- 1 Sit down with the children and show them the series of pictures overleaf. You may wish to lay the sheets out either on a table or the floor, and then read the story.
- 2 Ask the children the following questions and discuss them:-
What part of the story did you like and why?
Which pictures did you like or didn't you like and why?
Who helps you?
- 3 Talk to the children about who looks after them and what they do.
- 4 Talk about what happens when you do something wrong.
