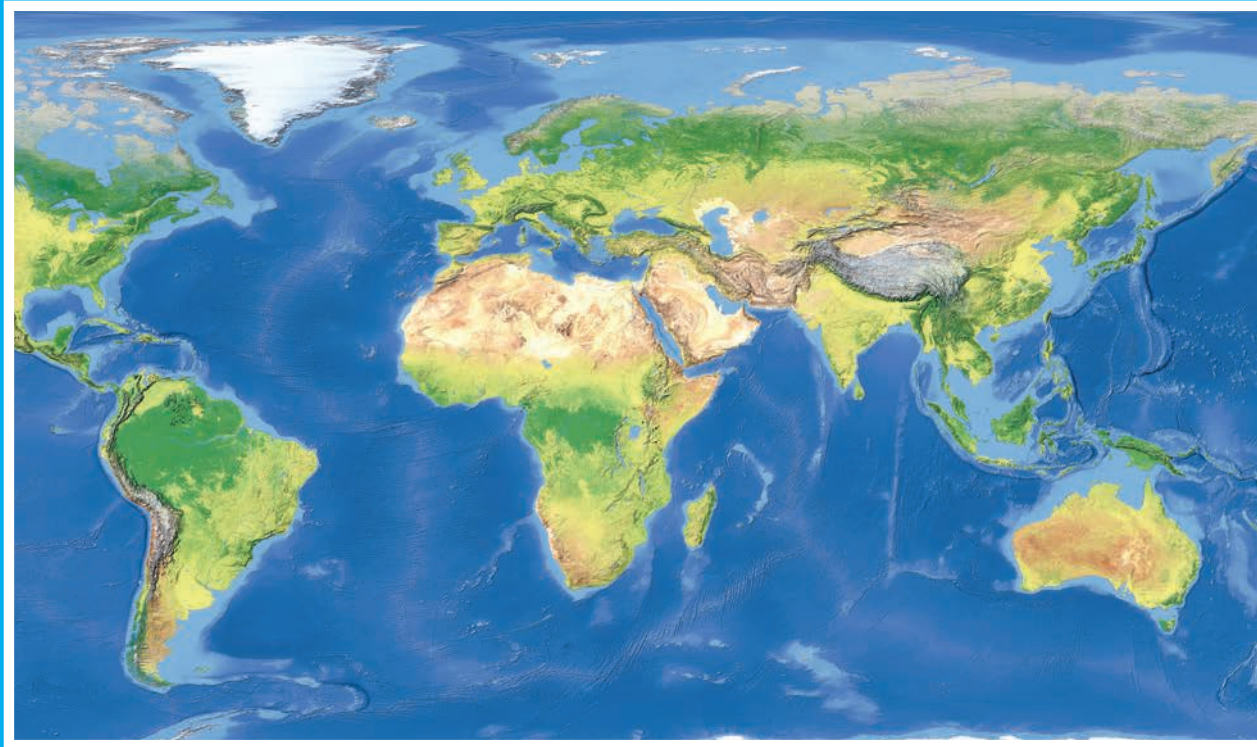

- Slide 5: Explains the process of water vapour and evaporation.
- Slide 6: Explains condensation, when clouds are formed.
- Slide 7: Explains precipitation, when water falls back to the ground as rain (or snow, sleet or hail).
