

# Easter Egg Wreath

Here's a fun way to make an Easter egg wreath!



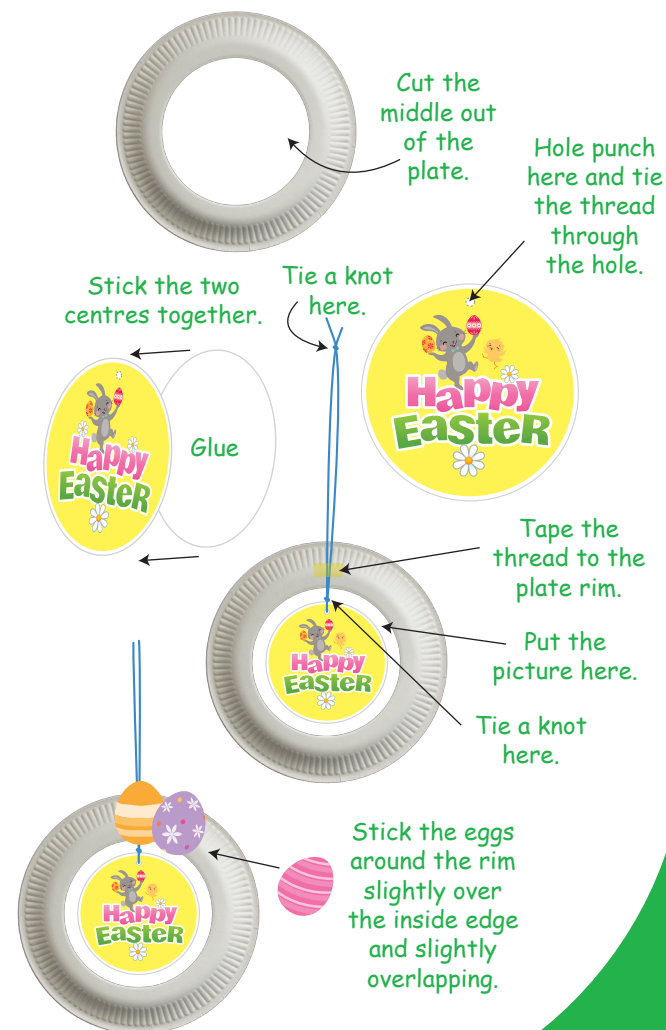
## You will need

White printer card, scissors,  
thread, glue stick, tape,  
hole punch and  
a 9" paper plate.

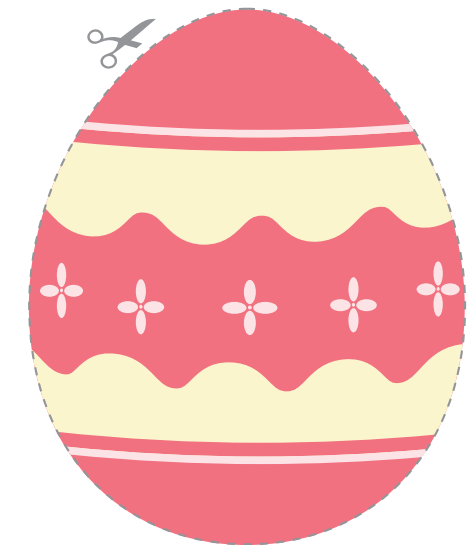
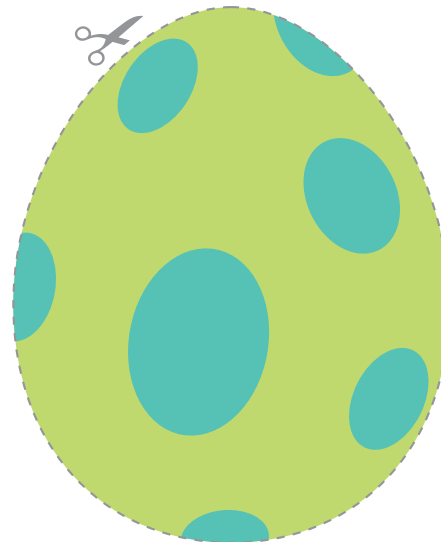
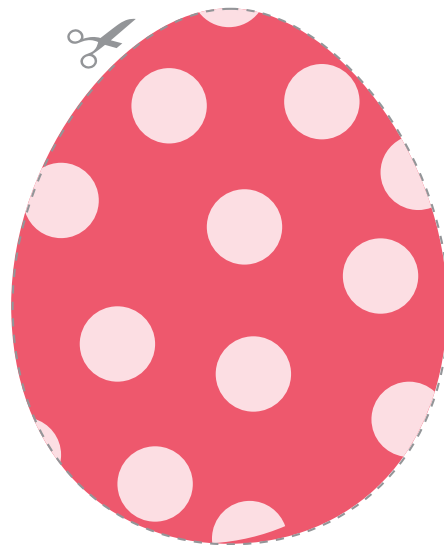
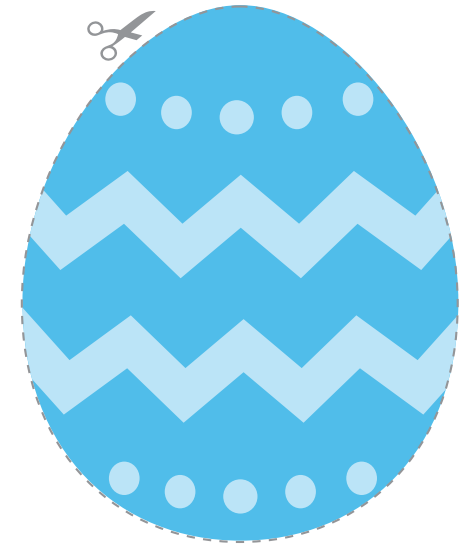
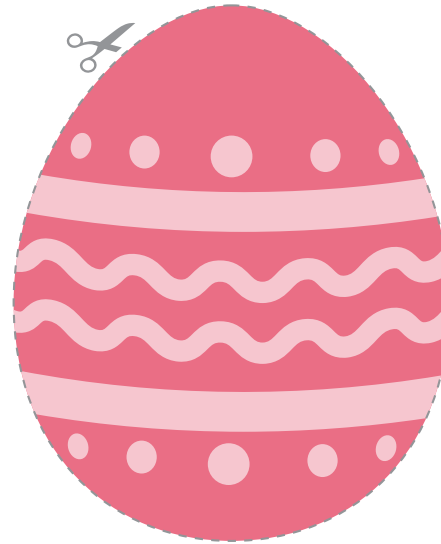
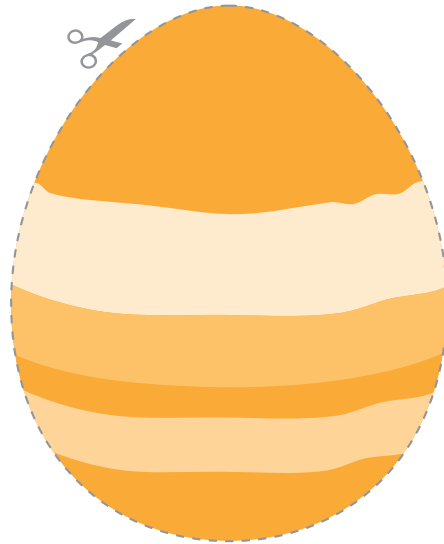
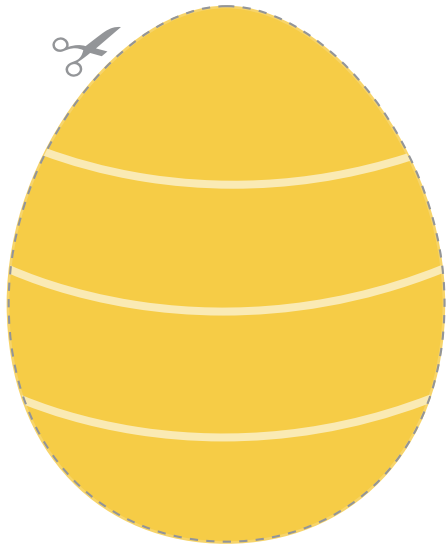
## Instructions

- 1 Print and cut out all the images on the next 3 pages.
- 2 Cut the middle out of the paper plate.
- 3 Stick the 2 wreath centres together and punch a hole where marked.
- 4 Tie a thread through the hole, long enough to hang up the finished wreath.
- 5 Place the plate face down (so what would have been the bottom faces up) and put the wreath centre in the hole. Tape the thread to the rim at the top to hold in place.
- 6 Stick the eggs around the rim slightly over the inside edge and slightly overlapping, then decorate with daisies.
- 7 Hang up your finished wreath!

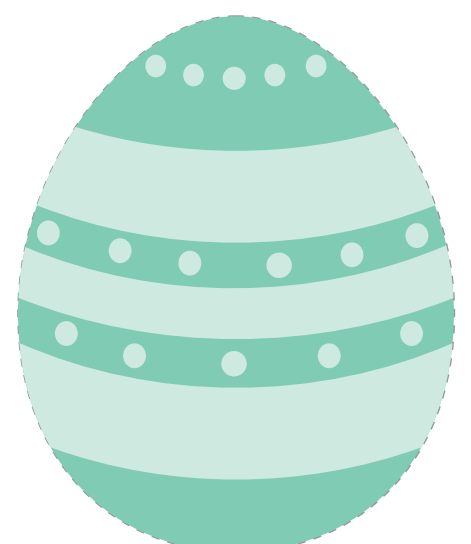
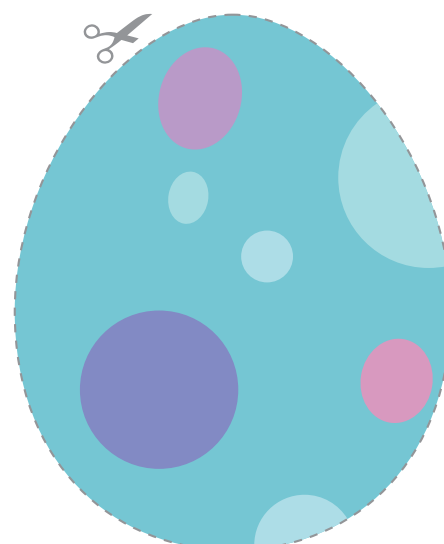
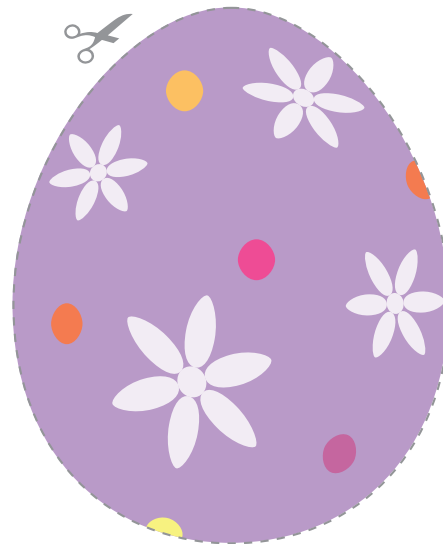
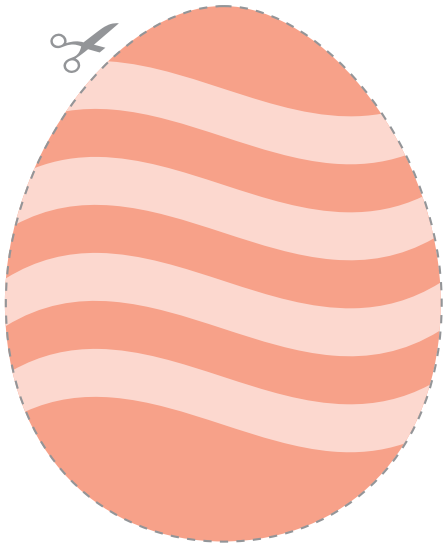
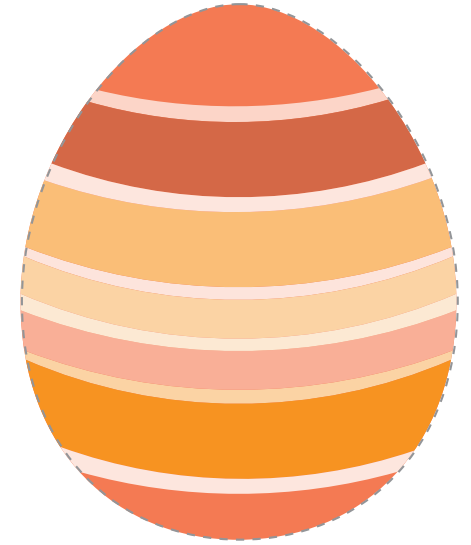
