

Paper Plate Robin

Here's a fun way to make a Robin craft.

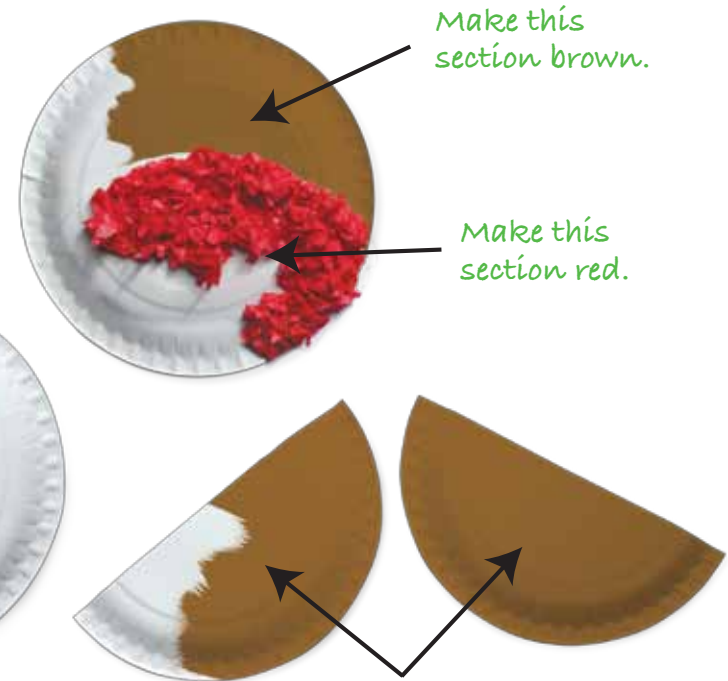


You will need:

2 White paper plates
Red tissue paper
Scissors
Glue
Brown paint
(or tissue paper)
Yellow card
Pencil

Instructions

- 1 Place one plate over the other, about half way. Draw a line with your pencil. Colour in the top half brown using paint, pens or tissue paper. Make the bottom half red using torn up red tissue paper, or you can use paint, or pens to colour in if you like.
- 2 Cut the other plate in half. The 2 halves will become the wings. Colour them brown in the same way as the Robin's body.

Make this section red.

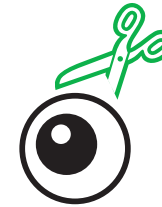
Make these sections brown.

- 3 Stick the wings behind the plate as shown above. Next, cut out a square of yellow card. (About 3cm by 3cm). Fold it in half to create the beak. Glue on to your Robin. (Alternatively, you can use the yellow squares on this page. Simply cut them out and stick the 2 squares together so it's yellow both sides. Fold as above.)

- 4 Finally, cut out the eyes and feet on this page. Glue them onto your Robin.
