

Spider Paper Plate Craft

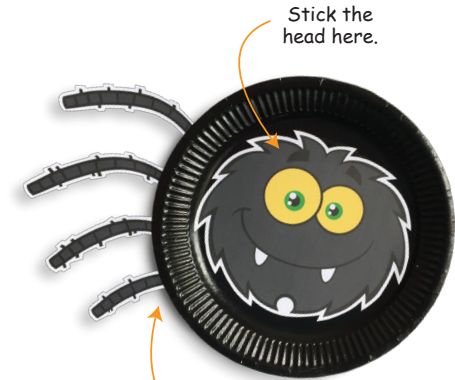
Here's a fun way to make a spider!

Instructions

- 1 Paint the paper plate black and leave to dry.
- 2 Print pages 2 to 3 on to card and cut out the head and legs. Alternatively colour in pages 4 and 5.
- 3 Stick the spider's head onto the painted plate.
- 4 Glue the spider's legs to the back of the plate where shown. Four legs one side, four legs the other side.
- 5 Make a hole at the top of the spider.
- 6 Tie a knot to the end of a piece of white string or ribbon and thread through the hole. Secure the knot with a bit of tape on the back.

You will need:

9 Inch paper plate, card, scissors, black paint or colouring in pen, hole punch, glue, tape and white string/ribbon.



Glue the legs behind the body.

Tie a knot at the end of the string, thread through the hole and secure with tape.



You now have a fantastic
Spider!
