

Flower Quilling Craft

Here's a fun way to make flowers.

Instructions

- 1 For the middle of your flower, cut a thin strip of yellow paper (about 1cm wide), curl the strips up tightly to make a circle. Let go of the roll a little so there is a little space between the turns of the roll. Glue the end of the paper to keep the curl together.
- 2 Choose some coloured paper for your petals and cut into thin strips. Now, roll up in the same way as before but this time when you've finished, pinch one side as shown here. Do this again for each petal.
- 3 Stick all the elements together onto some card. It's important to stick the rolls on the card so that the spirals are visible, not the edge of the roll.
- 4 To finish off cut a long strip of green card for the flowers stalk.

You will need:

*Scissors or
a paper cutter,
Coloured paper,
glue, and
cardboard.*

You can make lots of other shapes by pinching the roll in different areas. You can glue shapes together to make animals or writing such as 'Happy Birthday'. The designs can also be used to decorate greetings cards etc.
