

Make your own sheep

This activity introduces your child to different textures and increases their understanding of the world around them. It also build on their understanding of farmyard animals and builds their creative skills.

You'll need

White cotton wool balls, glue, black pens, sheet of A3 white paper or card.

- ① Using the A3 piece of paper or card as a base, tell your child that you are going to make a sheep. Spread some glue in a large oval and help your child to stick all the cotton wool balls on. Talk about what you are doing and how the cotton wool balls are similar to a sheep's coat.
- ② When you have finished, use the black pen to draw the outline of the sheep's face, eyes, ears and nose. Your child may also want to decorate the rest of the page, by adding flowers, grass etc...
