

Create a Poem- Easter

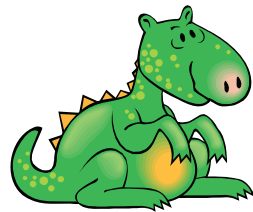

Help your child to fill in all the blank spaces to create their own poem. They might even like to try writing a poem of their own!



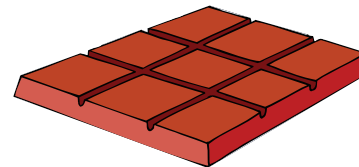

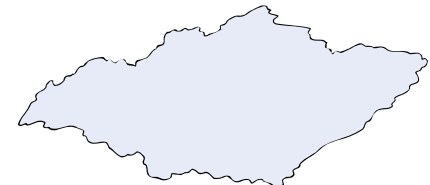
