This is the first day of Spring where Saraswati Goddess of Learning, is worshipped.



- ① Sit down with the children and show them the series of pictures overleaf. You may wish to lay the sheets out either on a table or the floor, and then read the story.
- ② Ask the children the following questions and discuss them:-
What do you like learning about?
How do you find out how to do things?
- ③ Discover some special creations in nature such as at the park, for example a spider's web, a snail's shell, new plants growing etc.

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The Goddess Saraswati is usually pictured with 4 arms, wearing a white Sari and seated on a lotus flower. She has a book. There is always a peacock in the picture.
