

Easter Egg Chick Craft

Here's a fun way to make an Easter egg chick!



You will need

Scissors, glue, brass paper fastener, colouring in pens or pencils, decorations for the egg (we've used buttons and tissue paper).

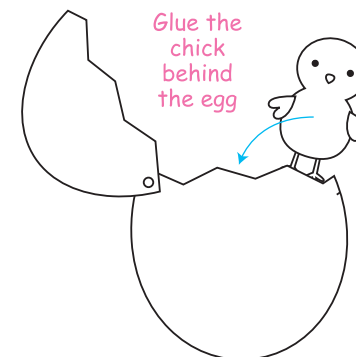
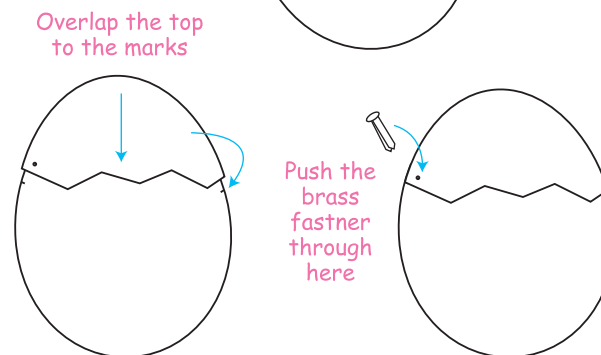
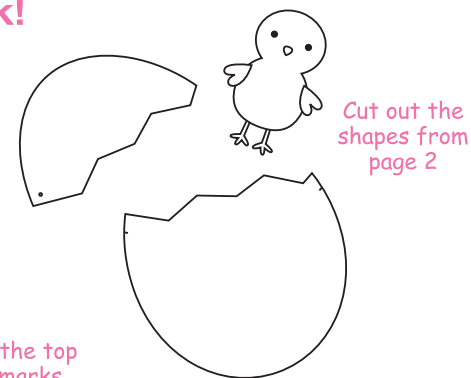
Instructions

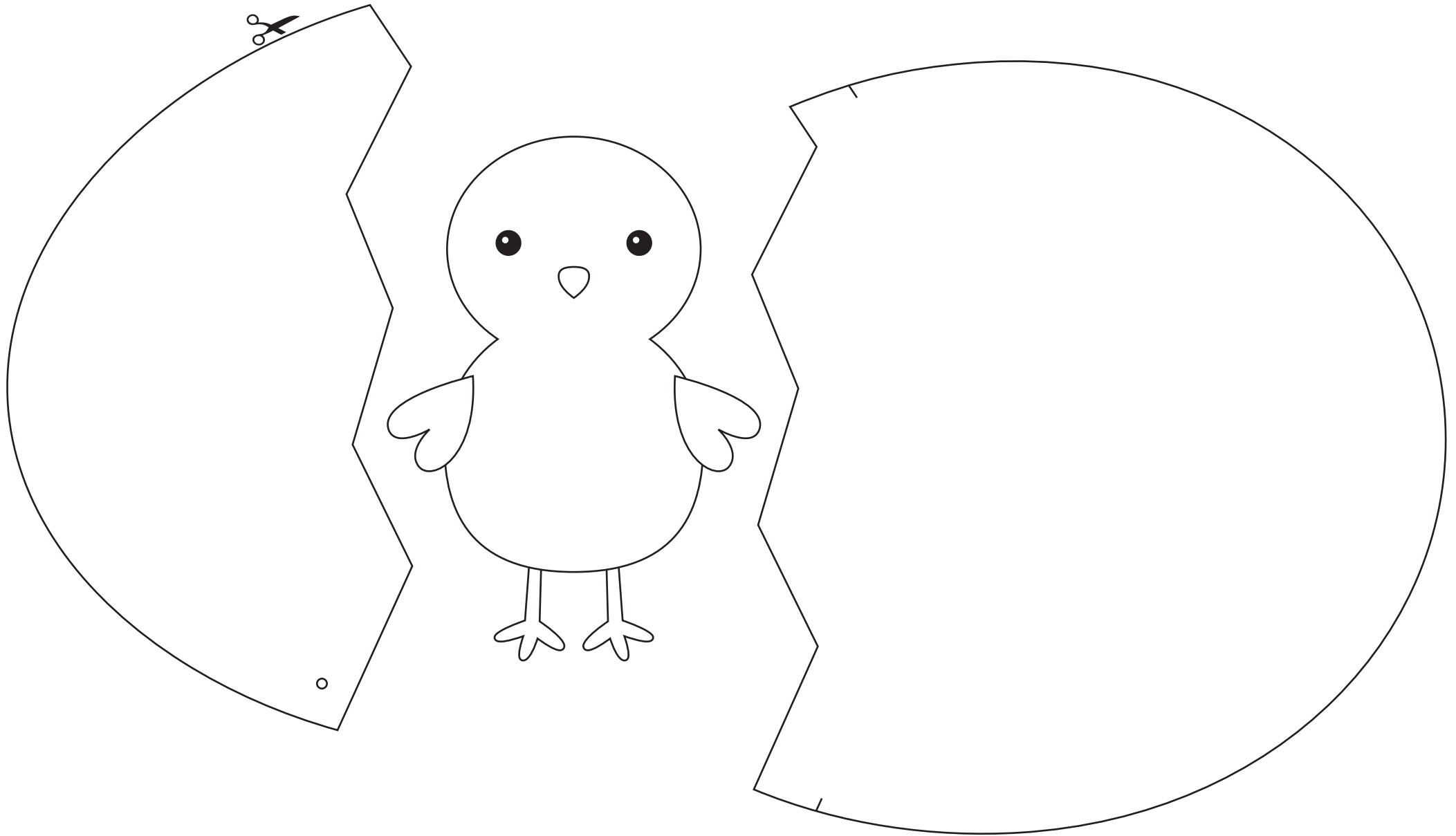
- 1 Print page 2 on to white card, then cut out. Colour in the chick then decorate the egg however you like. We've used buttons.
- 2 Overlap the top of the egg shape slightly, up to the line so that when closed the two pieces of the egg make an egg shape.
- 3 Push a brass paper fastener through the two egg pieces on the left side of the egg where shown to hold them together. Don't fasten too tightly so the egg can still open and close.
- 4 Glue the chick to the back of the bottom part of the egg. Make sure the chick is hidden when the egg is closed.

You now have a fantastic
Easter egg chick!
