

Money money money game

Activity 6

Games are an excellent way to teach your child new ideas and concepts. They not only stimulate their language development but they also help with social skills and interaction with others. This game is designed to help them learn more about the concept of saving.



The Ten Year 10% Saver Account

You have to keep your money in this account for ten years. If you take any money out before then you have to pay a £50 penalty on each withdrawal.

The Easy Saver Account

This lets you take your money out five times a year without having to pay any penalties. You must save at least £20 a month.

The Easy Withdrawal Account

You can save as much as you like and you will receive 5% interest a year on your savings. You can take the money out at any time without any penalties.

The Three Year Account

You can pay money in but you cannot take any out for at least 3 years.

There are several different ways to play this game depending on how many players there are. The object of the game is to collect one full set of cards out of the four sets.

The game has been designed for older primary children, however it could be modified for younger children. See the instructions for 1 – 4 players below.

You will need

Card, glue, and scissors.

How to play

- Print out the cards, stick them onto card and cut them out.
- Mix the cards up and turn them upside down.

For 3 – 4 players:

- Each player must pick up five of the cards from the middle.
- Each player must pass the card they don't want to the player on their left.
- The game goes on by continuing to pass cards to the left, until one of the players manages to collect a complete set of four cards plus a Joker. You will have 5 cards in total.
- When they have a set of four cards plus a joker they shout 'Set' and the game stops whilst the cards are checked. If they have a full set the player is declared the winner, if not the game goes on until someone gets a full set.
- If you are playing with 3 players print off 3 sets of cards and the Joker cards.

For 1 - 4 players:

- Shuffle the cards and then place them face down in four rows of five cards. Each player then has to turn over two cards at a time. If they are cards of the same set (or two matching Jokers), then the player picks up the two cards and takes another turn. If not, the cards are turned back over and it is the next player's turn.
- The winner is the first person to pick up a complete set of cards or the person who has the most cards at the end of the game.

Additional Activities

- Make up some different games using the same cards.
- Ask your child to design a logo for one of the accounts on the cards, see the drawing template provided on the next page.
- Ask your child to design a savings leaflet for one of the accounts. You will find a separate leaflet template activity in this section on iChild.
- Talk about the different types of accounts shown on the cards. Which is best?
- Investigate Junior ISAs and Child Investment Plans.
