

Daffodil Paper Chain

Here's a fun way to make a Daffodil decoration

You will need

*Large sheet of white,
or yellow coloured paper*

Scissors

Glue

Optional items

Coloured tissue paper

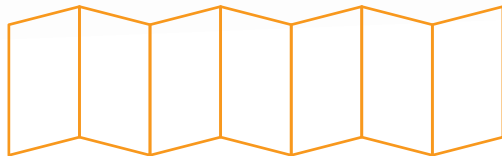
Coloured pen or pencils

Glitter



Instructions

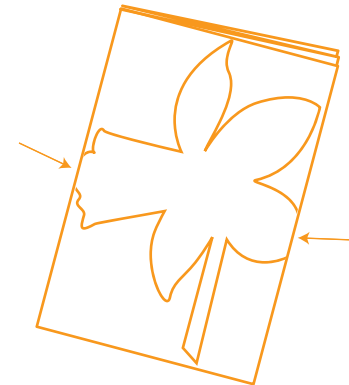
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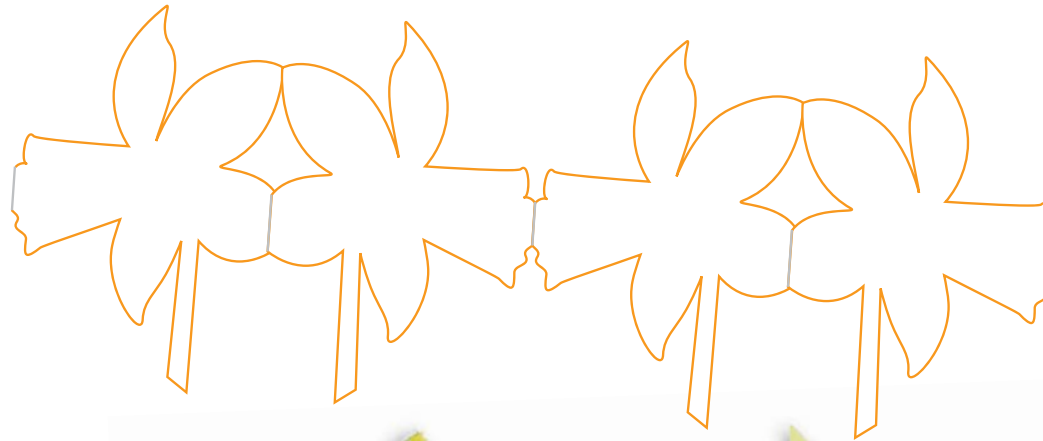
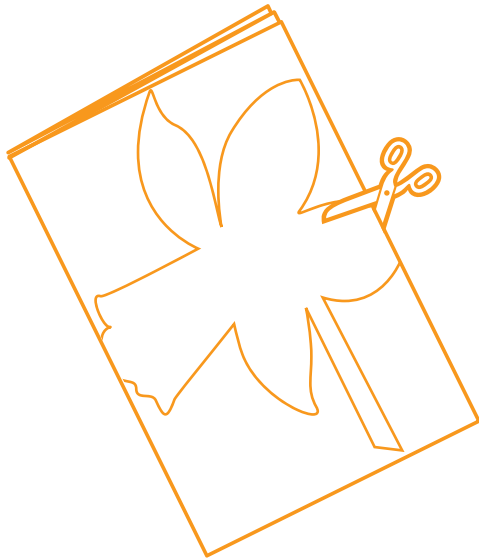
Fold the white paper into a concertina.
Alternatively you could use yellow paper.

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Draw a Daffodil shape on the front of the paper or use the Daffodil template on the third page. Make sure the Daffodil sides touch the folded edges of your paper so they will link together when it's unfolded.

- 3 Cut out the Daffodil shape. You can then unfold the Daffodil paper chain.
- 4 Decorate the Daffodils however you like! Colour them in, stick coloured tissue paper on them. You could even sprinkle them with glitter to make them sparkle! If you like you can simply cut out the pictures and shapes on the last three pages and stick them on.
