

Make a New Year's Eve Clock

Here's a fun way to make a clock for New Year's Eve.



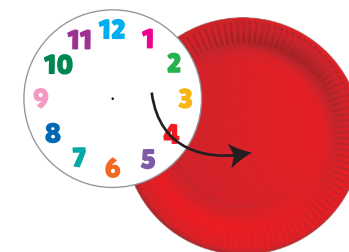
You will need:

9 inch paper plate, scissors, straw, red tissue paper, ribbon, glue stick, tape, glitter, paper fastener.

Instructions

- 1 Print pages 2 to 4. Stick the 2017 star and clock hands on to card then cut out all the pictures.
- 2 Cover the paper plate with red tissue paper. Then stick on the clock face.
- 3 Decorate with the streamer and star pictures. Use glitter too!
- 4 Tape the 2017 star to a straw, then tape the straw to the back of the clock behind the number 12.
- 5 Push the paper fastener through the dots on each clock hand (small hand first), then through the clock face. Fold back the fasteners to secure the hands in place.
- 6 Tape a loop of ribbon to the back of the clock and hang up!

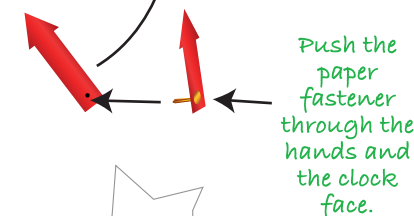
You now have a fantastic
New Year's Eve Clock!



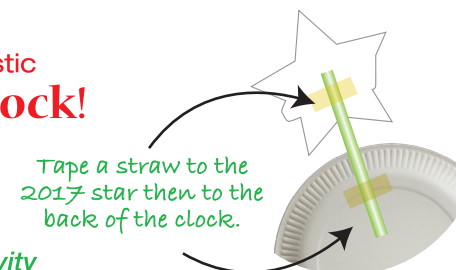
Cover the plate with red tissue paper then stick on the clock.



Decorate with stars and streamers.



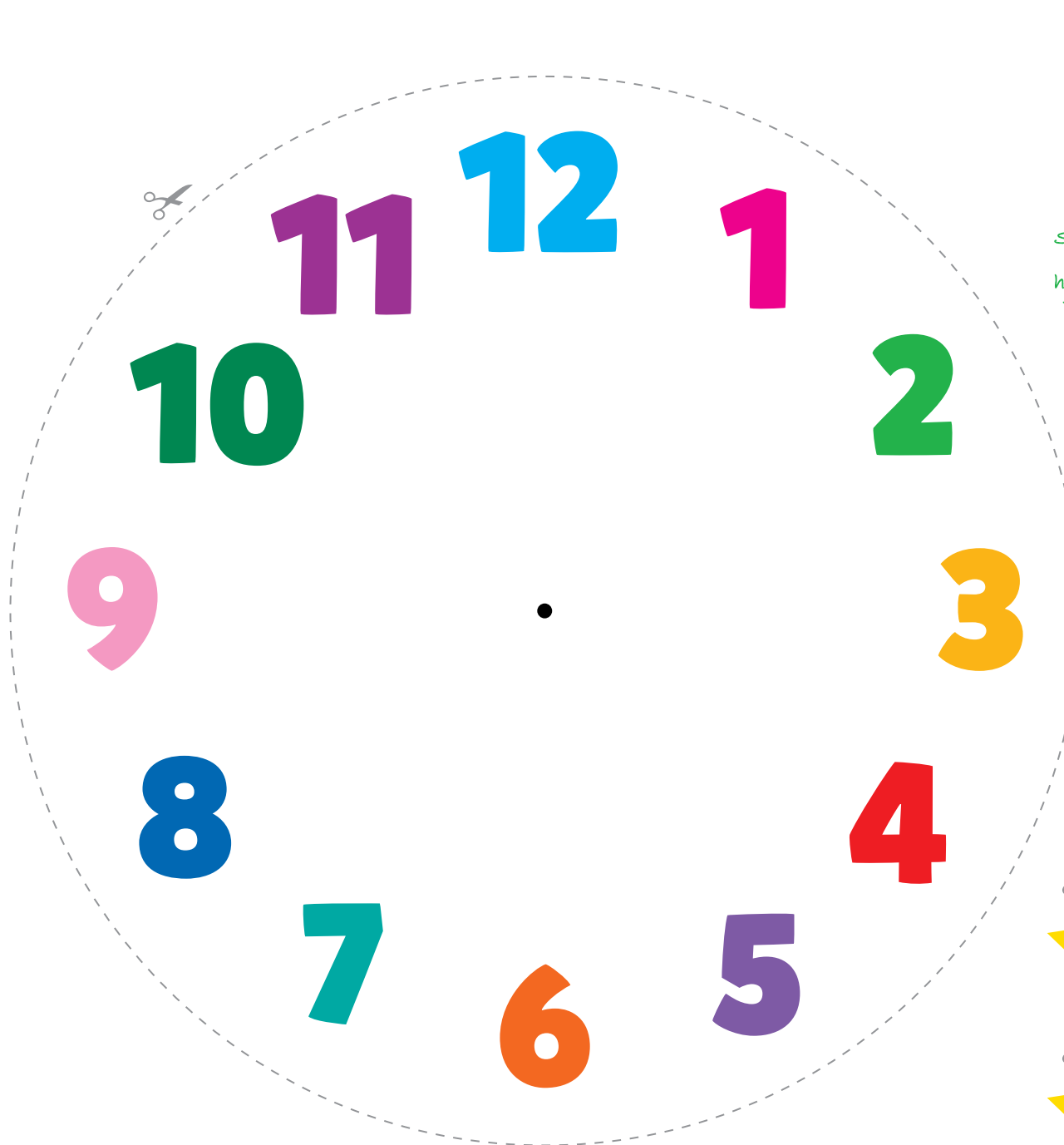
Push the paper fastener through the hands and the clock face.



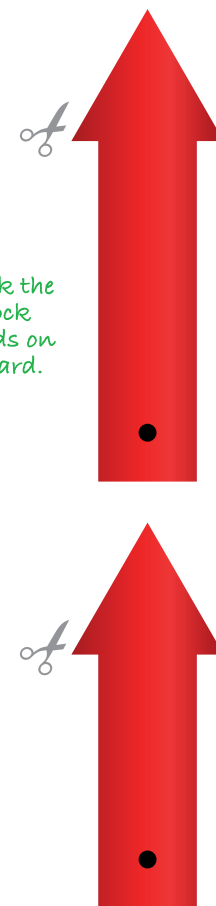
Tape a straw to the 2017 star then to the back of the clock.

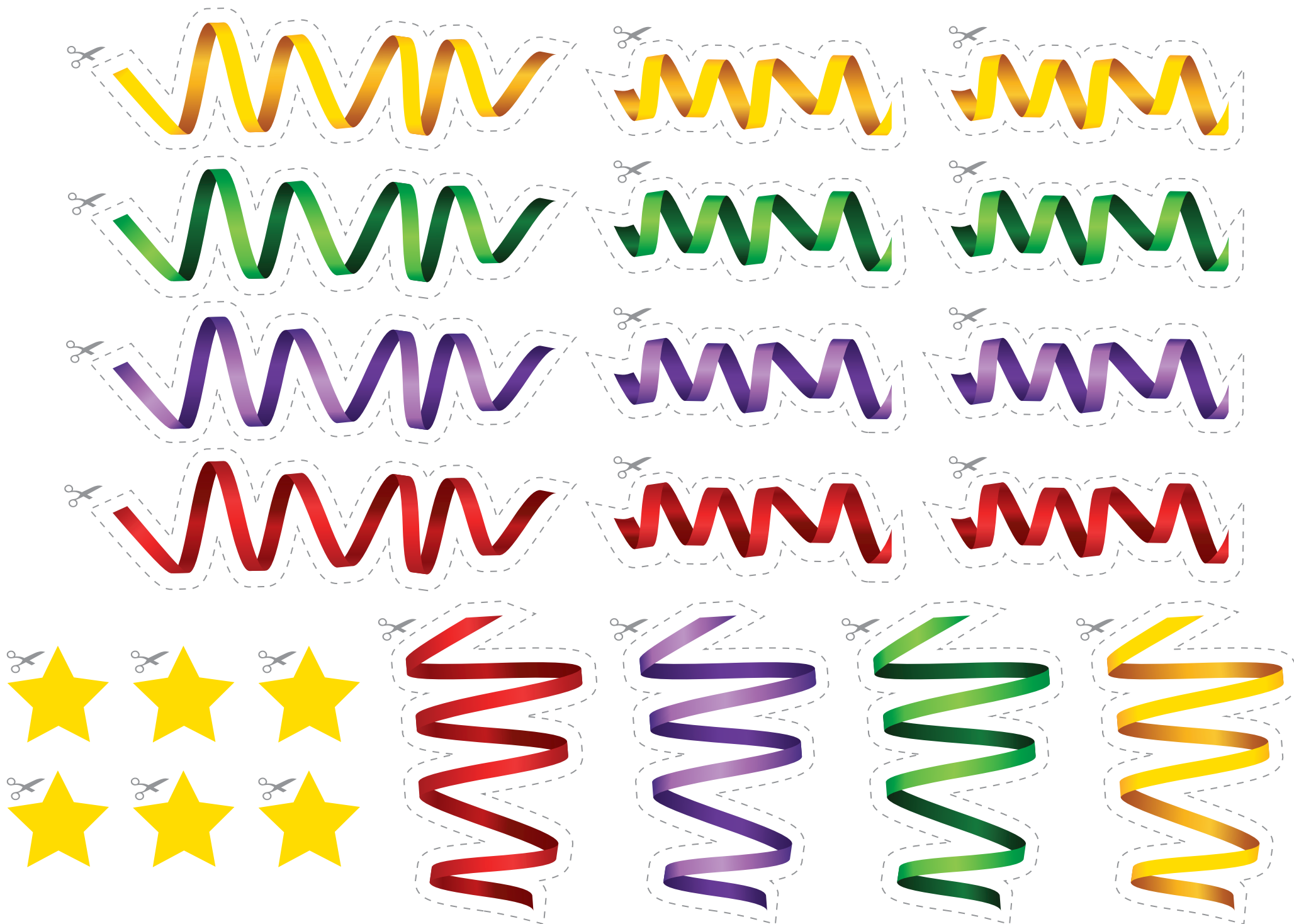
