

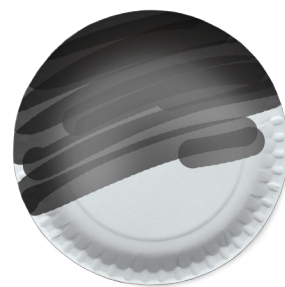
Ladybird Paper Plate Craft

Here's a fun way to make a Ladybird.



You will need:

2 White paper plates,
scissors, glue,
black paint or pen,
red tissue paper
or red paint.



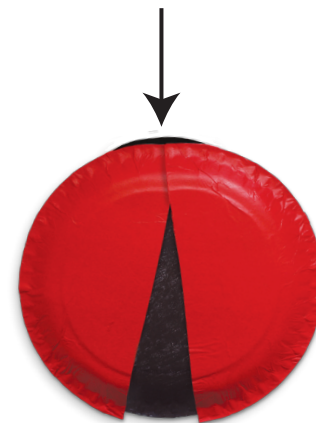
Paint the back of
one plate black.



Cut a plate in half,
then cover the back
with red tissue paper.



Glue one wing in place leaving a
small bit of black plate showing at
the top. Glue the other wing slightly
over the top of the other wing.

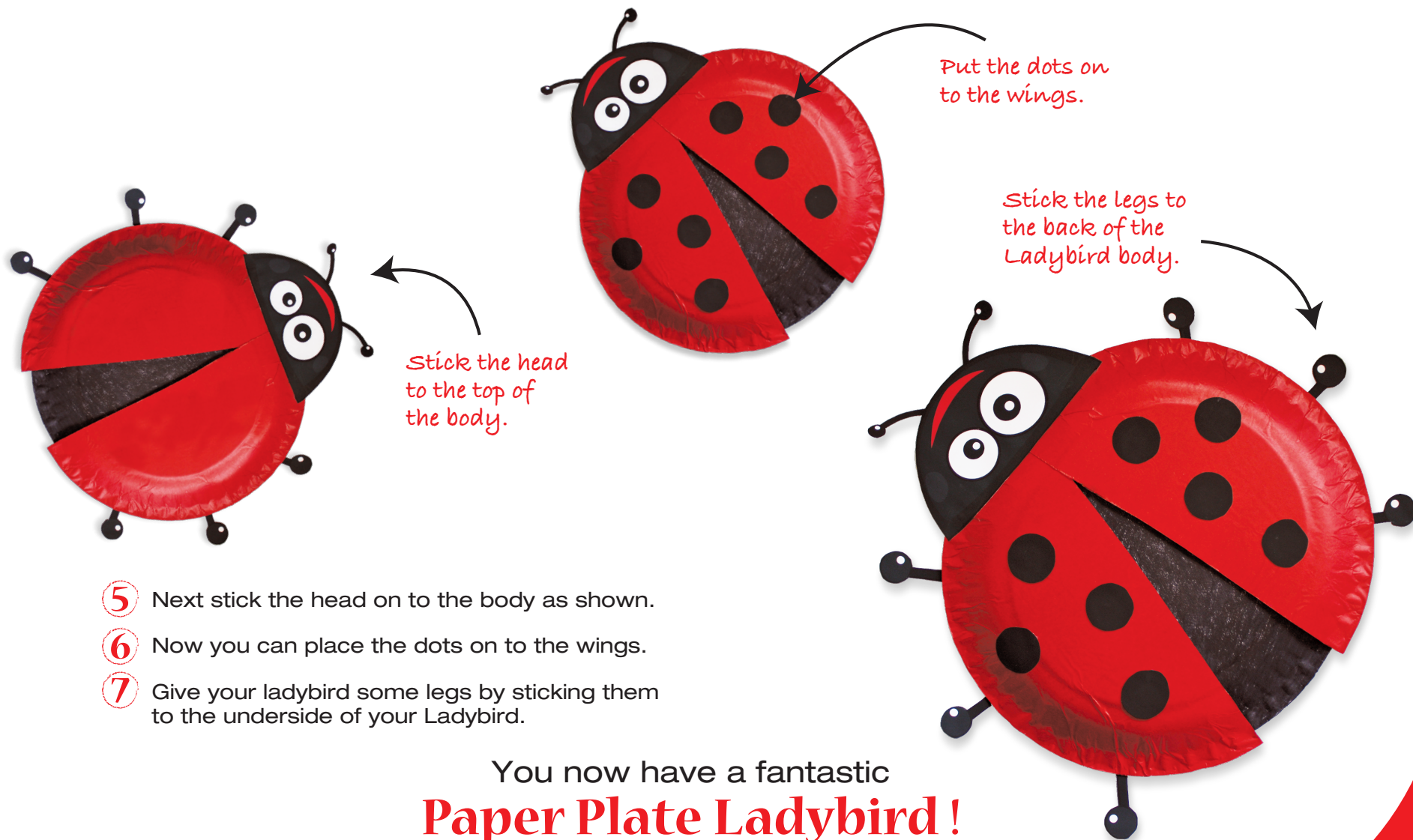


Instructions

- 1 Paint one paper plate black, then leave to dry. Alternatively you could use a black marker pen.
- 2 To make the Ladybird wings, cut the other paper plate in half, then cover the back of both halves with red tissue paper. Alternatively you can use red paint or a marker pen.
- 3 Next print out and cut out the Ladybird parts on the last page.
- 4 Put all the elements together by first sticking the wings on to the black plate as shown above.

- 5 Next stick the head on to the body as shown.
- 6 Now you can place the dots on to the wings.
- 7 Give your ladybird some legs by sticking them to the underside of your Ladybird.

Paper Plate Ladybird !
