4 How much money would you save after **30 weeks**?

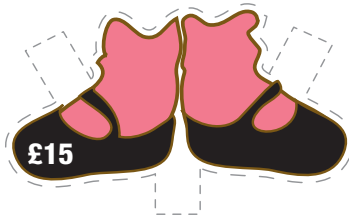
- Print out, stick on to card, and cut out these figures.

- Cut out the clothes you have chosen and use the tabs to secure them on the figure.

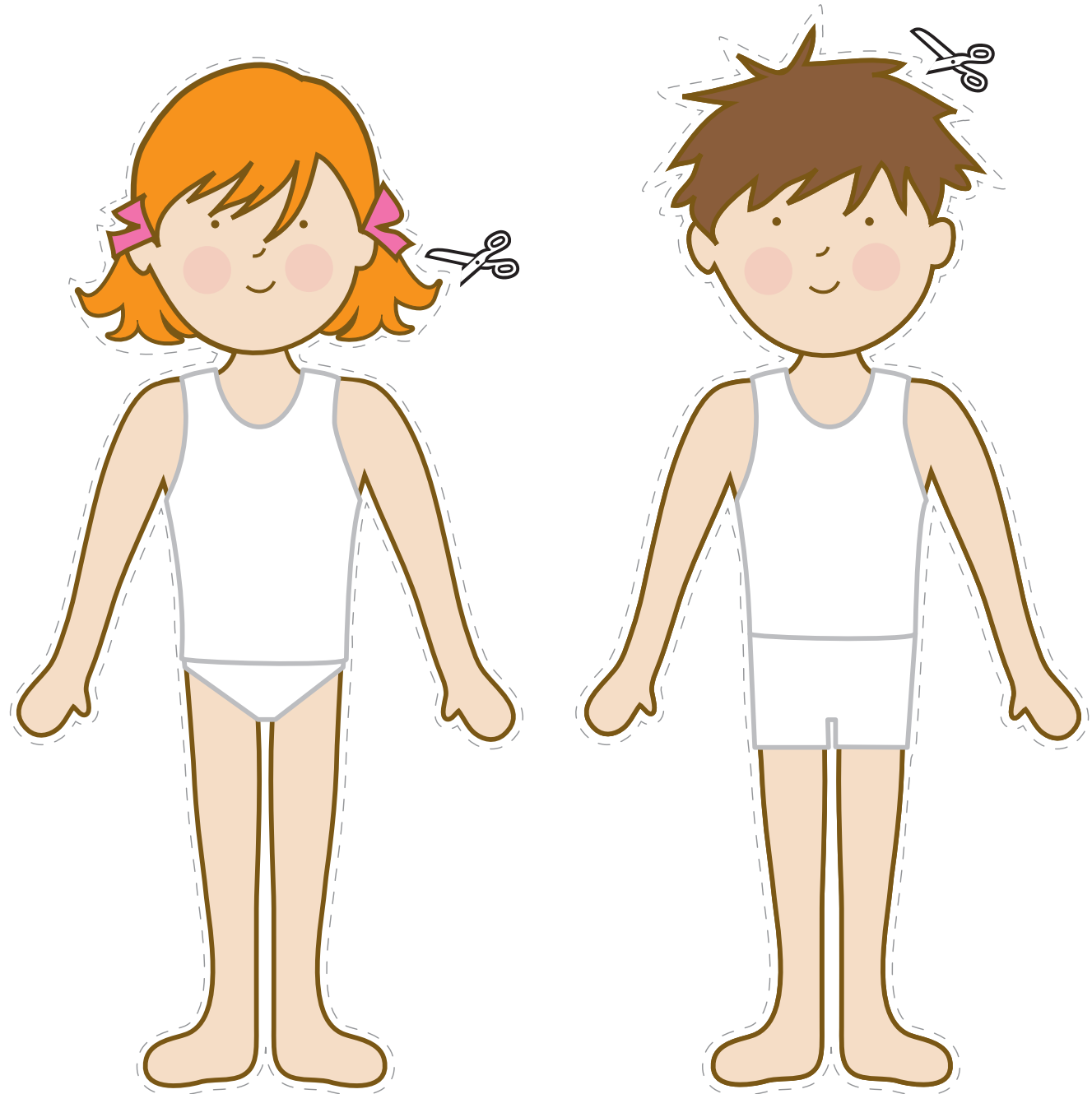
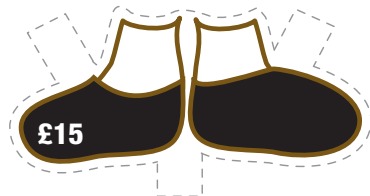
