

Father's Day Owl Craft

Here's a fun way to make an owl.

You will need

Thin card, glue, tape and scissors.

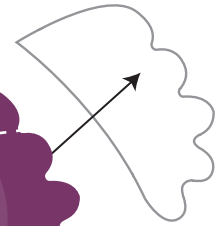
Optional

Colouring in pens or pencils and a photo.

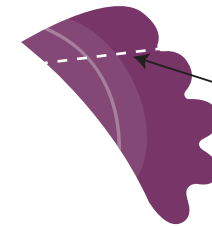
Instructions

- 1 Print pages 2-4 (Alternatively print pages 5-7 and colour them in however you like). Stick the owl body onto thin card. Next, cut out the body and both sets of wings.
- 2 Stick the wing fronts to the wing backs as shown. Then fold along the dotted lines.
- 3 With the left wing folded, place the body between the fold and line up with the small white line on the owl. (So the wing tab is behind the body). Turn over and tape in place. Do the same for the right wing. Make sure the wing covers the white panel before you stick down.
- 4 Write a message in the white space provided. You can even stick a picture here if you like!

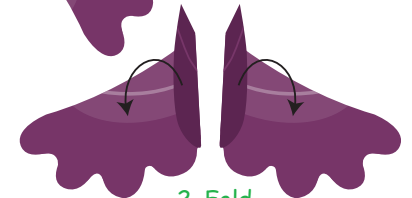
2. Stick the wing front and backs together.



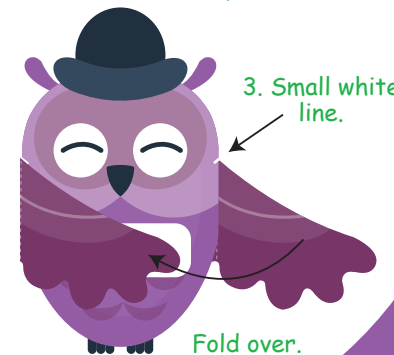
2. Fold along the dotted white line.

3. Small white line.

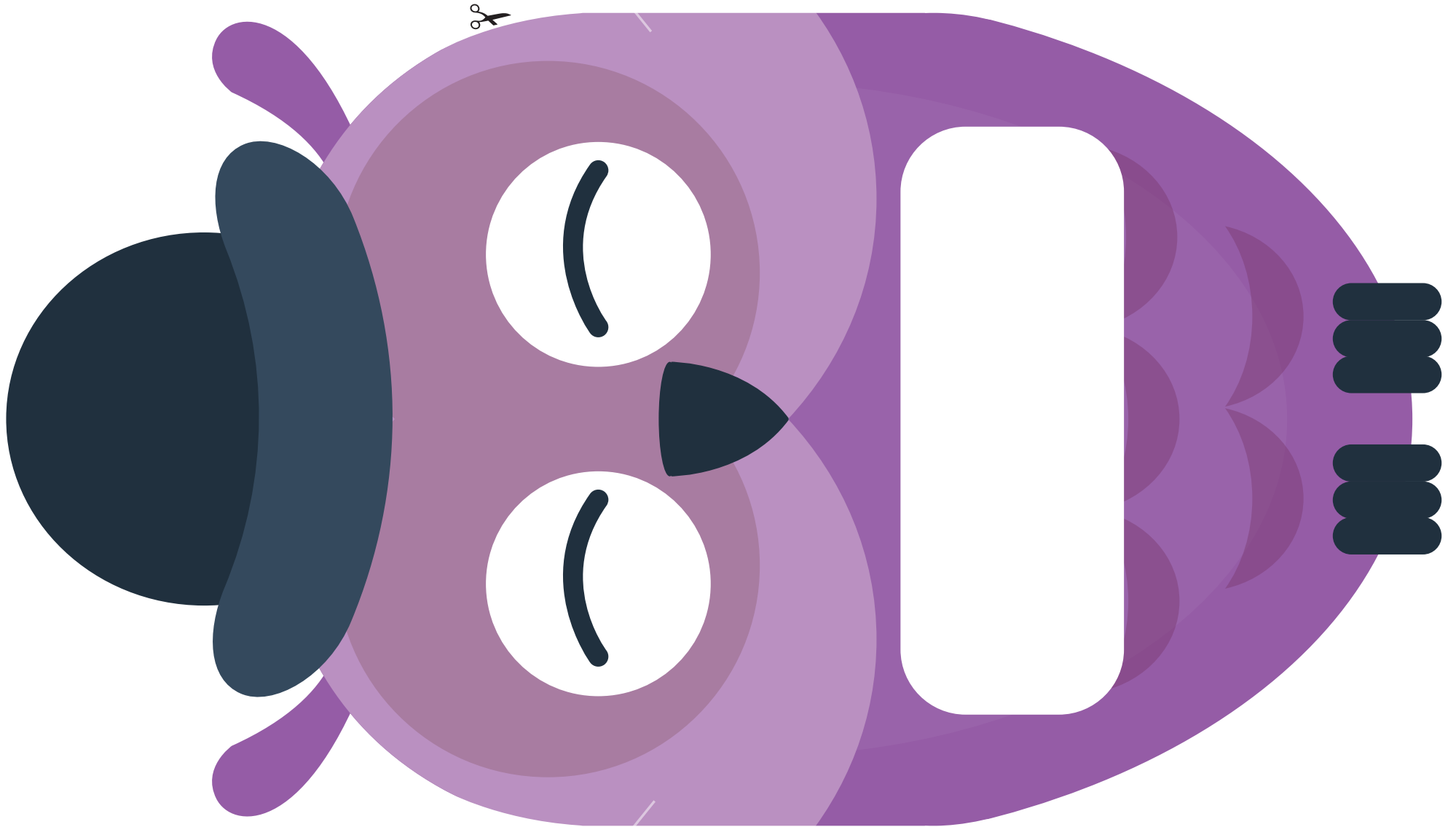


Fold over.

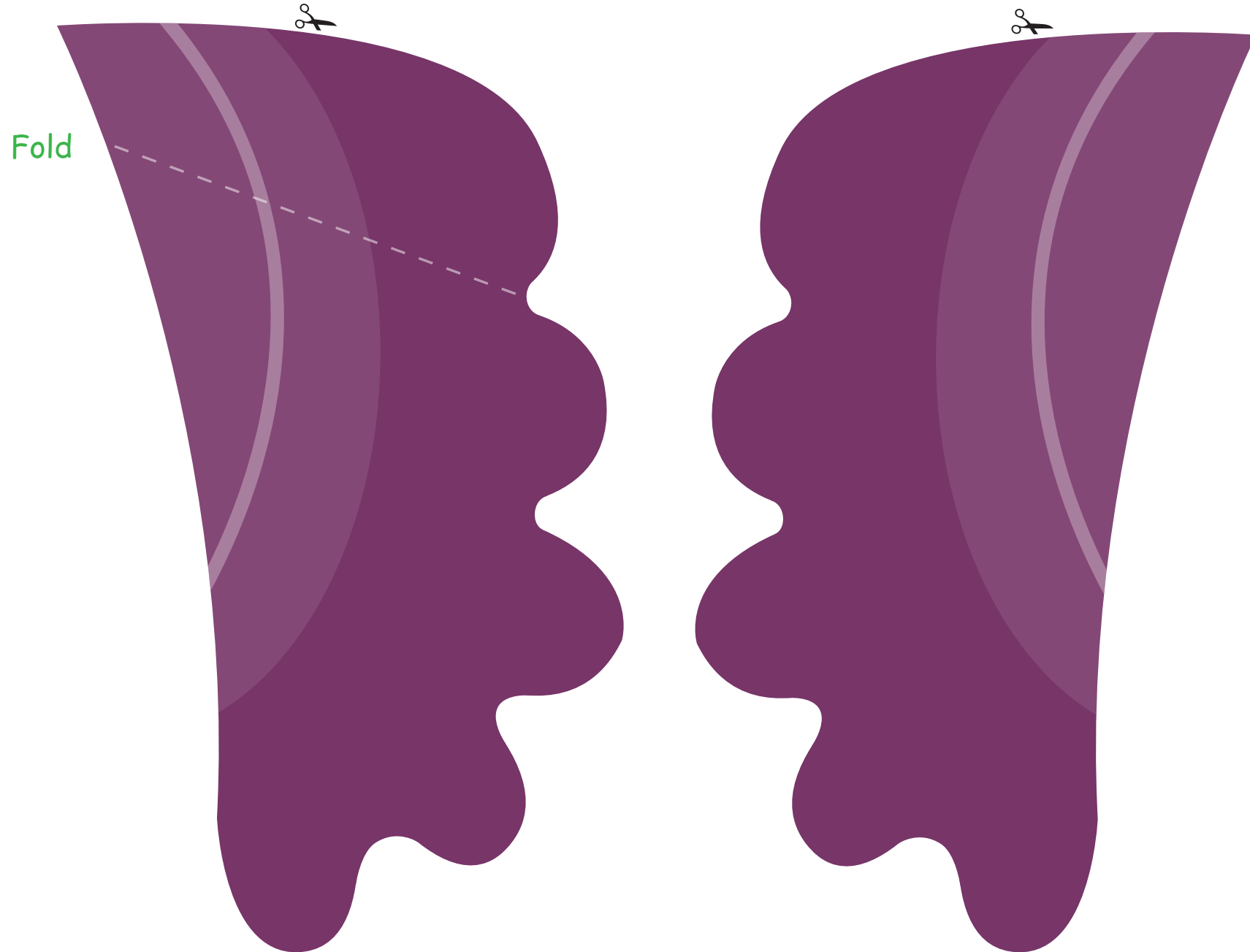

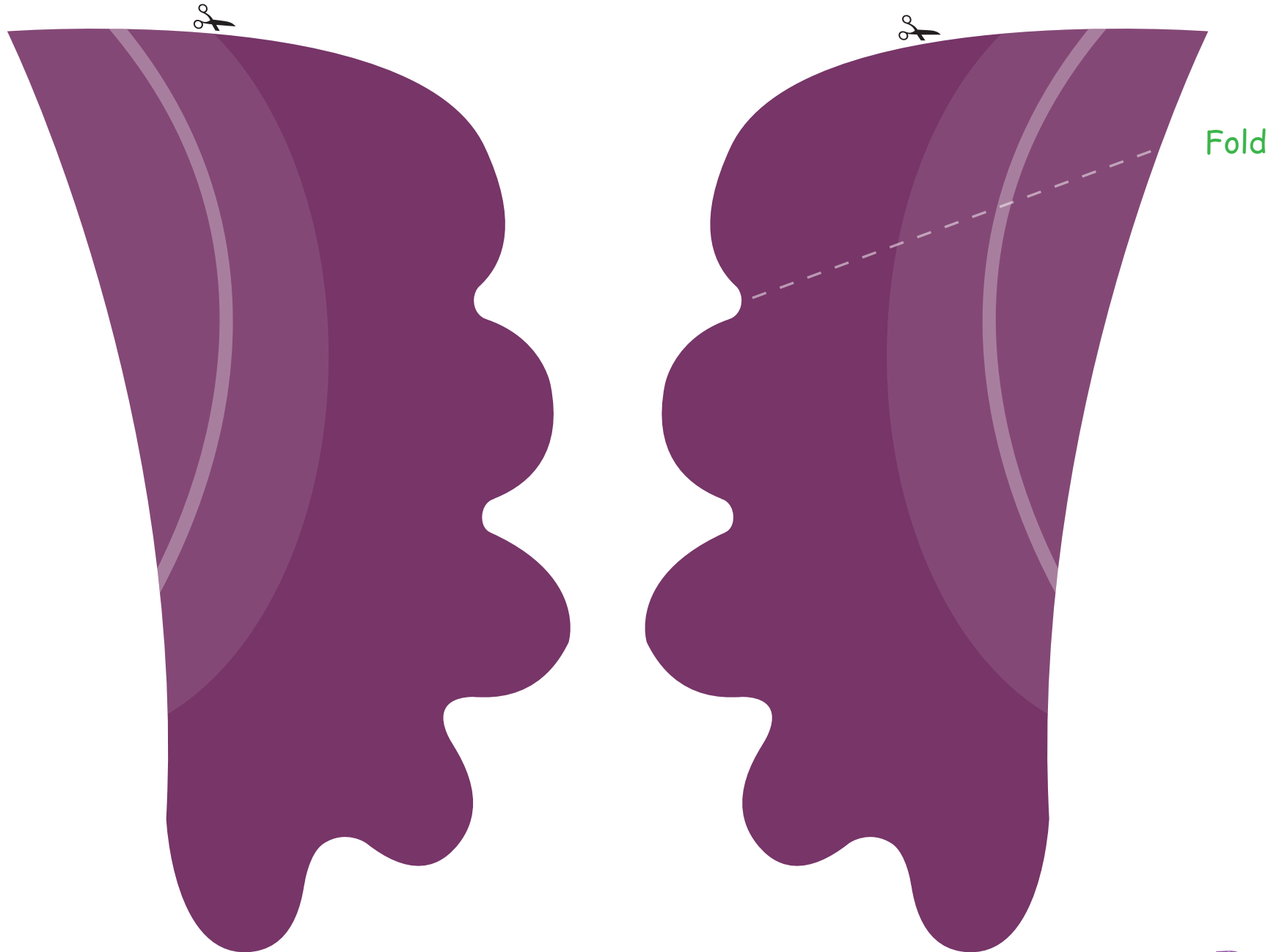

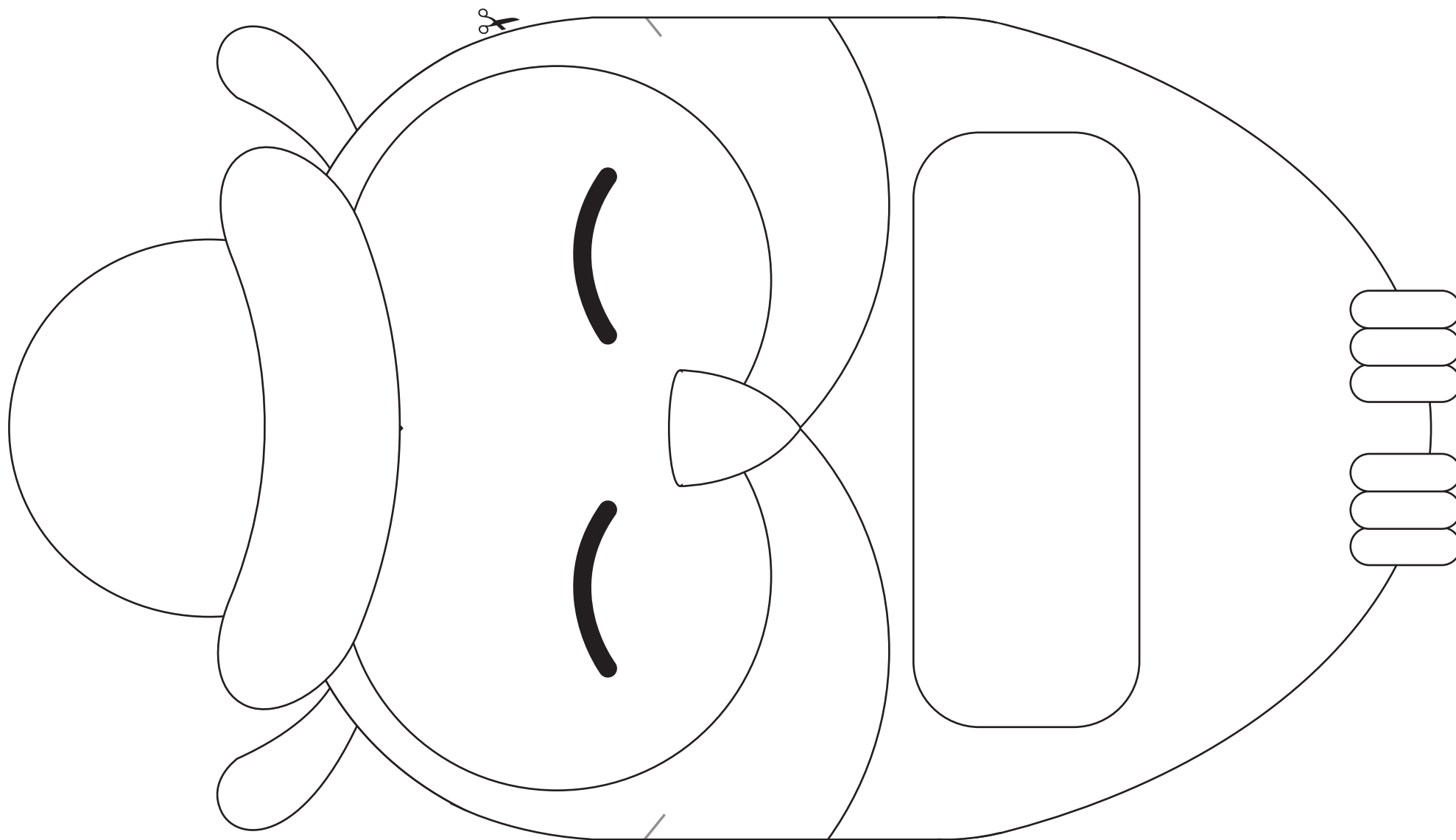


Left wing

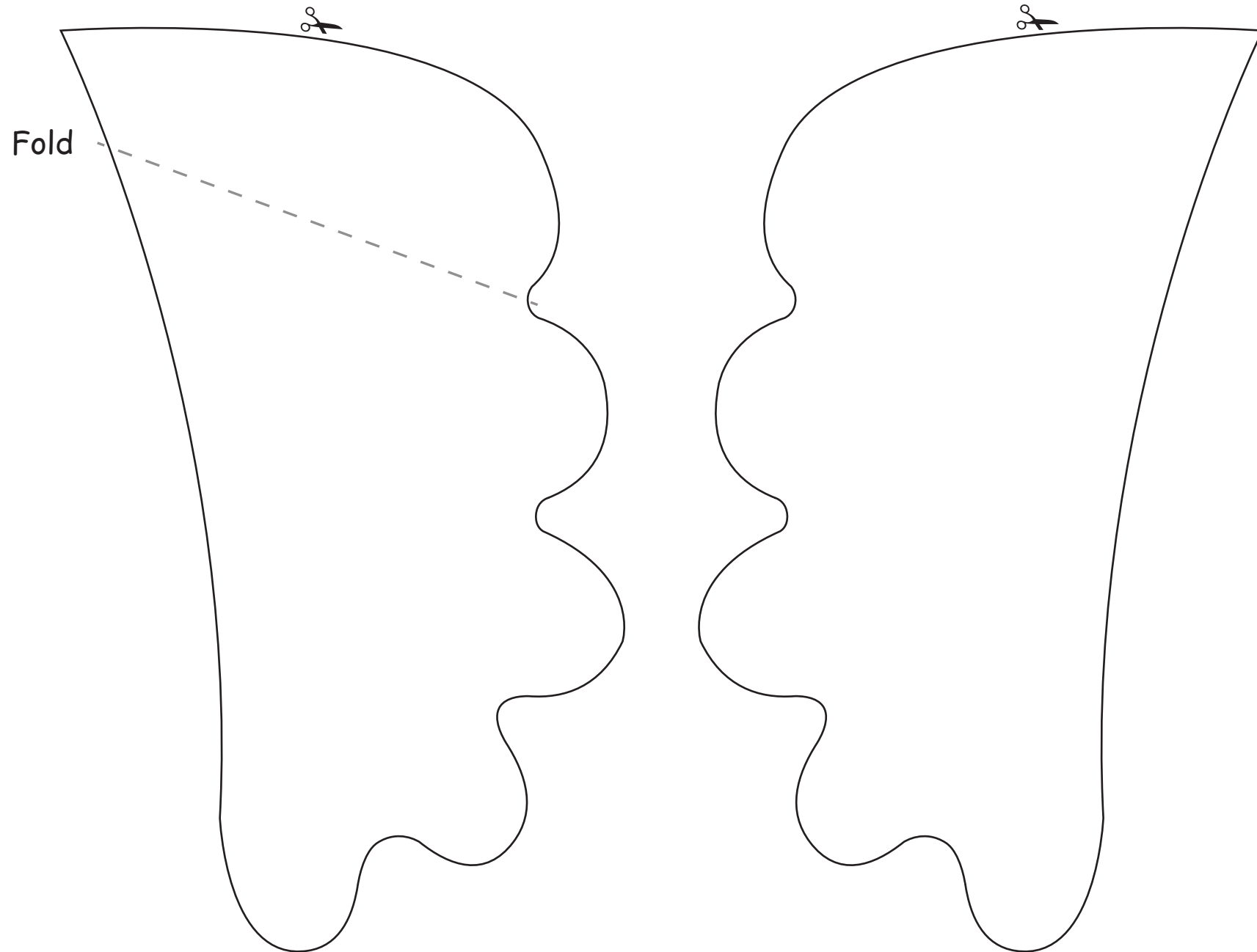


Right wing
