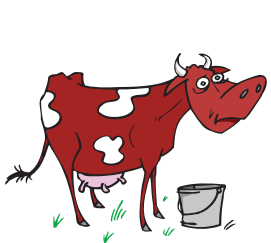


# Create a Poem- Daisy Farmyard

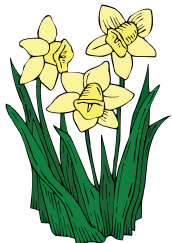

Help your child to fill in all the blank spaces to create their own poem. They might even like to try writing a poem of their own!



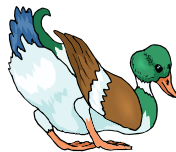

Daffodils



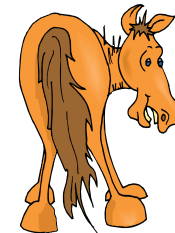
Snail

Who never left his comfy pen, yet loved to play and \_\_\_\_\_.

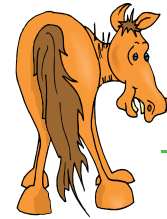


But on the first warm day of Spring, Pip woke up with a fright;
