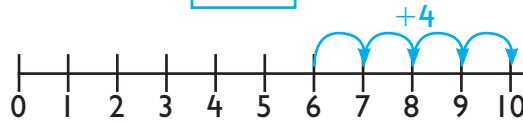


Pairs totalling 10 and 20

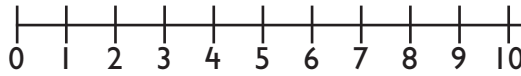
We can use a number line to help find pairs of numbers that total 10.

$$6 + \boxed{4} = 10$$

$$2 + \boxed{} = 10$$



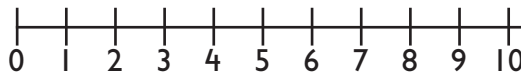
$$7 + \boxed{} = 10$$



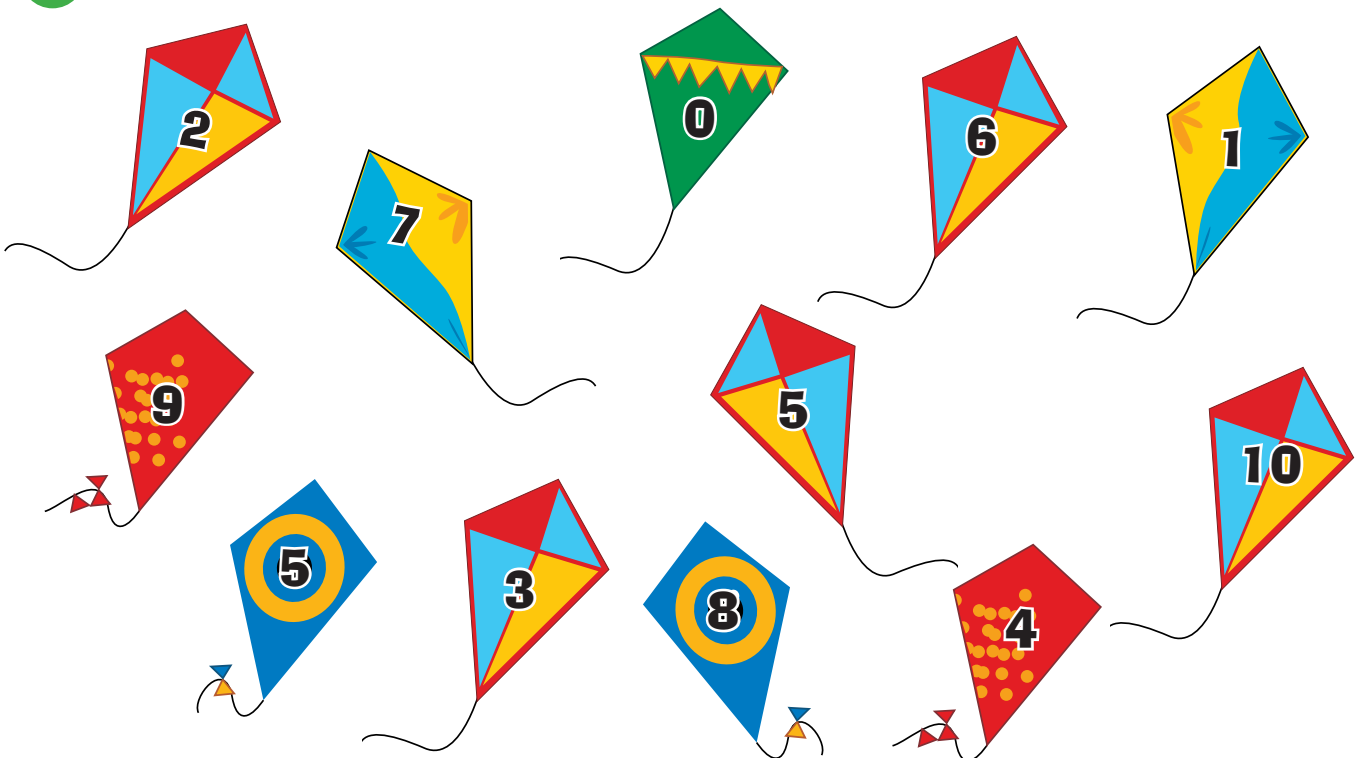
$$9 + \boxed{} = 10$$



$$5 + \boxed{} = 10$$

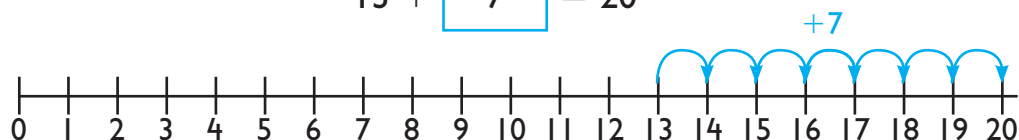


Q2 Draw lines to join each pair of kites that total 10.



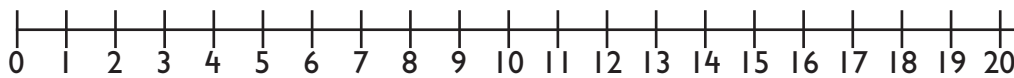
We can use a number line to help find pairs of numbers that total 20.

$$13 + \boxed{7} = 20$$

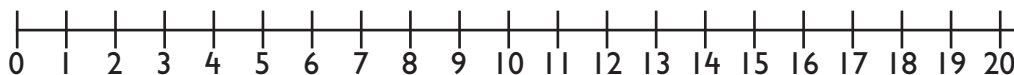


Q3 Use the number lines to work out pairs of numbers that total 20.

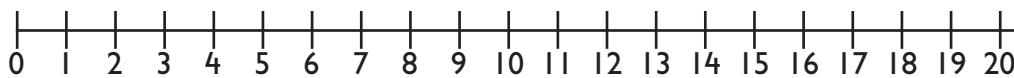
$$16 + \boxed{} = 20$$



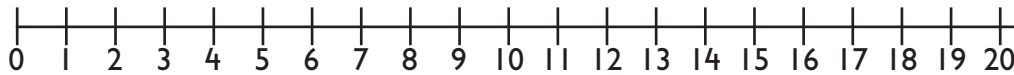
$$9 + \boxed{} = 20$$



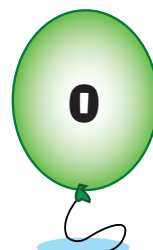
$$18 + \boxed{} = 20$$
