

Eid Moon & Crescent Craft

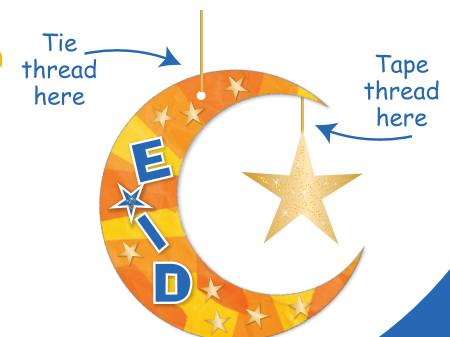
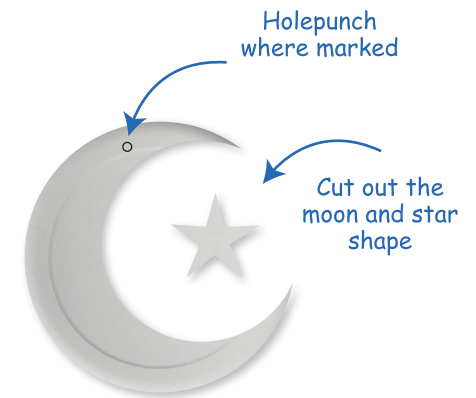
Here's a fun way to make an Eid decoration.

Instructions

- 1 Cut your paper plate into a moon shape by using the template on the next page. Mark the position of the hole. (Alternatively print the next page onto card and cut out).
- 2 Cut a star out of the leftover card.
- 3 Punch a hole at the top of the moon shape in the position marked.
- 4 Decorate the moon and star however you like, being careful not to cover the hole. You can colour in and use the stars and letters on the next page.
- 5 Tie some gold thread through the hole so you can hang up your decoration.
- 6 Tape some gold thread to the back of your star. Tape the other end to the point of the moon, make it long enough so the star sits in the middle of your moon shape when you hang it up.

You will need:

One 23cm diameter white paper plate, (or one A4 sheet of thin card), tape, pencil, scissors, holepunch, thread (gold). Decorating materials such as tissue paper, pens, pencils, glitter, stickers etc.



You now have a fantastic Eid decoration!
