

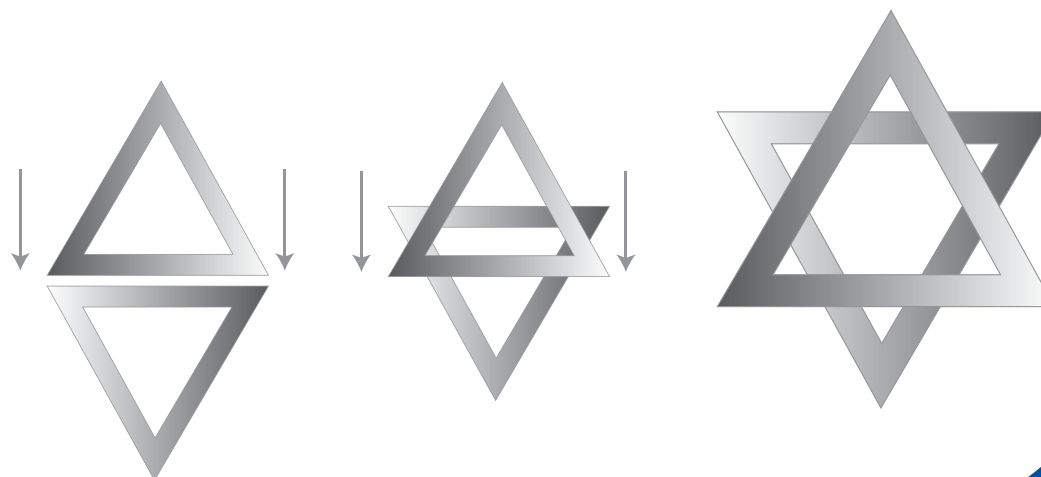
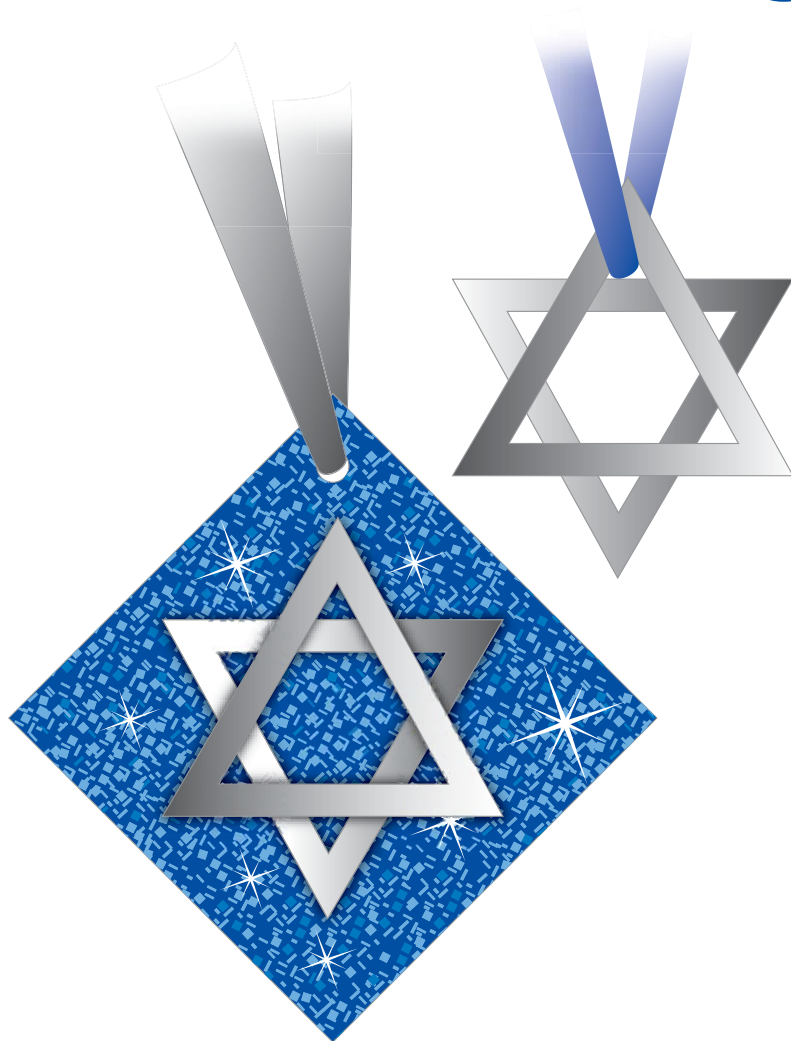
Star of David hanging Hanukkah decoration

You'll need

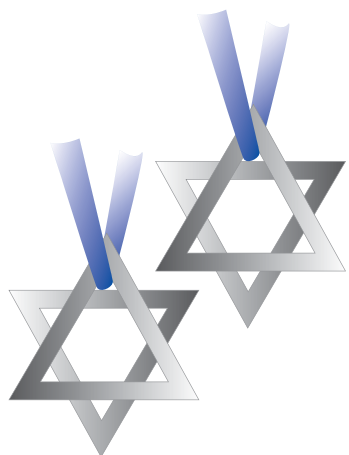
Card, scissors, silver foil or silver paint, blue paper, blue beads, or blue glitter, sticky tape, blue or silver ribbon, and some glue.

Instructions

- 1 Cut the four triangles out of card from page 3 and cover them with silver foil. Alternatively paint them silver.
- 2 Overlap two triangles to make a star shape. Stick them together with glue or tape. Do this again with the other two triangles. You should now have two stars!

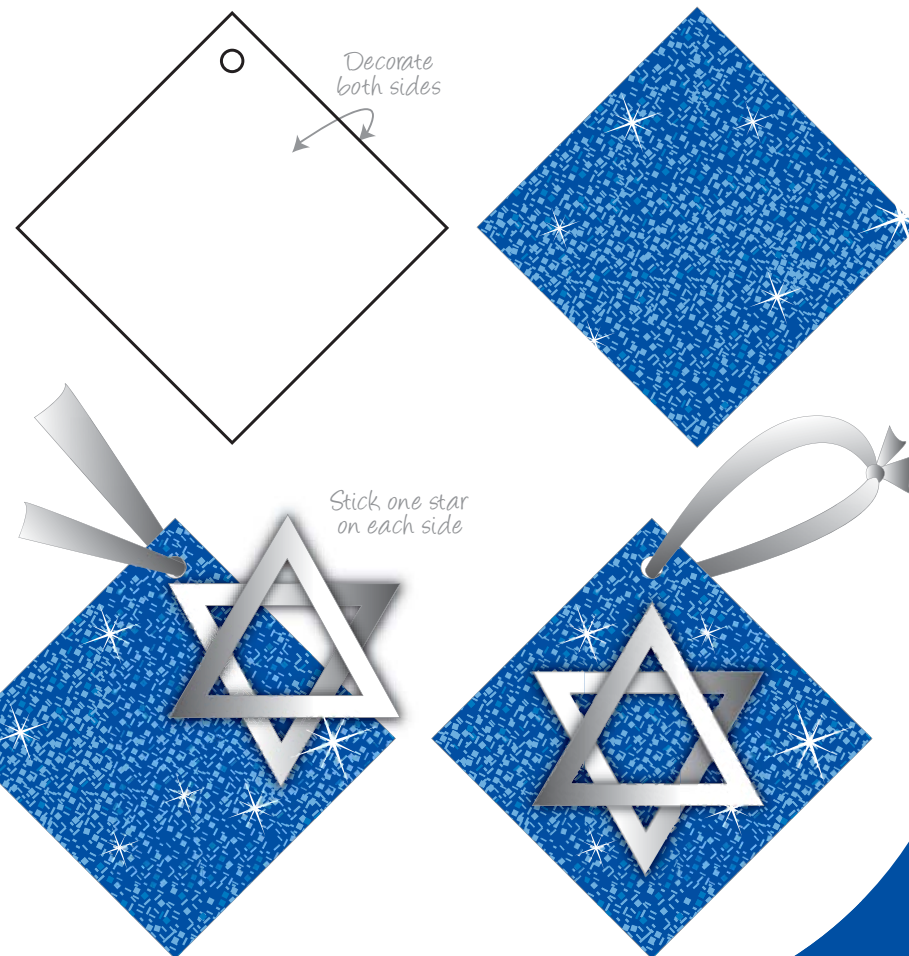
- 3 You can thread some ribbon through the top hole and use them as they are, or you could put your star on a background.

- 4 For the background. Cut out the diamond shape on the last page. Cover it with blue paper or be as creative as you like! You could cover it with blue beads, glitter or shiny sweet paper wrappers. Do this by covering the shape in glue and placing the beads or paper on to the glue. Repeat again on the other side when dry, so your shape is totally covered on both sides.

- 5 Now make a hole big enough to thread your ribbon through at the top of the diamond shape. *You should get an adult to help with this.*

- 6 Glue one star in the middle on one side and the other in the middle on the other side. Then thread your ribbon through the hole. Tie a knot to make a loop and hang it up.
