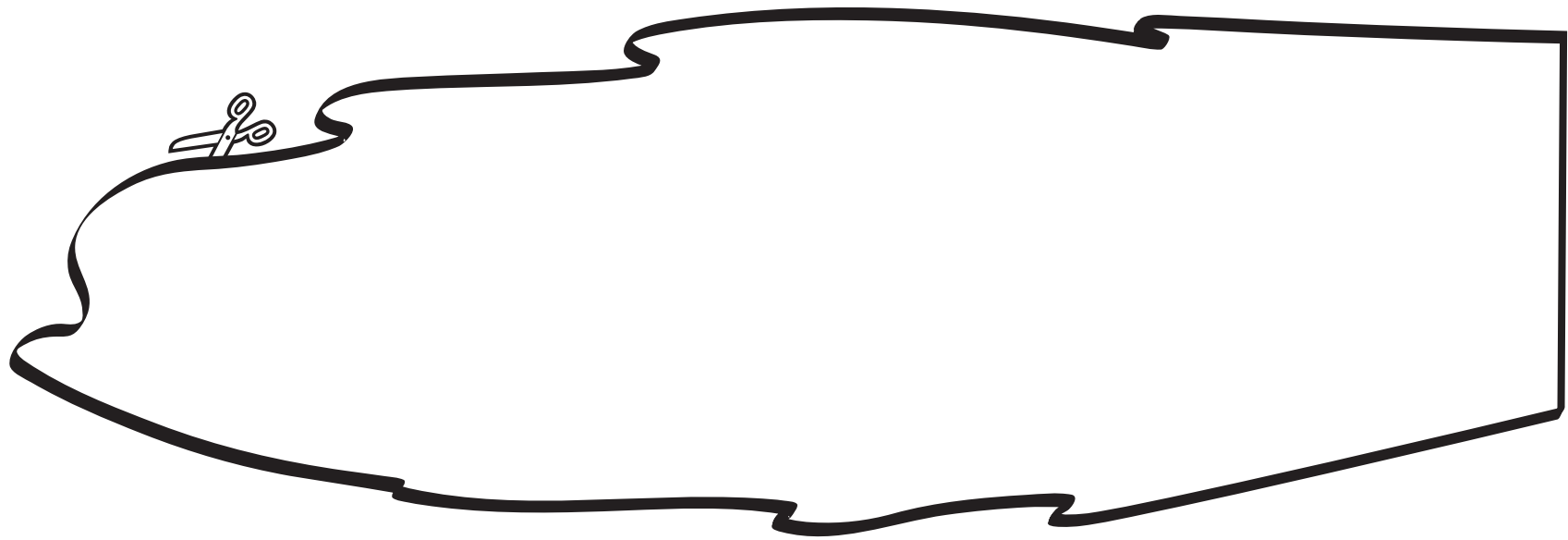
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Outside of your bunny ears
