

# Daffodil Craft

Here's a fun way to make a daffodil.



## You will need

Orange acrylic paint, paintbrush, green flexible straw, scissors, glue, small children's sized yoghurt/ fromage frais pot.

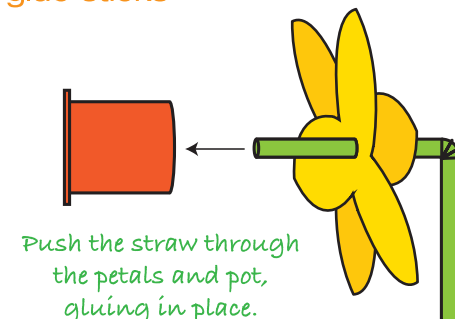
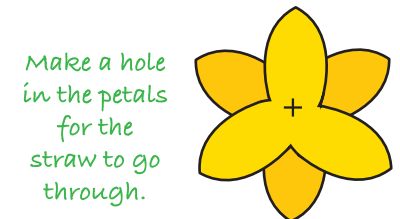
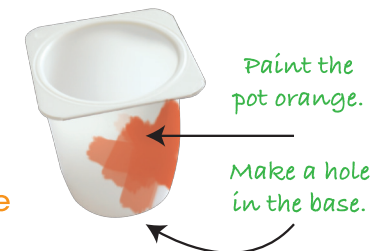
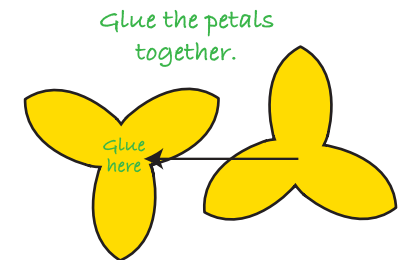
## Optional

Coloured pens and pencils, yellow paper or thin card.

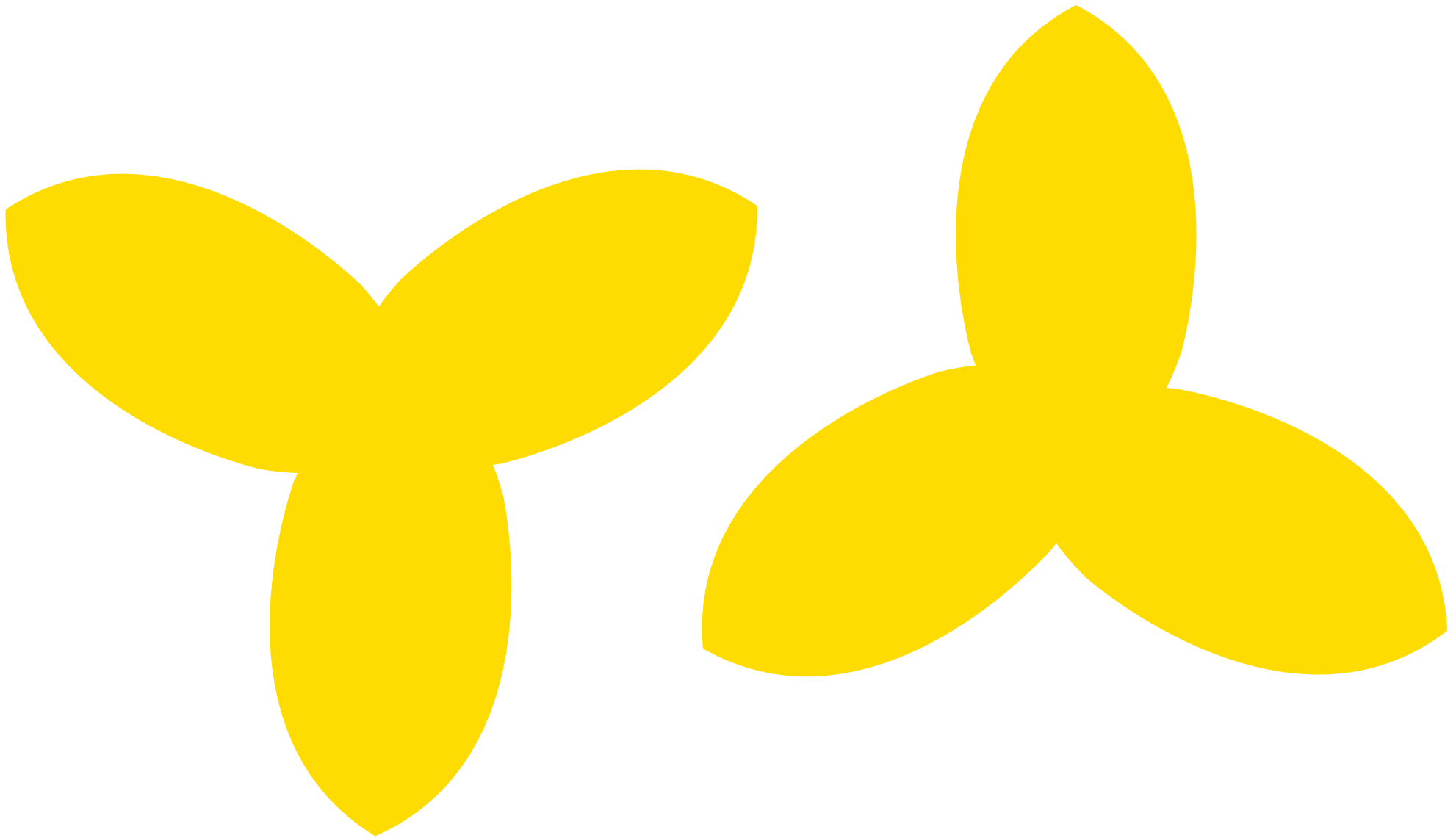
## Instructions

- 1 Cut out the daffodil petals on the next page. Or use the template on the last page, which you can either colour in or draw around on yellow paper/thin card.
- 2 Put a little glue in the middle of one of the petal shapes, then stick together as shown.
- 3 Paint a small children's sized yoghurt/ fromage frais pot orange. Wait for it to dry.
- 4 Make a small hole in the base of the pot and in the middle of the petals.
- 5 Push the straw through the hole in the petals. Put a little glue on the base of the pot, then push the straw through the hole in the pot. Push together so the glue sticks the pot in place.

You now have a fantastic daffodil!

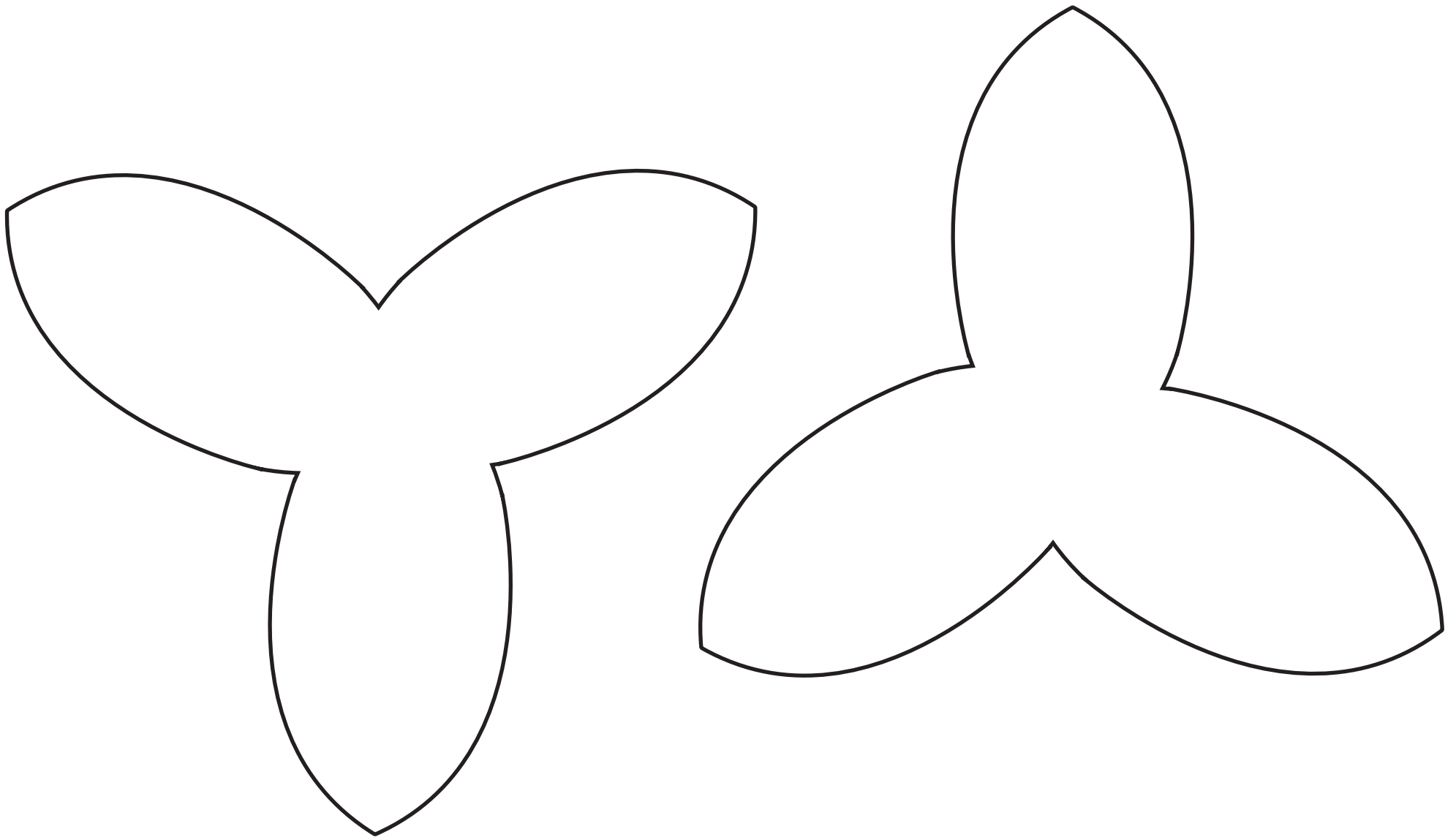


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
