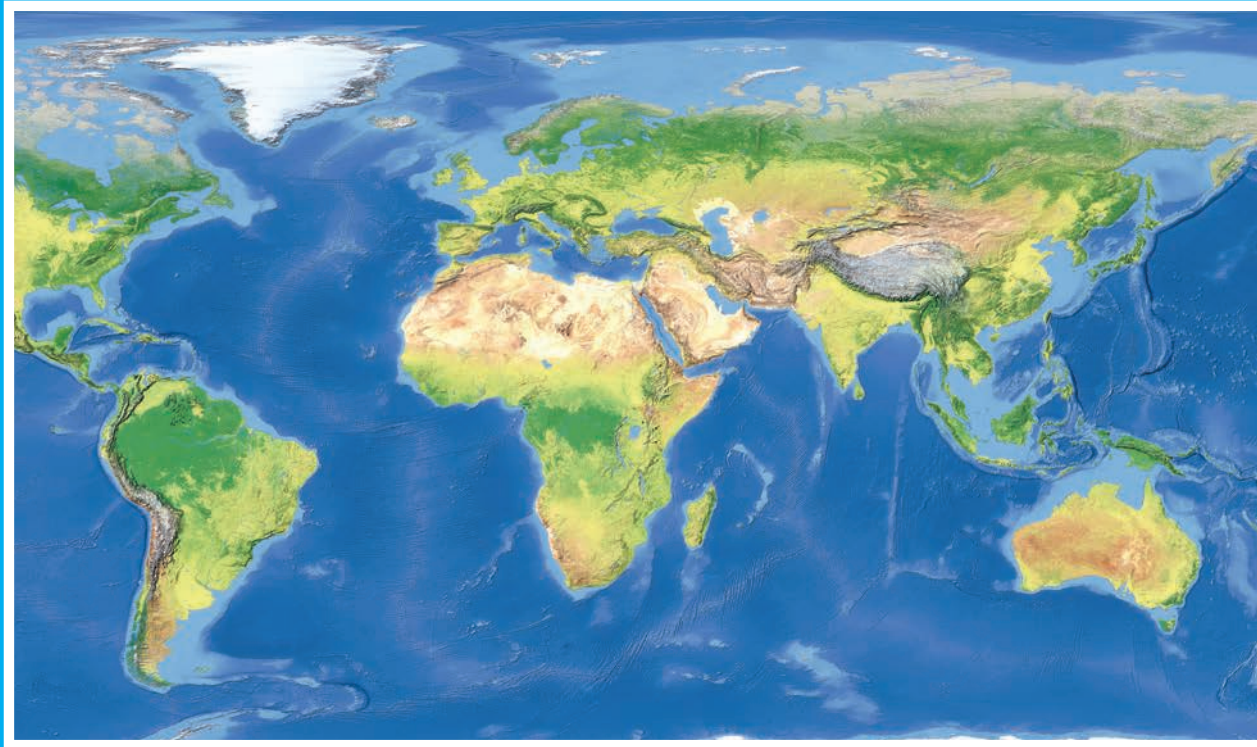

- Slide 10 explains that water flows back to the sea. And the water cycle begins again.

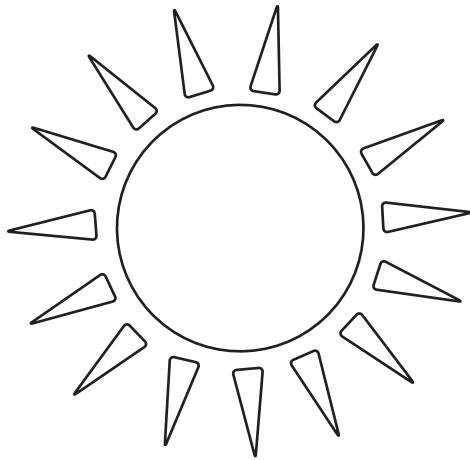
Activity

- Slide 12 introduces the next activity, in which the children are asked to label the water cycle process.

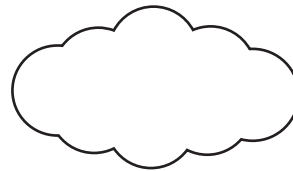

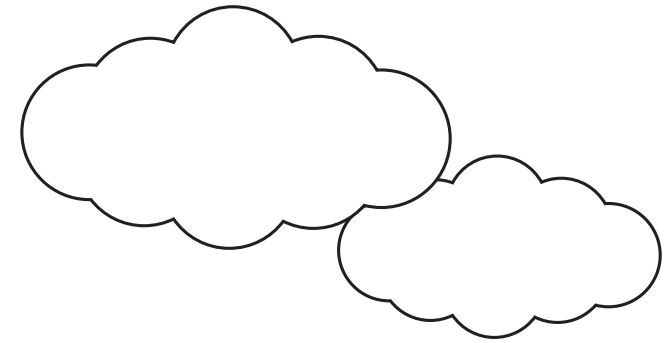

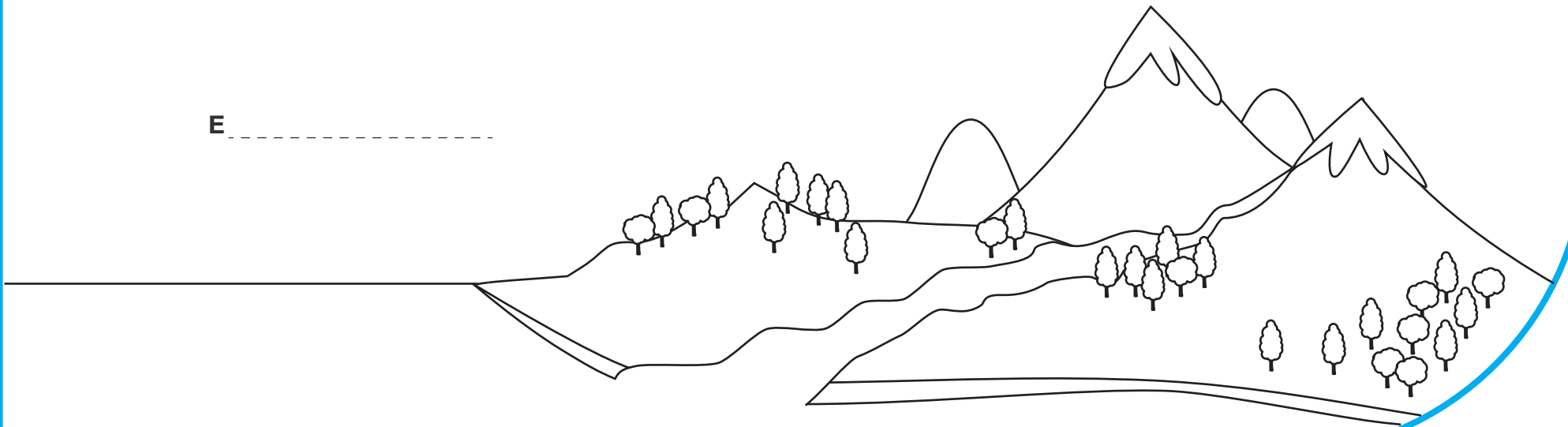
